

Instructions for Updating Win 11 on Computer Quickly and Simply

1. What is Windows 11?

Windows 11 is a new operating system launched in 2021 and is currently used on laptops. In this version, users will experience all the outstanding improved features that previous versions did not have. At the same time, the new interface is easy to see and has high aesthetic effects.

2. Minimum configuration requirements to update Windows 11

Processor:	The CPU must achieve a minimum processing speed of 1 GHz with a 64bit processor.
System firmware:	UEFI extended firmware, secure boot support.
Internal memory:	4GB RAM
Graphics card:	Ensure compatibility with DirectX 12 or later and have WDDM 2.0 driver.
Screen	> 9 inches with HD Resolution (720p)
Internet connection:	Make sure your PC or laptop has a Microsoft account and is connected to the Internet.
TPM	TPM version 2.0

3. Features when updating win 11

When updating win 11 there will be new features, including

Logo

Compared to the old versions, Win 11 uses a logo of 4 squares combined together to form a simple window shape. Similar to the logo on the company's computers, simple, easy to remember and beautiful.



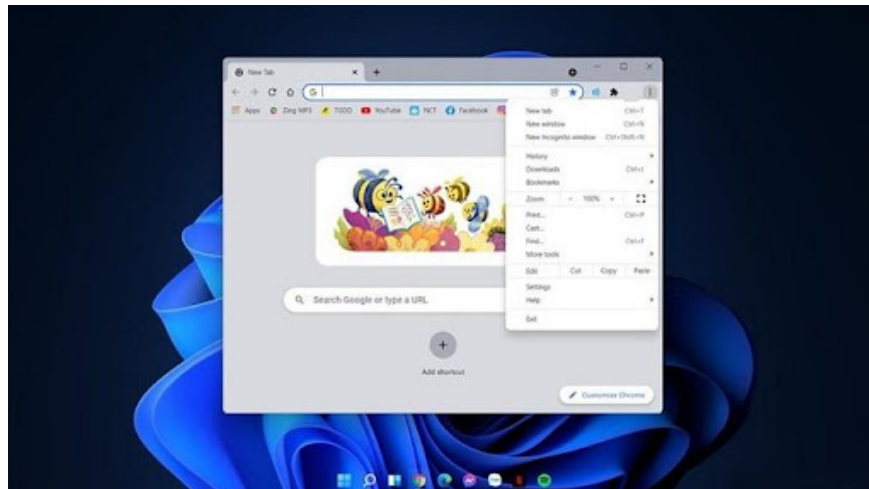
Refreshed start menu and taskbar

When updating Windows 11, the taskbar in this version is designed very neatly with icons in the middle of the screen.

The Start Menu has an impressive design, with rounded corners and being placed in the center of the screen, allowing users to see a wider view of the screen. The icons are scattered across the window instead of being grouped on the left as before. A search box is added at the top to make it easier for users to search for applications.

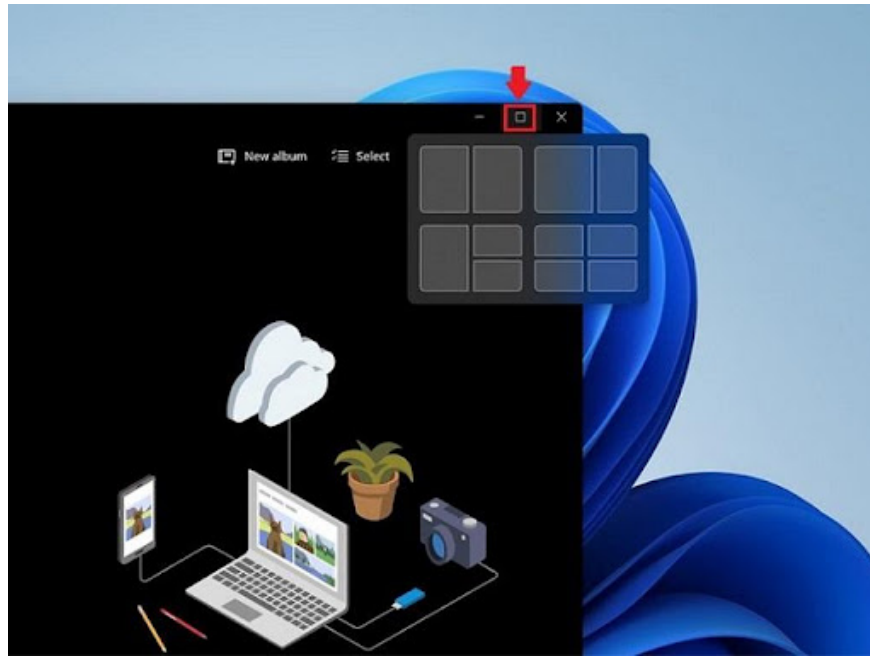
Rounded window corners

The aesthetic effect is also shown when users update Windows 11. In this version, the rounded window corners create a strong and extremely comfortable feeling for users.



