

# Instructions for recovering email sent on Gmail iPhone / iPad

If you accidentally send the wrong message on Gmail, we can completely postpone the sending process thanks to the Undo Send feature available on Gmail.

Probably many times you will accidentally write the wrong content to send messages on Gmail, or simply want to add some details before proceeding to send mail. So the undelete feature on Gmail Undo Send will become our savior in this case. The network administrator once instructed you to read how to enable Undo Send on Gmail online. So how do we want to recover the email sent on the Gmail iPhone / iPad application? Similar to the web browser Gmail version, we can also use this Undo Send feature on Gmail for iOS version. Join us to learn how to use the undelete feature on Gmail iPhone / iPad.

## How to recover sent email on Gmail iPhone / iPad

First, download the new version of the Gmail application under the link below to use the Undo Send feature.

1. Download the Gmail app for iOS


### Step 1:

First of all we **log into Gmail personal account** on the device. At the main interface of Gmail, you click on **the pen icon** to proceed to compose email as usual.

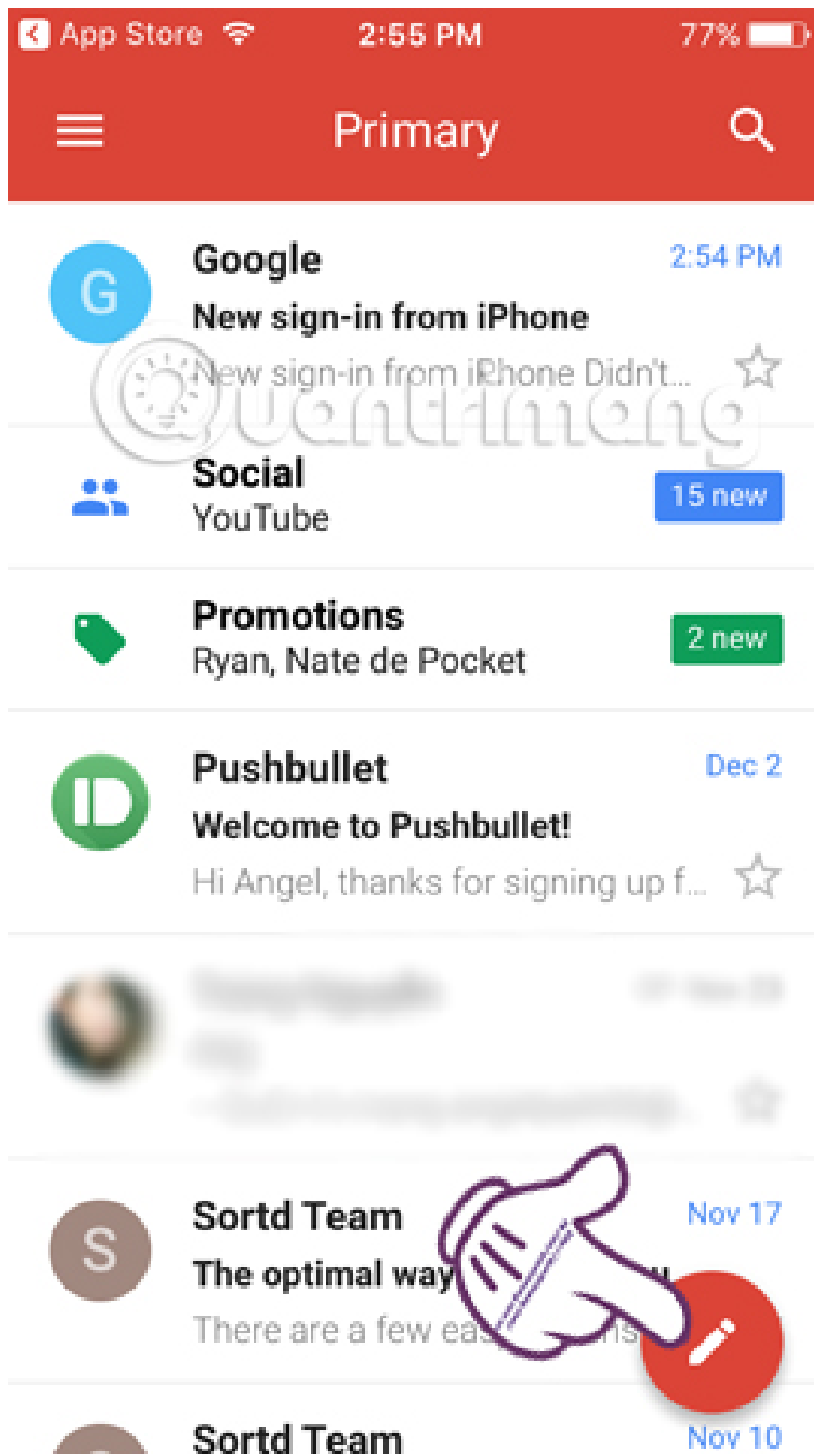

