

Instructions for turning off the Sound (Touch Sound) on Android device

The system sounds every time you press or touch any application on Android that makes you headache? So how to disable these sounds? Please follow the article below to know how to do it.

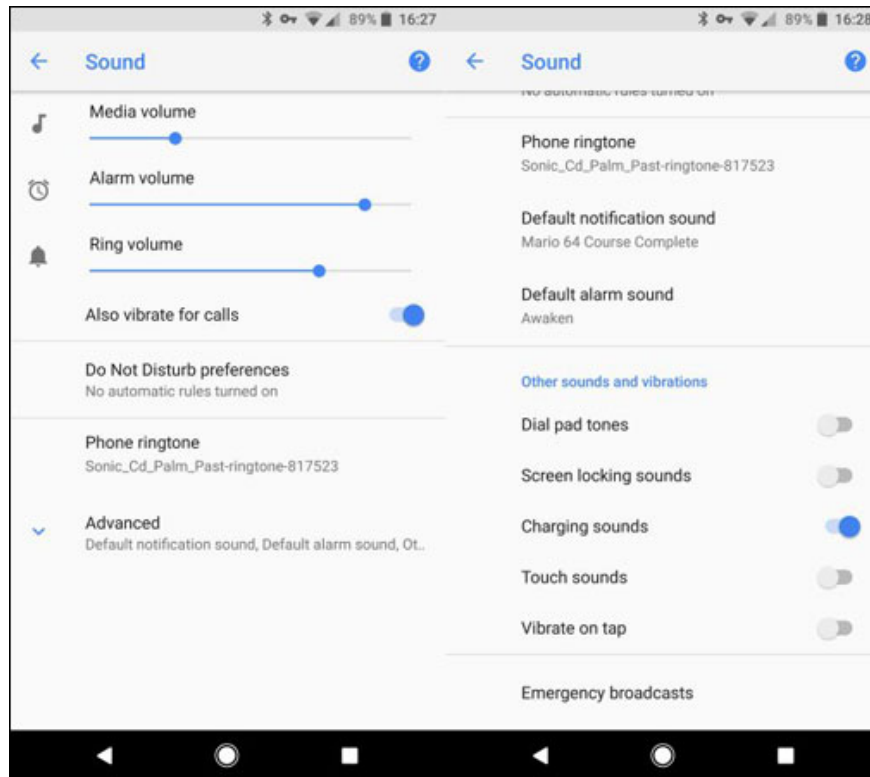
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How to turn off the touch sound (Touch sound) on Android

First, you need to access the **Settings** application , then scroll down to the **Sound** section . Here, you will see some volume options, select **Advanced** to see more options. Then, scroll down to see the **Other sounds and vibrations options**.

Here, you can turn off all the sounds, however, we recommend turning on **Charging sounds** to help you confirm if the phone is connected to the charger.



You can also turn off the **Vibrate on tap** option to save battery or **Dial pad tones** so that your phone doesn't ring every time you dial a phone number.

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On iOS devices, there is no touch sound similar to Android, but you can mute the keyboard and the screen lock sound if you feel bothered. To do that, simply go to **Settings> Sounds** (Sounds & Haptics for iPhone 7 and newer) and scroll down. Here, you can disable **Lock Sounds** (Key Lock) and **Keyboard Clicks** (negative when pressing keys).