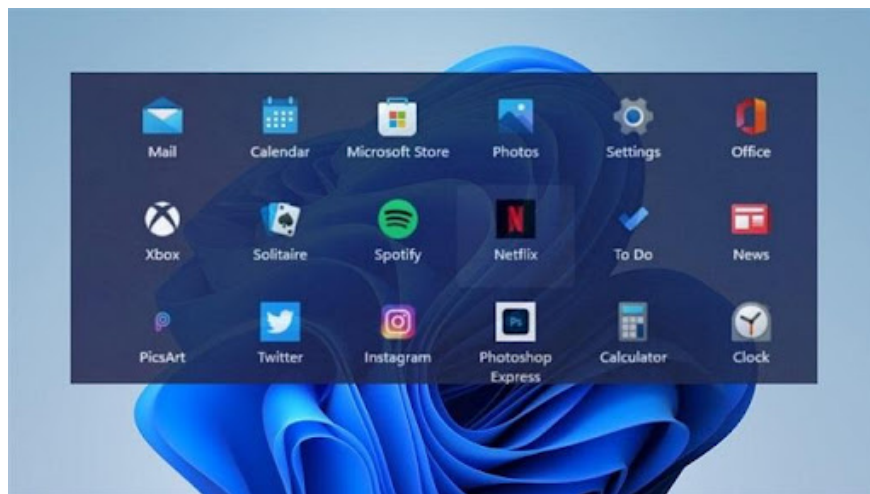
Expanded snap feature

The Windows 11 operating system allows the use of a new feature called Snap Layout that makes users extremely excited. Specifically, when you click on the window's zoom position, Windows will suggest available layouts. This allows you to run applications in parallel at the same time.



Using the new icon system

Users will experience a whole new collection of icons with bolder and more personal color designs on Windows 11. Other icons of the device such as Desktop, Document, Music, Download,. are all replaced with new icons in the Fluent Design style.



Fluent Design is understood as a cross-platform design language, released by Microsoft in 2017. When designing the Windows 11 interface with this style, developers relied on elements such as light, depth, motion, materials and proportion.

4. Instructions on 5 ways to officially update Windows 11 on laptops and computers

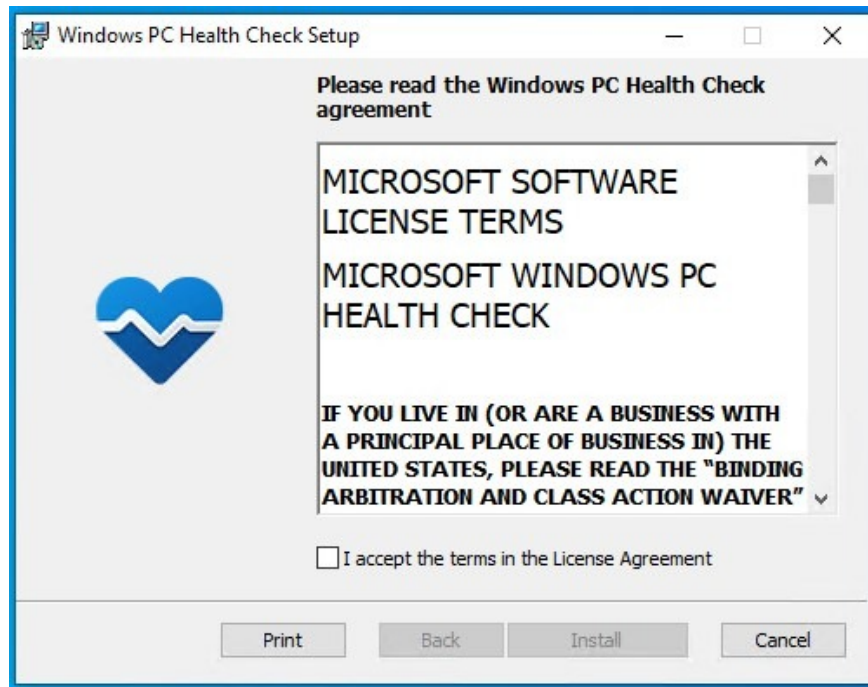
Requirements to Update Windows 11

With the latest version of PC Health Check, users can see if they have a PC that can run Windows 11. The latest version of the app also includes a list of specific reasons why a PC can't run Windows 11 – along with recommendations for upgrading.