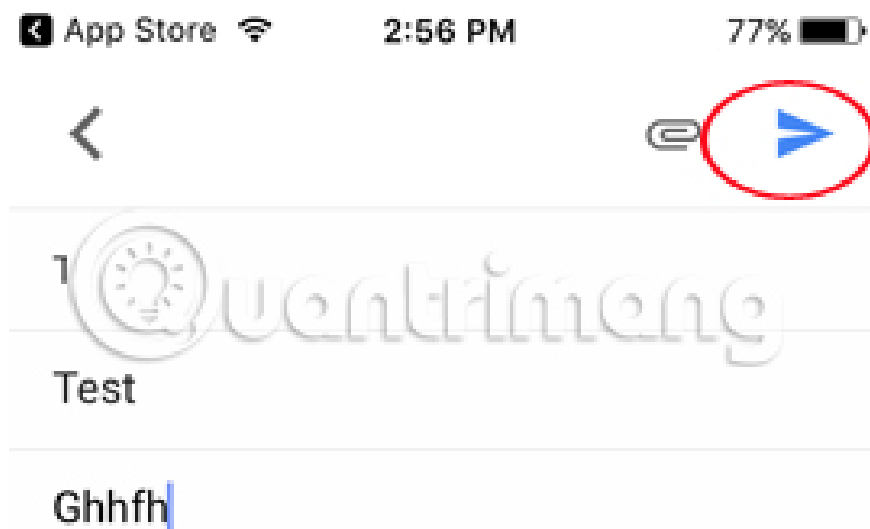


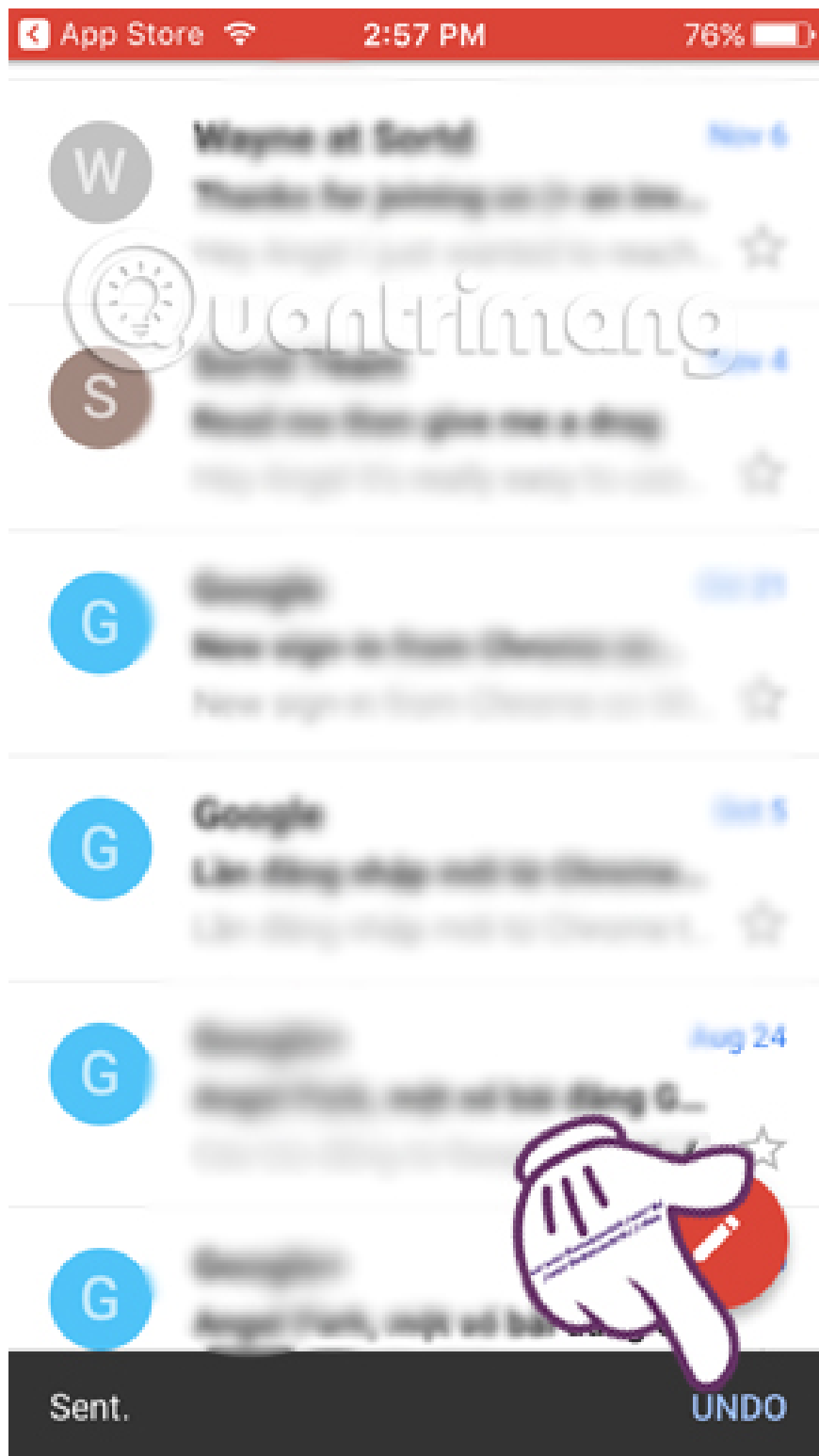


## Step 2:

We proceed to enter the recipient's name, the content of the message. After that, we also click on **the Send arrow icon** in the right corner of the interface. Soon you will be taken back to the main interface on Gmail and a **gray notification bar** appears **below the interface** , to the left is Sent and to the right is the Undo button.

Gmail will allow users **only 5 seconds** to **undo the mailing operation on Gmail** . So users need to do it quickly when **clicking the Undo button** to the right of the notification bar as shown below.



