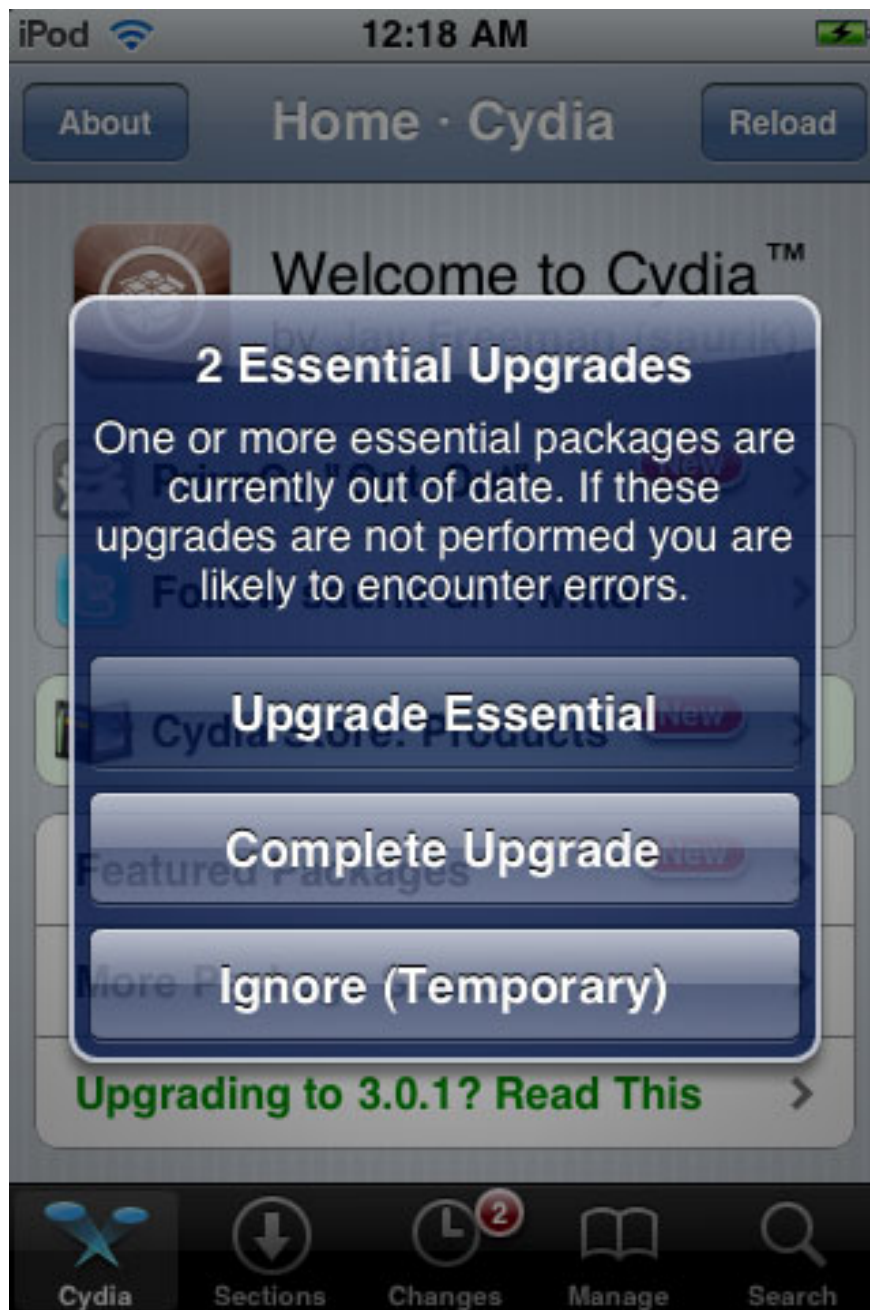
The following article helps you get familiar with Cydia quickly.