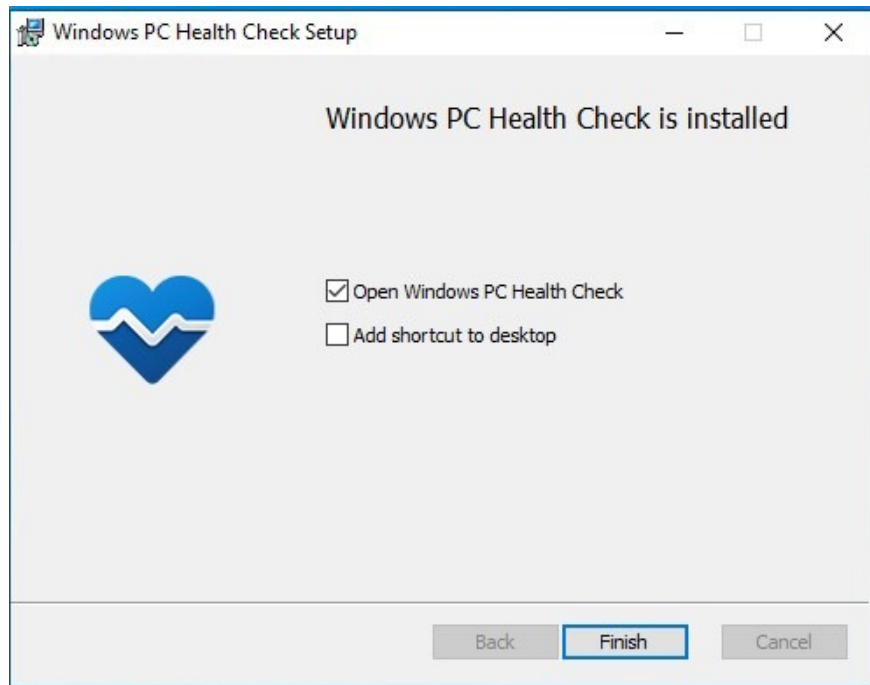
Step 1: From your web browser, download Microsoft's PC health check.

Step 2: Once downloaded, click on the WindowsPCHealthCheckSetup.msi file

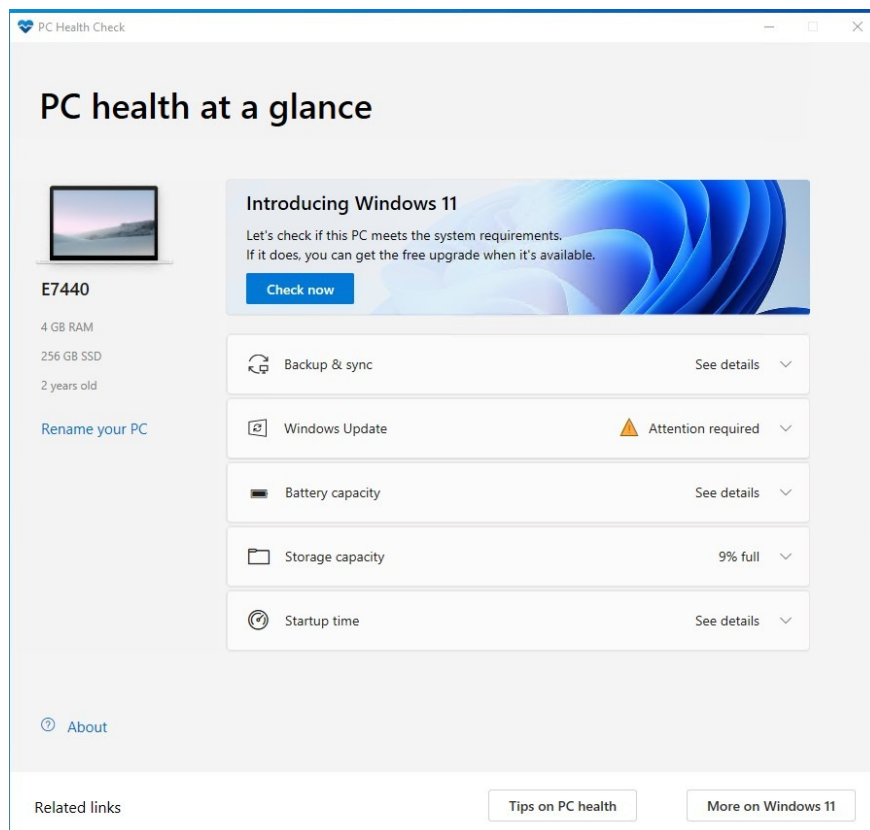
Step 3: Review the policy and then click **I accept** . Once accepted, click **Install** .