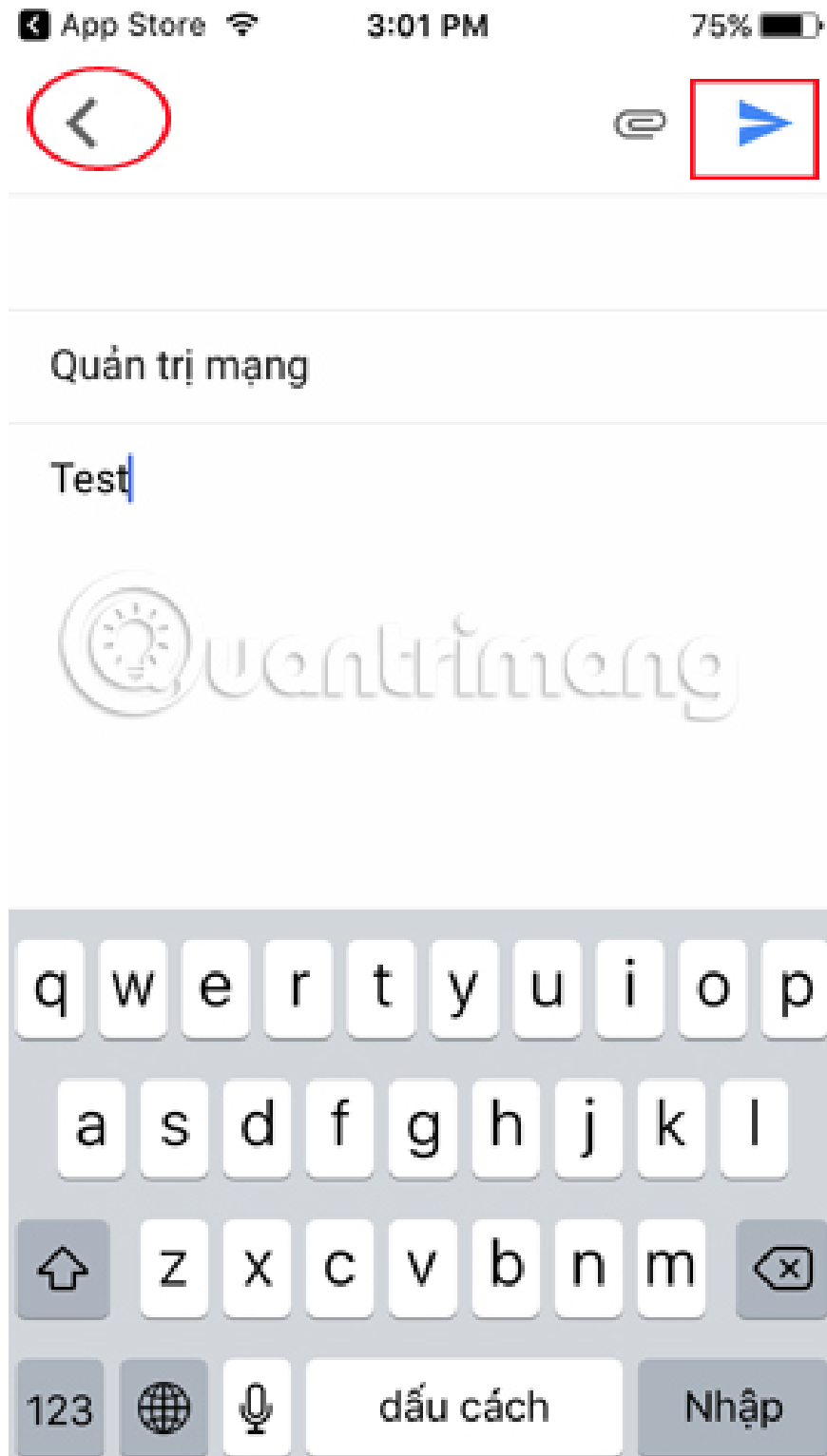


### Step 3:

At that time, the notification bar will be changed to **Undoing** mode and we will be taken to the compose interface with the content of the message written earlier. You can proceed to **edit any content** if you want and also press the arrow icon to proceed with sending mail.

If the user **does not want to edit the message content right now** , click on **the left arrow on the same interface** . The message will now be **transferred to the Draft folder (Draft saved)** as a draft in Gmail.

If you **do not want to save this message** in the Drafts section, click the **Discard** button to the right of the gray notification bar. Now on the left side of the message bar below will switch to Draft Discarded. If you want to **restore the saved draft** press **Undo** on the right is done.