Connect your iOS device to a Wi-Fi network then click on the Cydia icon, you will see the interface of the Cydia application with 5 components: **Home** , **Sections** , **Changes** , **Manage** and **Search** .



A message may appear as shown below. Select **User** mode (Graphical Only).



## Add a source (source) in Cydia

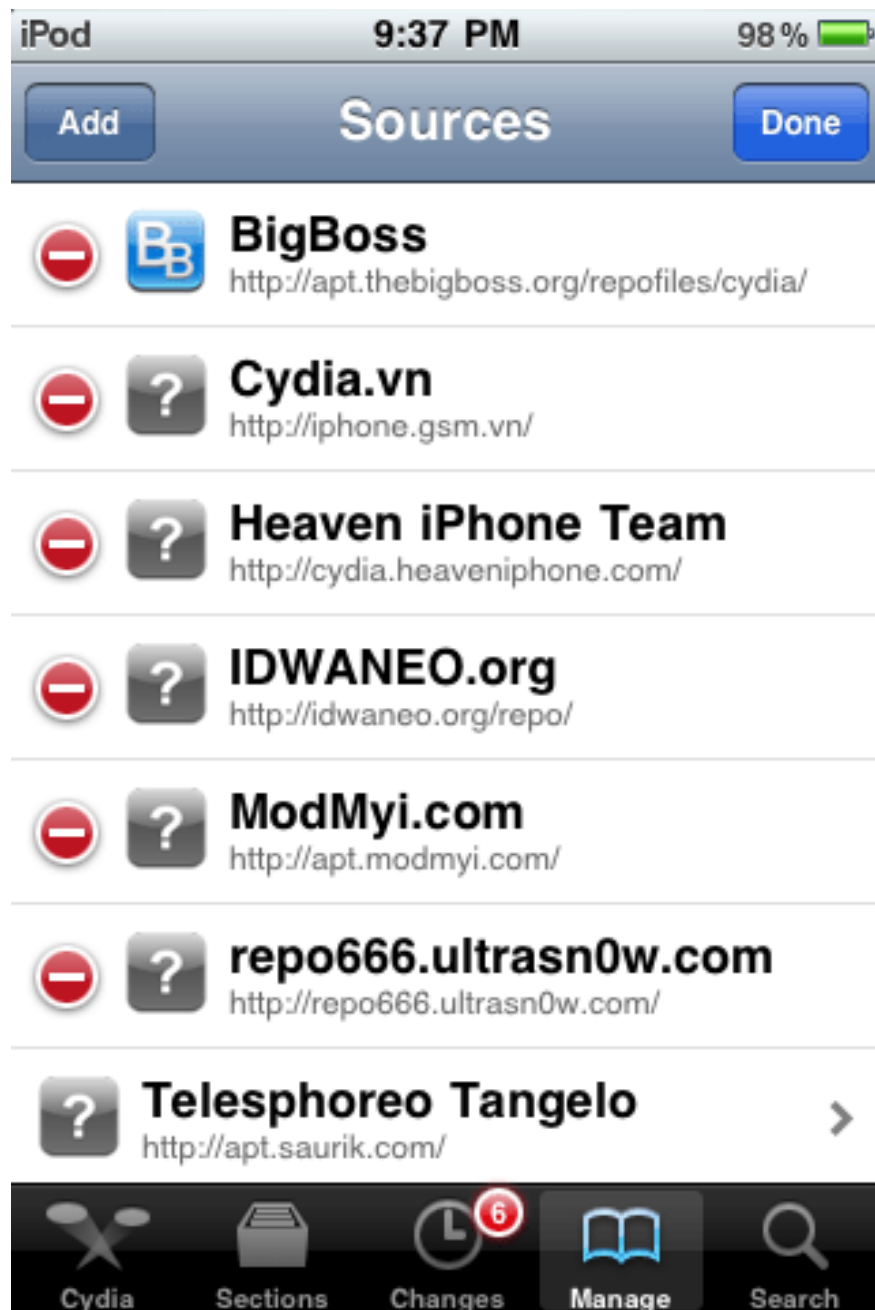
Click on the **Manage** item, then select **Sources** .