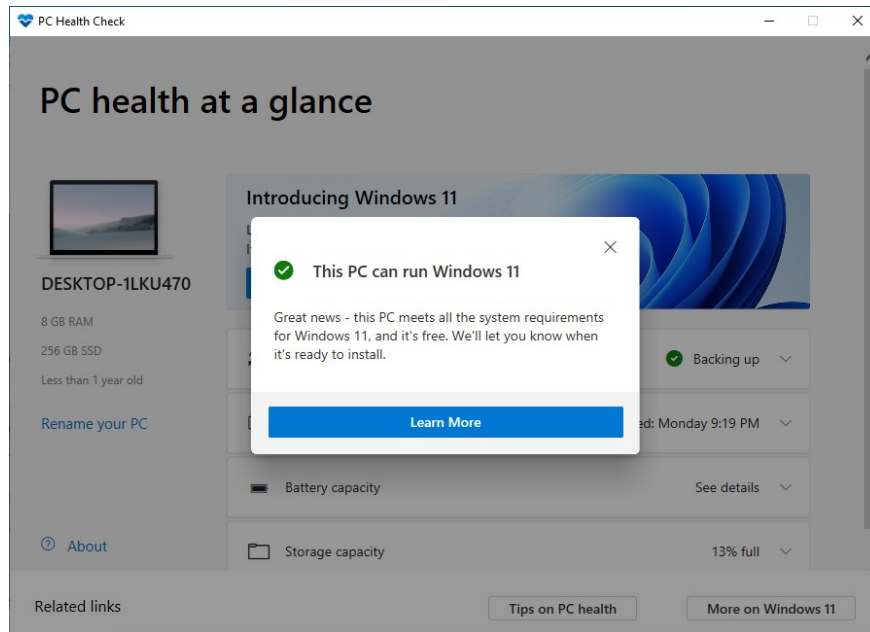
Step 4: Once PC health Check setup is complete, click Finish to launch the application.



Step 5: Click **Check now** to start analyzing your PC for Windows 11 compatibility.



Step 6: After the test is complete, you will receive a success or failure message. If you receive a success message, move on to Step 7. If you receive a failure message, move on to Step 8.



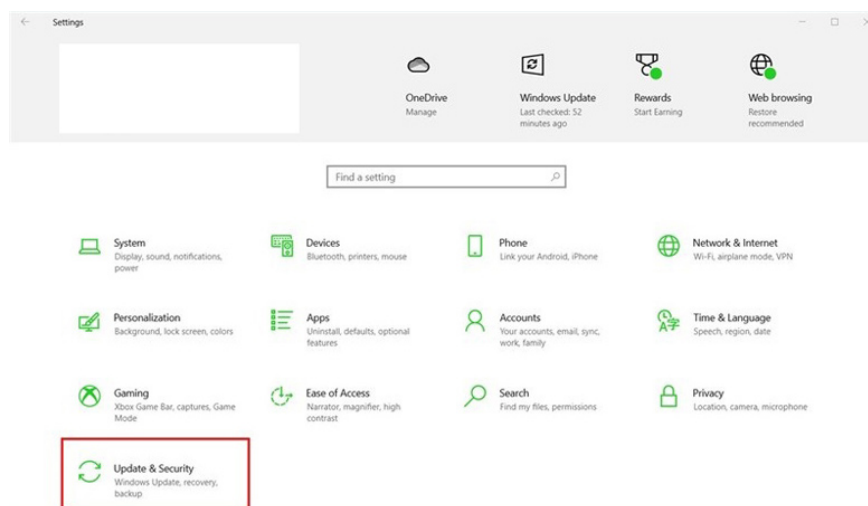
Note:

- Your PC is compatible with Windows 11 and will receive the update when it's available.
- Your PC is not compatible with Windows 11 and will not be able to update. The PC Health Check app will provide a reason why your PC is not compatible.

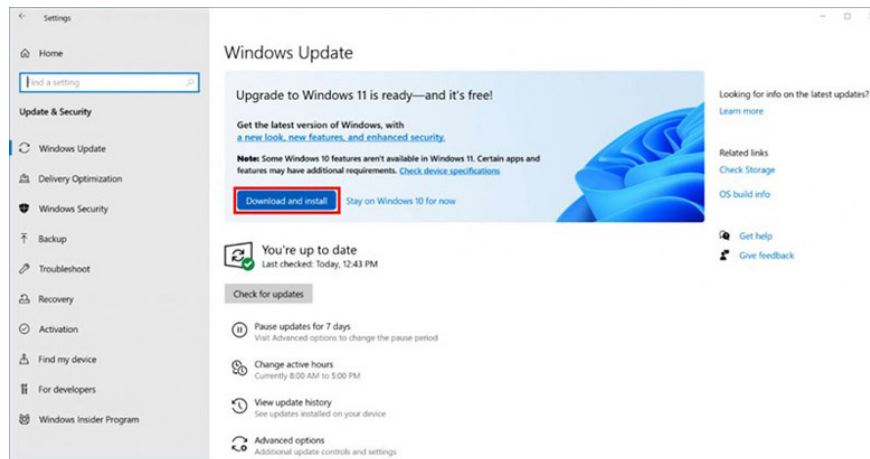
Method 1: Upgrade to Windows 11 officially from Windows update

There are many ways to update win 11 but this is the official way to update, ensuring the safety of your computer. Upgrading your computer to win 11 from win update will give you peace of mind because your computer is completely compatible with the operating system without any errors.

