

# Instructions for troubleshooting Flash Player crash (crash) in the browser

1. How to update Adobe Flash Player to the latest version?
2. How to check the version of Flash Player on the computer?
3. How to fix Adobe Flash Player error suddenly stopped on the browser?

Imagine if you are playing a game or watching an interesting movie, then suddenly Flash Player has crashed, causing the browser to freeze, hang, and mouse to be jerked when moving (not as smooth as usual) . it's annoying. And even more annoying if you don't know how to fix this problem. But now that is no more, because TipsMake.com will help you fix this error in the most radical way.

## 1. Fix Flash Player error that crashed, could not view video clip in browser:

The best way is to update Flash Player to the latest version (see the link above), and note that during the update process you must close all open browsers! After the installation is successful, please open your browser and watch any video clip to check.

## 2. Edit Adobe Flash Player configuration file:

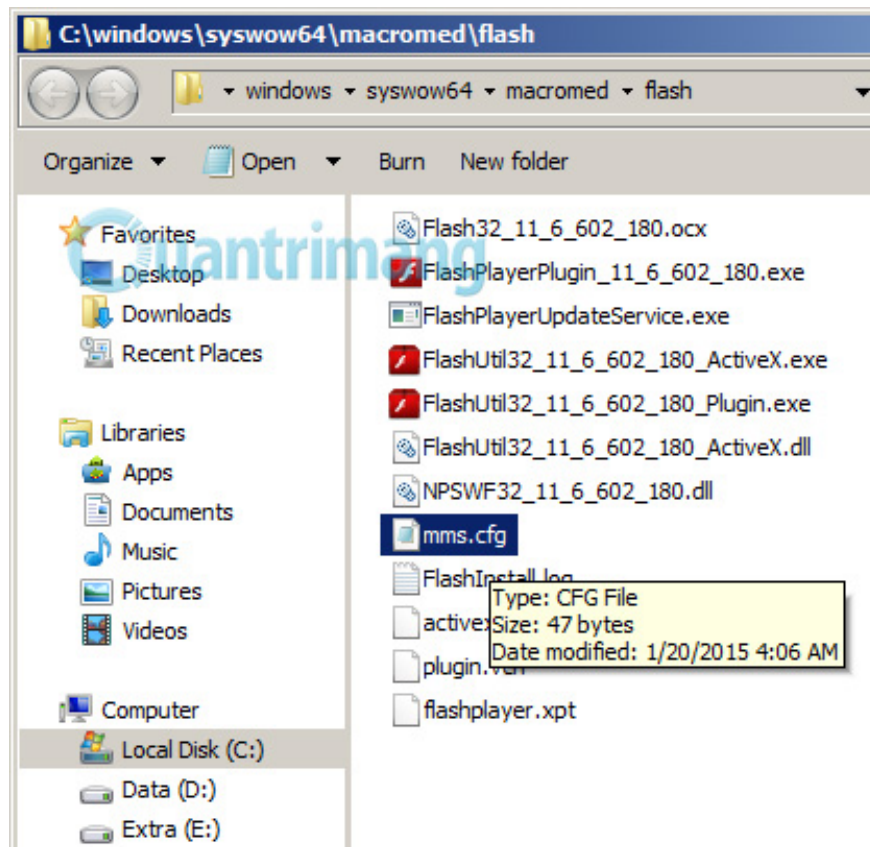
If you use 32-bit Windows 7, go to the following link:

1. C: windowssystem32macromedflash

As for 64-bit Windows 7, go to:

1. C: windowssyswow64macromedflash

Find the file mms.cfg and open it with NotePad ++ (or NotePad):



When you open it, the mms.cfg file will have this content:

```
AutoUpdateDisable = 1  
SilentAutoUpdateEnable = 0
```

Please correct it to:

```
AutoUpdateDisable = 0  
SilentAutoUpdateEnable = 1  
ProtectedMode = 0
```

Press Ctrl + S to save changes, close the browser and then reopen and check the results. Note that if you cannot save, it means that the account you are using is not an Administrator account, please use the account with Administrator rights to operate at this step!

The above are some basic ways to fix Flash Player errors or crash in the browser. *Good luck!*