By default, Cydia has some available sources, if you want to add a new source, click on **Edit** .

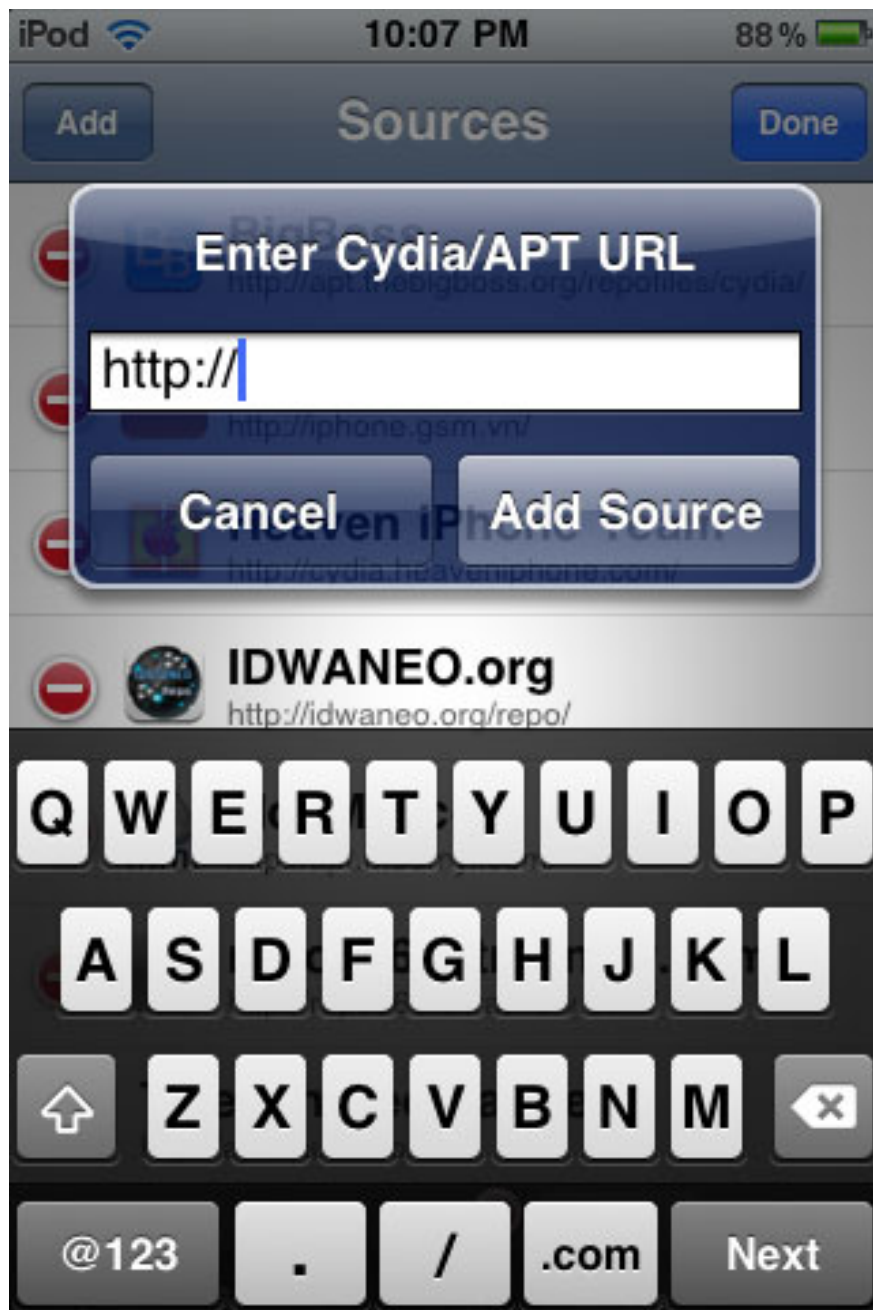


Then click on **Add** .