Step 1: Users access the **Settings** section on the Windows interface > Select **Update & Security** > Click on **Windows Update** .



Step 2: Then, a notification from Microsoft will appear on the screen inviting users to update to Windows 11. Click the **Download and install** button to download and install Windows 11 for your computer.



Method 2: Update Win 11 official version safely and securely

Step 1: Prepare your Microsoft account

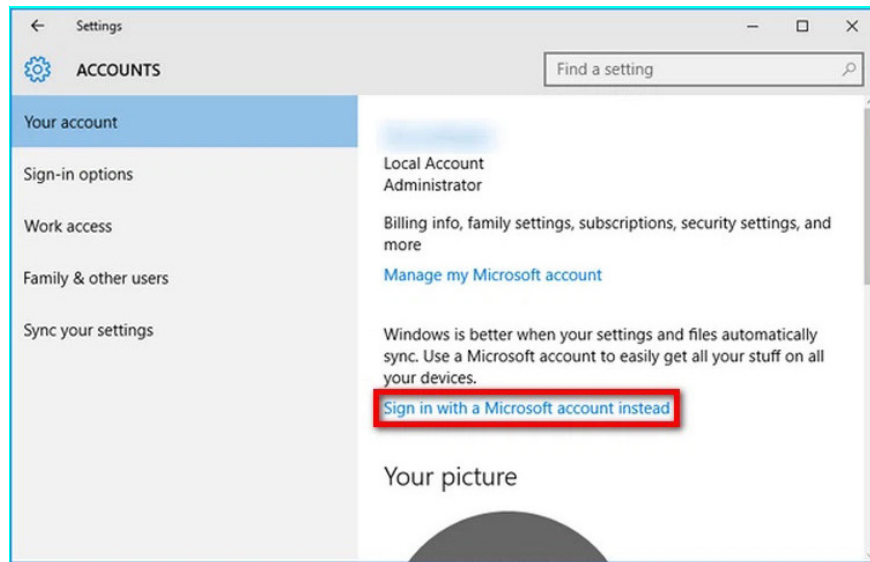
To upgrade from Windows 10 to Windows 11, you will need a Microsoft account. If you do not have an account, we will create a new one through the Microsoft account registration link and follow the instructions.



Step 2: Sign up for the Windows Insider Program

After having a Microsoft account, the next step in this Windows 11 update is to register to join the Windows Insider Program by clicking here. Select **Register** > **Sign in now** .

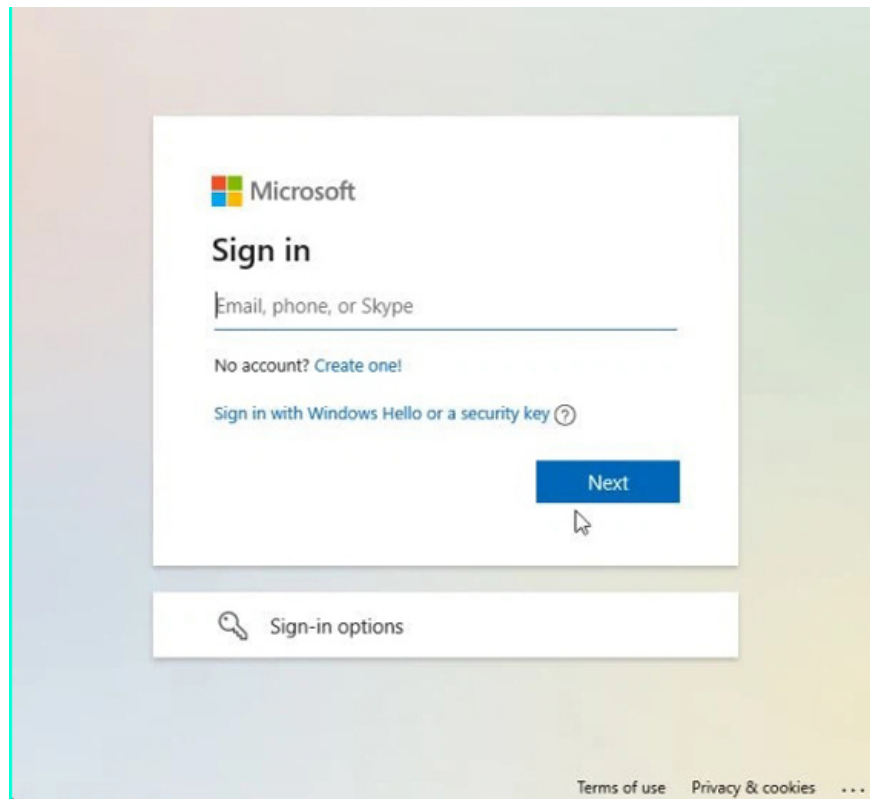
After completing the registration, everyone should link their Microsoft account to the computer using Windows 10. In case you are using a local account on the Win 10 computer, you need to switch to an online account. However, this change will not cause data loss.



