

Instructions for joining shared albums on iPhone

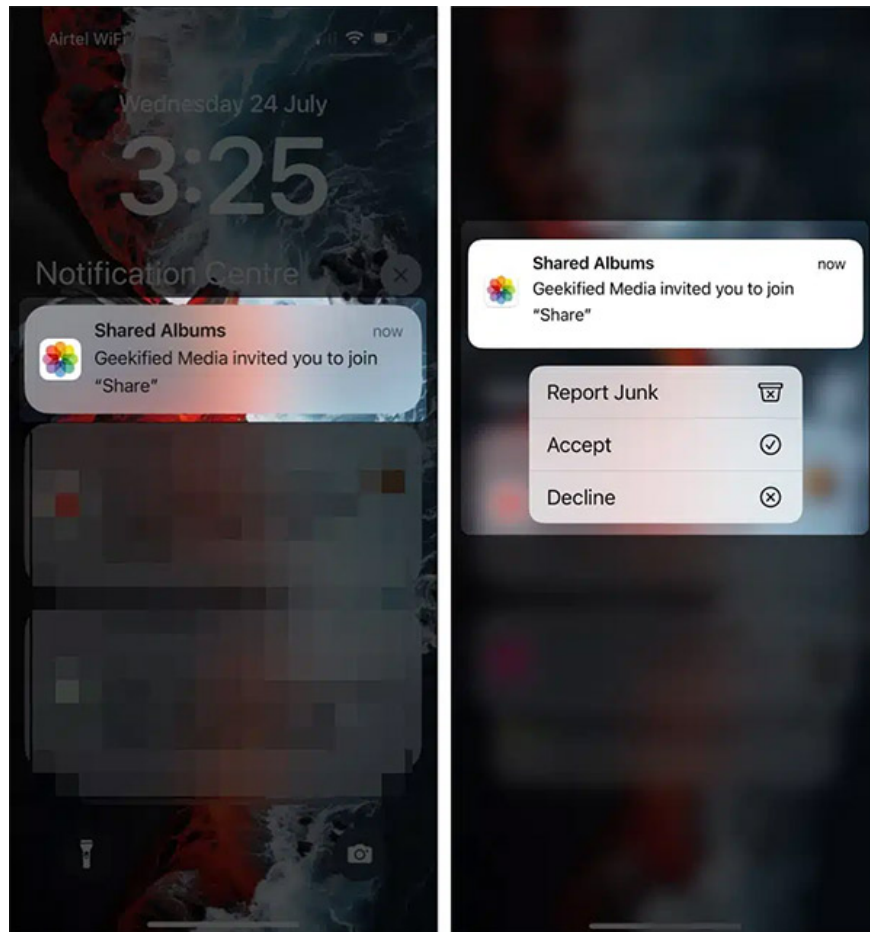
When you send a collaborative album on iPhone to someone else, they'll need to agree to join it. There are several ways to accept invitations to share an album on iPhone, as shown below.

iCloud shared albums on iPhone are useful for sharing photos, videos, and collaborating with participants in real time. When you send a collaborative album on iPhone to others, they will need to agree to join the album. There are many ways to receive invitations to share albums on iPhone, follow the instructions below.

How to join iPhone shared album via Notification Center

Note, users also need to enable shared album mode on their iPhone.

When receiving a notification to join a shared album on iPhone, users just **need to click Accept to agree** . Otherwise, click Decline to reject them.



Instructions for joining a shared album via iPhone Photos

You open the Photos app on your iPhone, then **tap the For You tab** , then tap **Shared Albums** to access the shared album. At this time, the user will see an invitation to join the shared album, if any. We just **tap Accept** to agree.

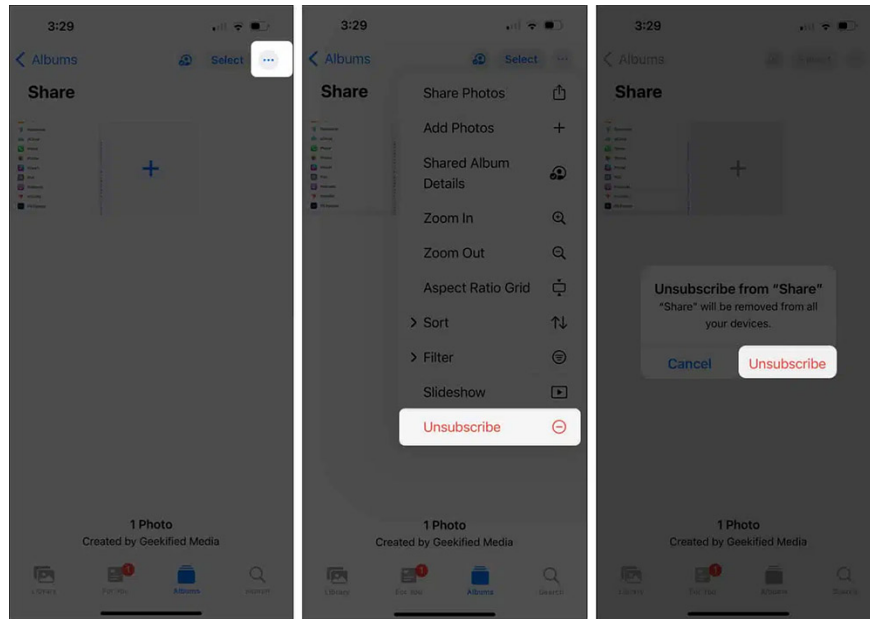

You also tap on **the For You tab** in the Photos app, then we **tap on Shared Albums** to access the shared albums we participate in.

Click on **the 3 dots icon** in the album you want to leave and **select Unsubscribe** to no longer participate in this shared album.
