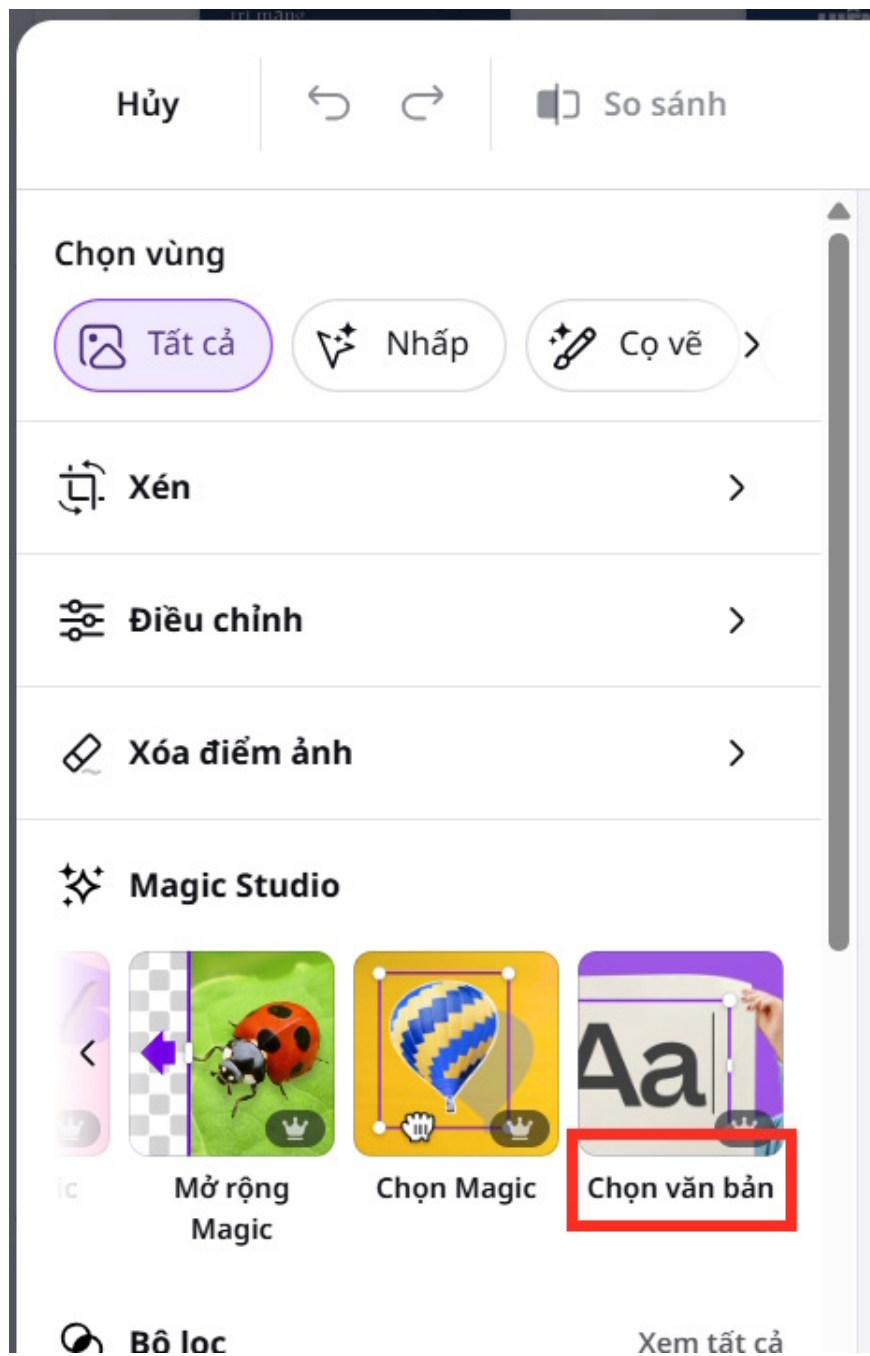

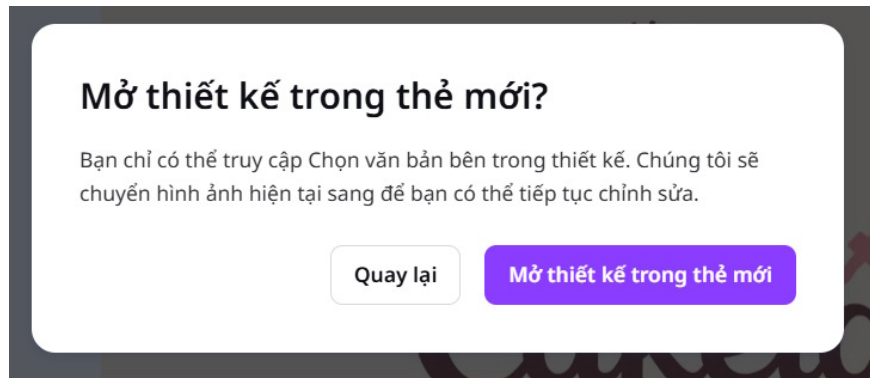
How to extract text from an image using Canva AI

Step 1:

First, upload the image to Canva or use an existing image to make adjustments. Next, **select Edit** and scroll down to click **Select Text** to extract text from the image.

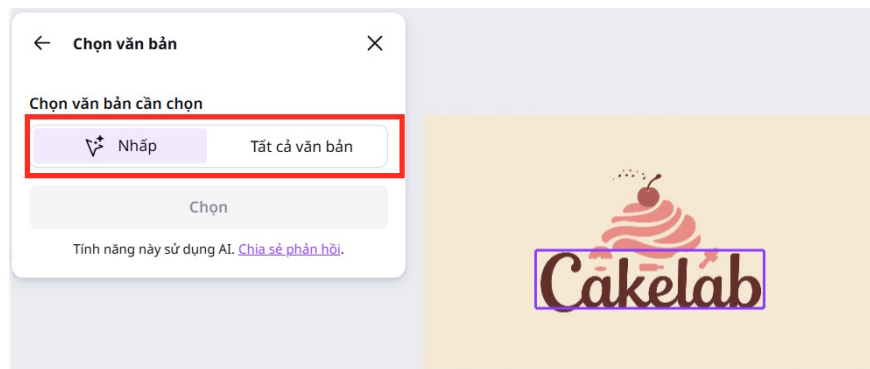


Then you choose whether to create a new design or use an existing one.



Step 2:

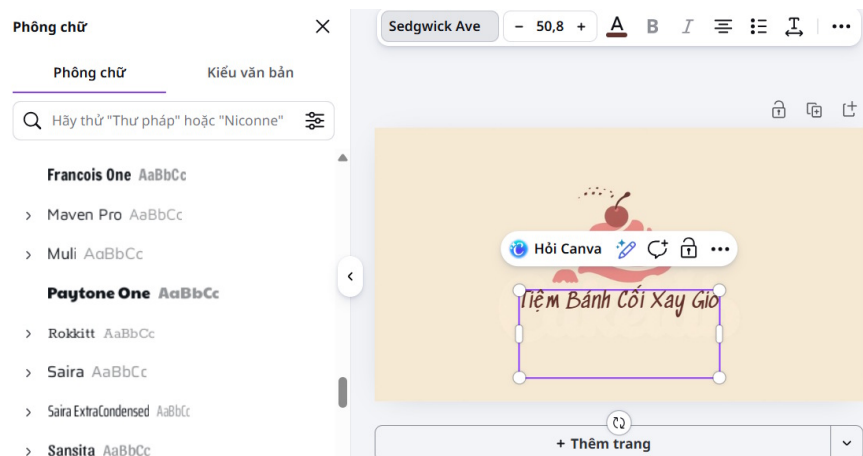
In the **text recognition** interface for extraction, the tool proceeds to select the text. You can click on the text area you want to select, or click "All Text" to select all the text in the image. Then **click "Select"** at the bottom.



Step 3:

Switch to the editing interface in Canva so we can modify the text extracted from the image. Here you can use Magic Write in Canva AI to change the content if needed.

Continue by selecting the font, font size, color, effects to use, and the content you want to change in the image.



Once you've finished changing the content in the image, continue editing and then download it as usual. Advanced text formatting options such as bold, italics, or underline are not yet fully recognized.