To connect your Microsoft account to your PC, go to **Start menu > Settings > Select Account > Click Your account** . On the right interface, click **Sign in with a Microsoft account instead** .

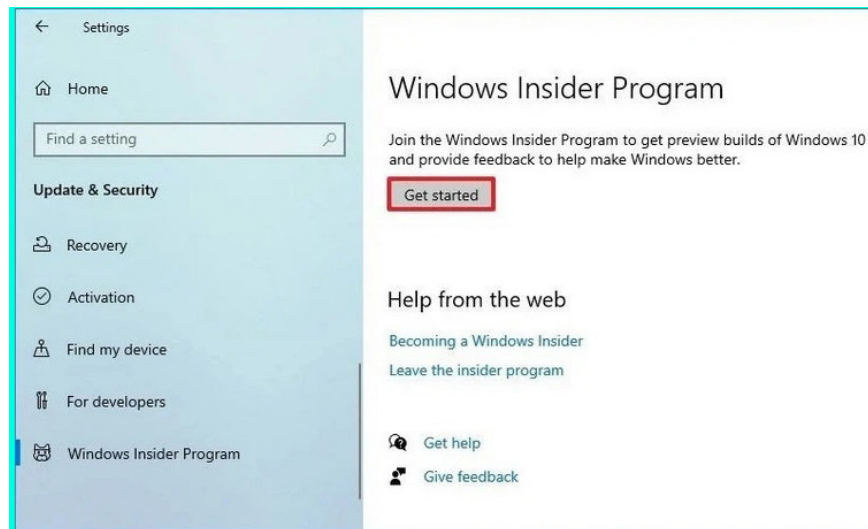
Step 3: Sign in to your Microsoft account

Fill in the necessary information of the Microsoft account that you used to register for the Windows Insider Program above and then log in.



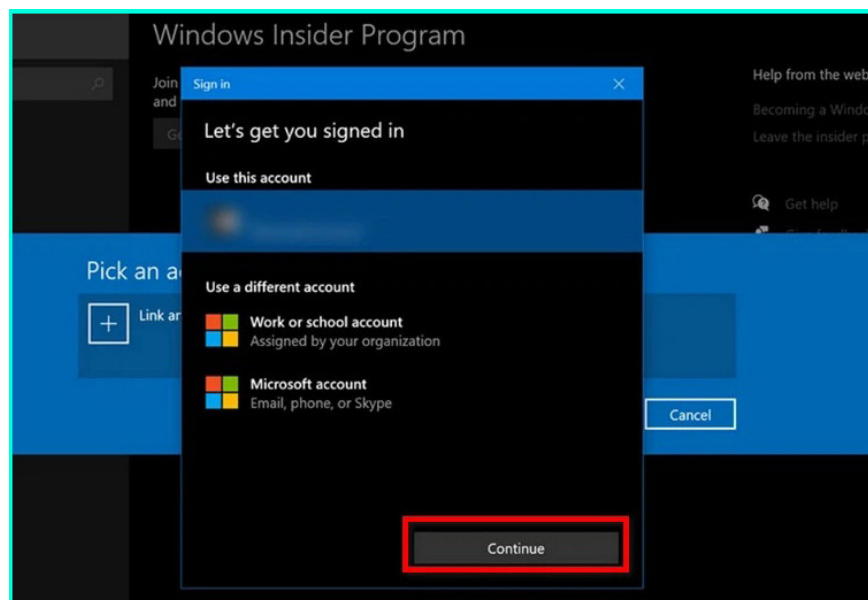
Step 4: Select the Get Started section inside the Windows Insider Program

Once logged in, the user will navigate to **the Start menu** > Select **Settings** > Click **Update & Security** . At this interface, select the **Windows Insider Program** on the right and then click **Get Started** .