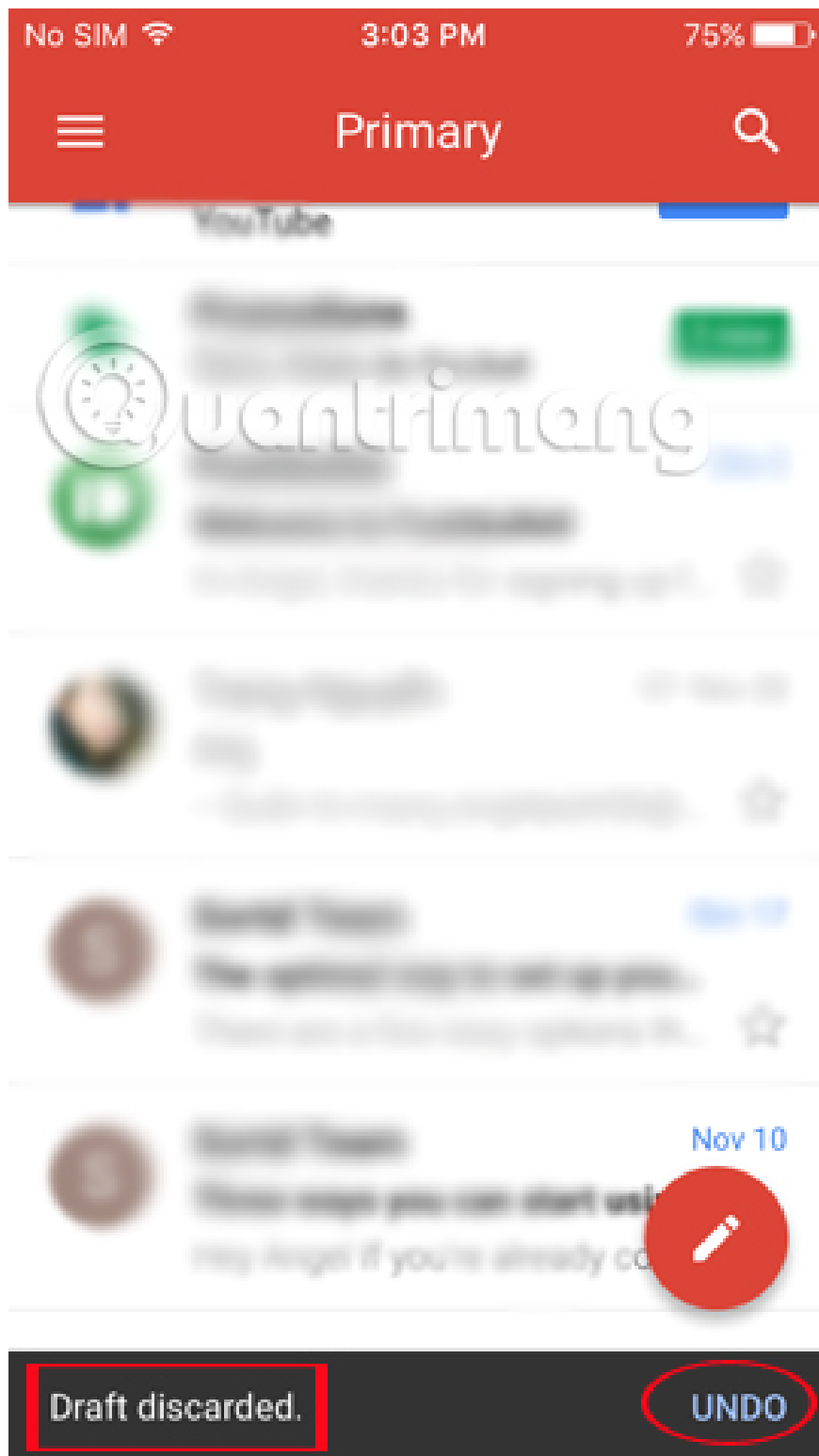

Above is how to use the undo send feature on Undo Send on Gmail iPhone / iPad. It is completely different from the Gmail version on the web when you have 5 to 30 seconds to retrieve sent messages and can customize the time, but the Gmail iOS version will show us exactly 5 seconds of sent email only. So users need to quickly manipulate when clicking the Undo button when the message has been sent. In addition, this Undo Send feature is always default on Gmail iOS, so even if you turn off this feature on Gmail web version, it will not affect.
