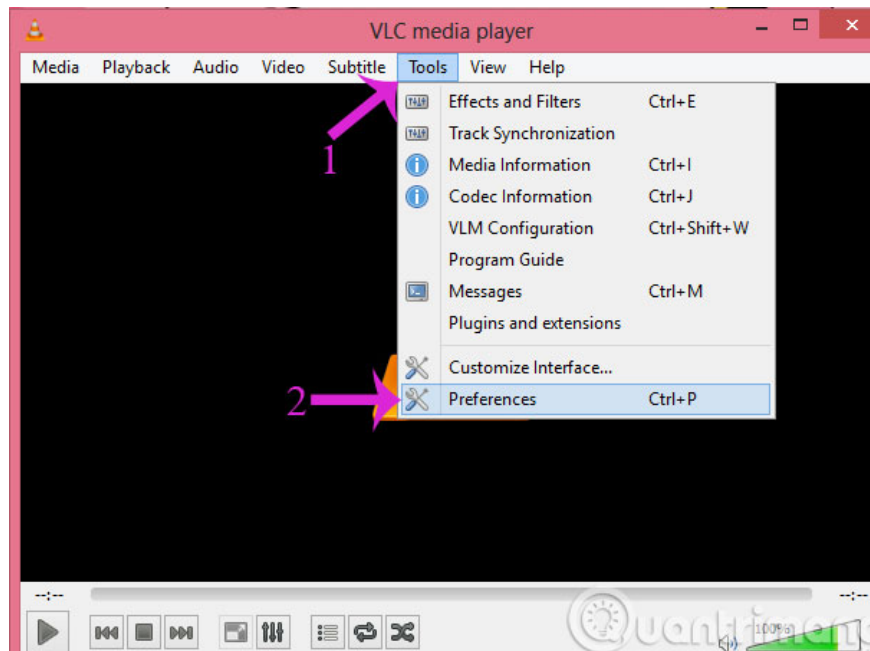

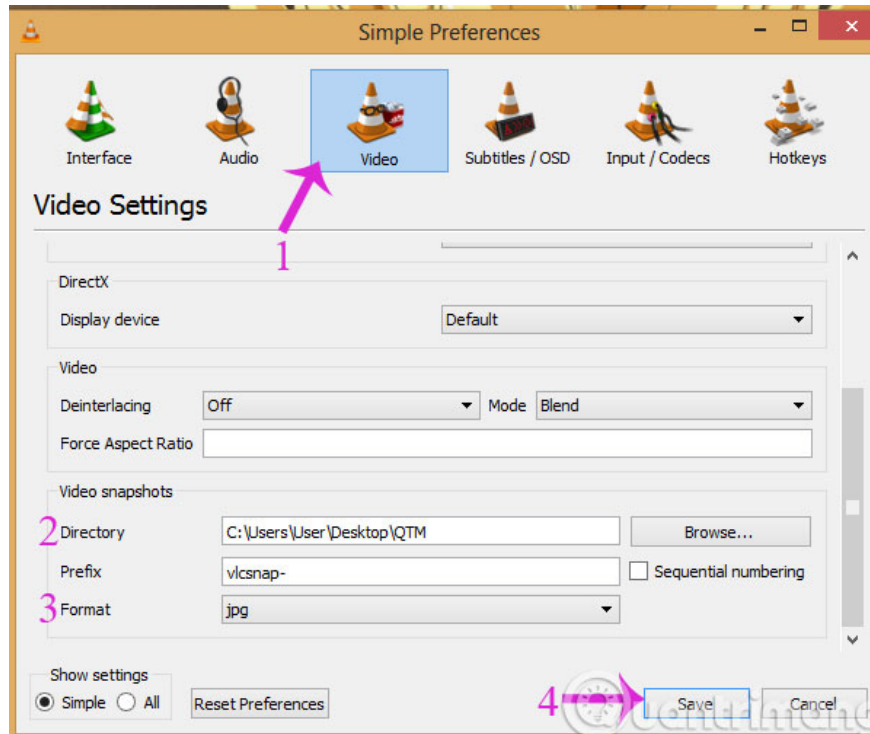
Step 1:

Open the VLC Media Player application, click the **Tools** menu and select **Preferences** (or press **Ctrl + P**)



Step 2:

In the **Simple Preferences** window, click the **Video** tab, then drag down to the **Video snapshots section**



1. **Directory** : Select the path for the photos taken
2. **Format** : Choose an image format

Then, click **Save** to save.

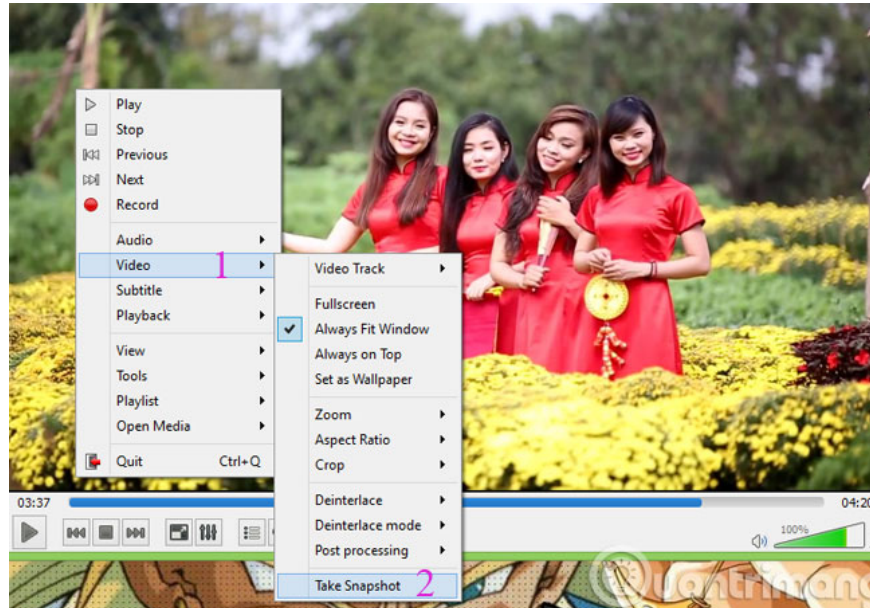
Step 3:

Open the video you want to take, when viewing the clip you want to take, click **Pause**.



Step 4:

Next, right-click the screen and select **Video > Take Snapshot**



Step 5:

Open the folder to save photos to see the photos you have taken