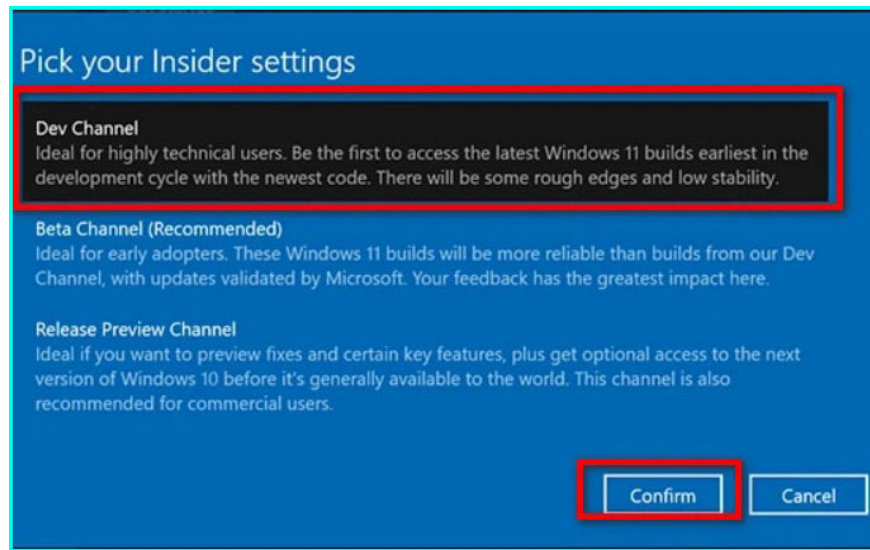


Step 5: Select Link an account

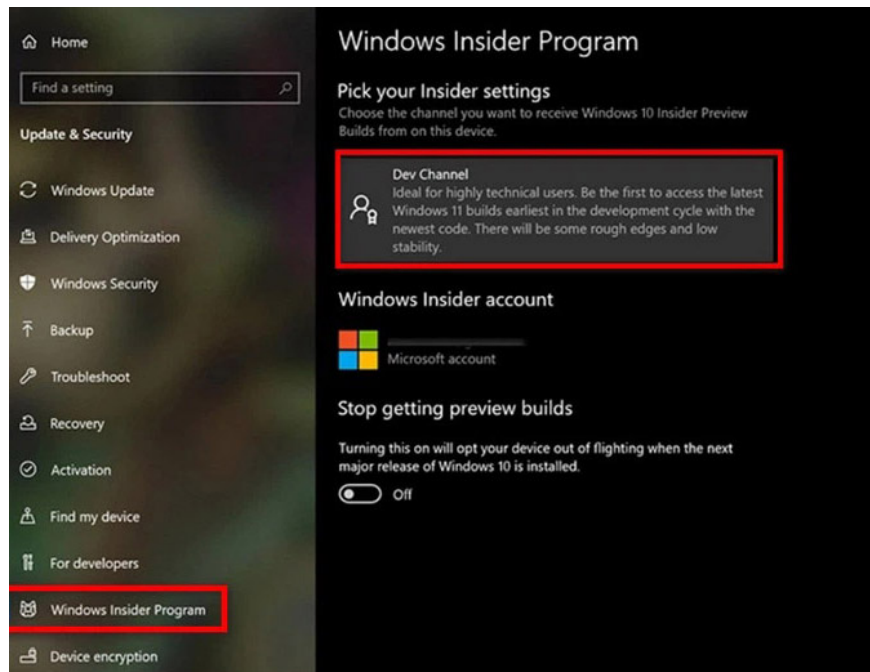
Wait for a few seconds for the computer screen to load. In the dialog box that just appeared, click on Link **an account** > Select the Microsoft account that you logged in above > Click **Continue** to continue.



Then, you go to the **Pick your Insider settings** screen > Click on the **Dev Channel** section because Windows 11 is only available to users in this channel > Click on the **Confirm** box .



Next, everyone selects **Restart Now** to restart the device to apply the new settings or select **Restart Later** if you want to restart later.

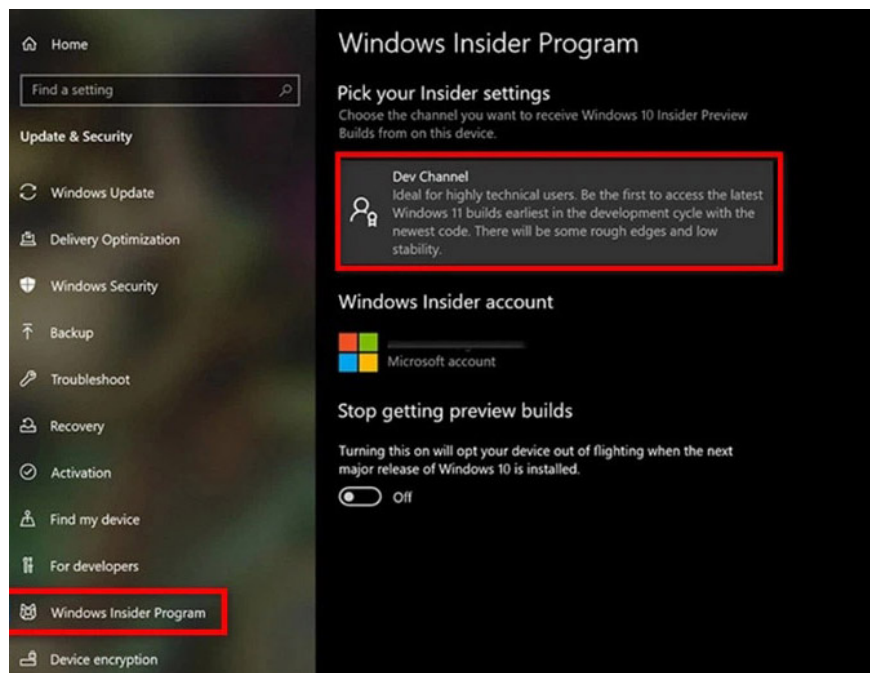


Step 6: Check the settings again

Go back to **Start menu** > Select **Settings** > Click **Update & Security** > Click **Windows Insider Program** again to make sure all your settings are correct.

