

# Instructions for setting up an Exchange account on Android phones

In the following article, we will show you how to set up and use email from **Exchange, Exchange Calendar, Exchange Contacts** and the ability to synchronize data between devices based on the Android platform.

First, we need to have an Android phone with data plan, an Exchange account can be used normally. Besides, there are some supporting information as follows:

- **Exchange** server address (same as **OWA** address)
- Account **username** and **password** information
- **Domain** name

Steps to proceed in order:

In case you already have any email account on your phone (such as **Google** or **POP** ), there are a few things you need to do:

- Open the **Email** application
- Press the **Menu** button and **Accounts**
- Click on **Menu** and **Add**
- Fill in **email address** and **password information**

In another test, we succeeded in applying the above steps to the **Sprint** distributor's **SamSung Epic 4G** phone model, and you can do the same with the phone models using the system. operating Android 2.0 or newer,

specifically as follows:

- Open the **Mail** application
- Enter your **email address** and **password**
- Click **Next**
- Click **Exchange Account**
- Fill in some related information such as domain, username, password, Exchange server address
- Check the **Use Secure Connection** box and agree to all the terms related to **SSL Certificates**
- After the account confirmation process is completed, check the box corresponding to the features you want to use such as **Push, Amount To Sync, Notifications, Sync Contacts, Sync Calendar, Sync Calendar Amount**
- Click **Next**
- At the next screen, the user must provide the account name and display name (will appear on the email sent)

Note here that you need to set domain and username parameters according to the standard. And when you have completed the setup process as above, we will not need to wonder or search for any other application to meet the needs of working and communication every day, but instead just need to check email, appointments, calendars, partner lists, friends . one more advantageous point when we do this is that **Exchange** server automatically syncs information in the **Calendar** and **Contact section** as before .

Another point to note in this process is that when setting up the account, the system will use and interact with the relatively large data stream, so consider the Automatic option in the Push section. To ensure that this process is not interrupted halfway, consider processing time from 5 or 10 minutes each time.

On the other hand, many people will think of using multiple accounts after they have successfully set up. But now, we can only configure 1 Exchange account with the built-in support tool, but if you want to use more than 1 account, please refer to and use some programs. like TouchDown - support us very well in creating an Exchange account with an unlimited number.