Step 7: Click Check for Updates

After confirming the information, everyone goes to **Start menu** > Click **Settings** > Select **Update & Security** > Click **Windows Update** > Select the **Check for updates** box on the right.

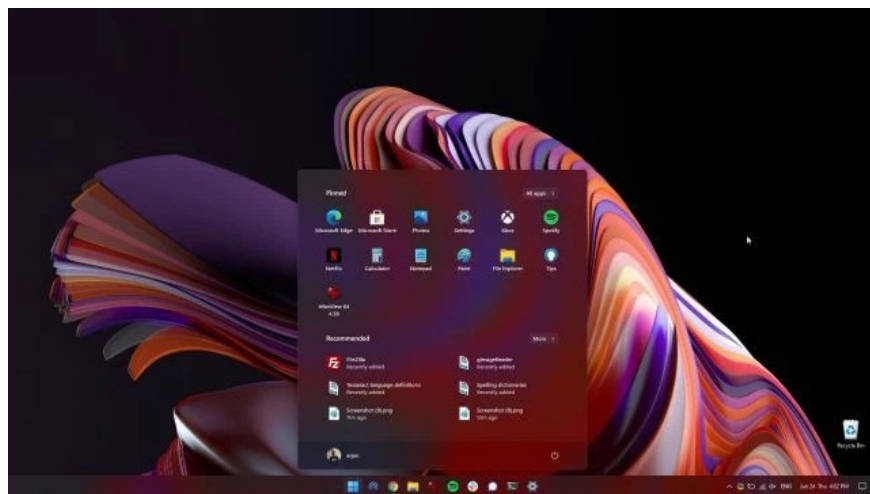


Step 8: Wait a moment and then click the Download button

The next step in how to update Windows 11 from Windows 10 is to wait a moment for the computer to download the update file. After completion, your Windows 10 computer will have Windows 11 Insider Preview Build 22000.51 > Click **Download** to download it to your computer.

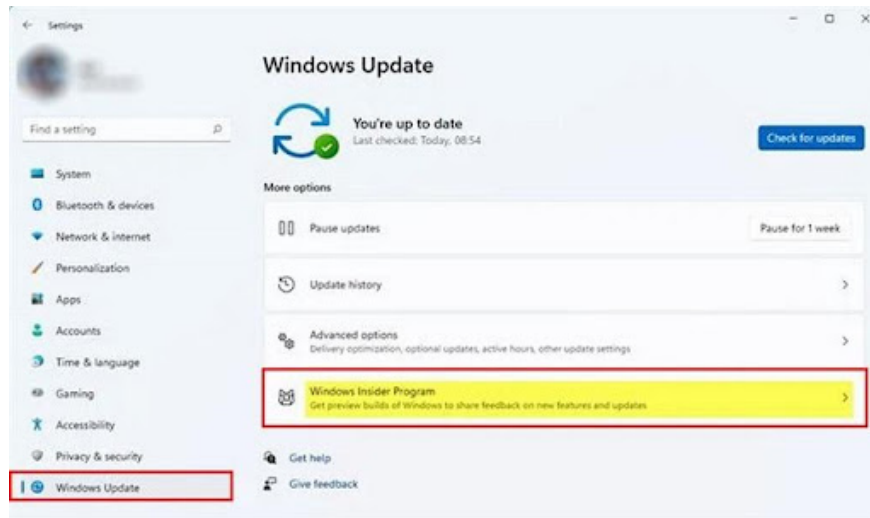
Step 9: The machine automatically installs

How fast Windows 11 downloads will depend on your computer's hardware configuration and your network speed. While installing the new operating system, your device may restart if necessary. This process will be completely automatic without user intervention.



Method 3: Update Windows 11 officially from Windows 11 Insider

Step 1: Go to Settings > Click **Windows Update** > Select **Windows Insider Program** .



Step 2: Click **Stop getting preview builds** > In the section, **Unenroll this device when the next version of Windows releases**, you slide the activation bar to **On**. Immediately after that, the device will help you exit Insider and you can update to the official Windows 11 operating system version.

When updating on Windows 11, no data will be lost before updating. The security system is absolutely safe, does not take too much time, and does not lose files on the computer.