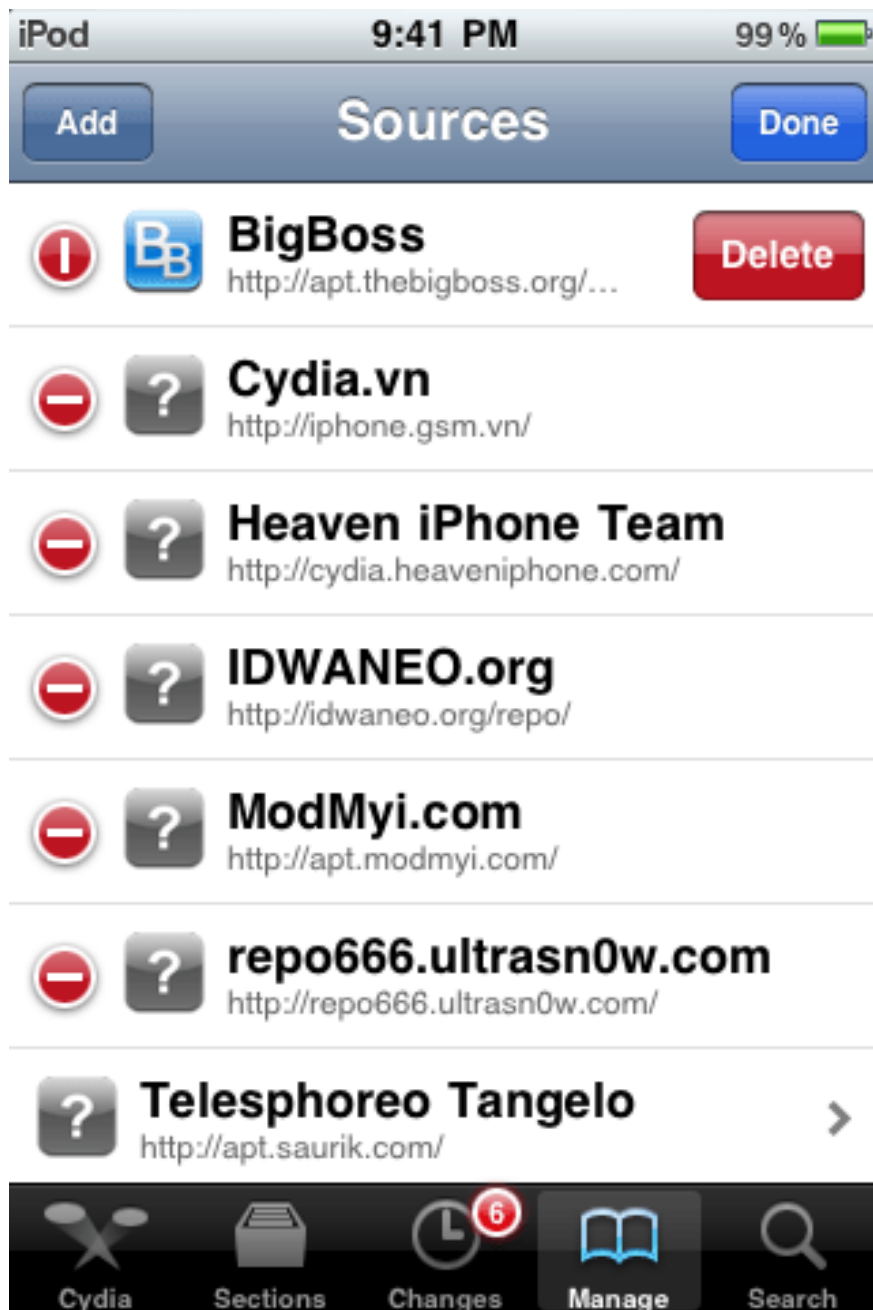
Next type the address of the source and click on **Add Source** . Here are good sources for Vietnamese users.

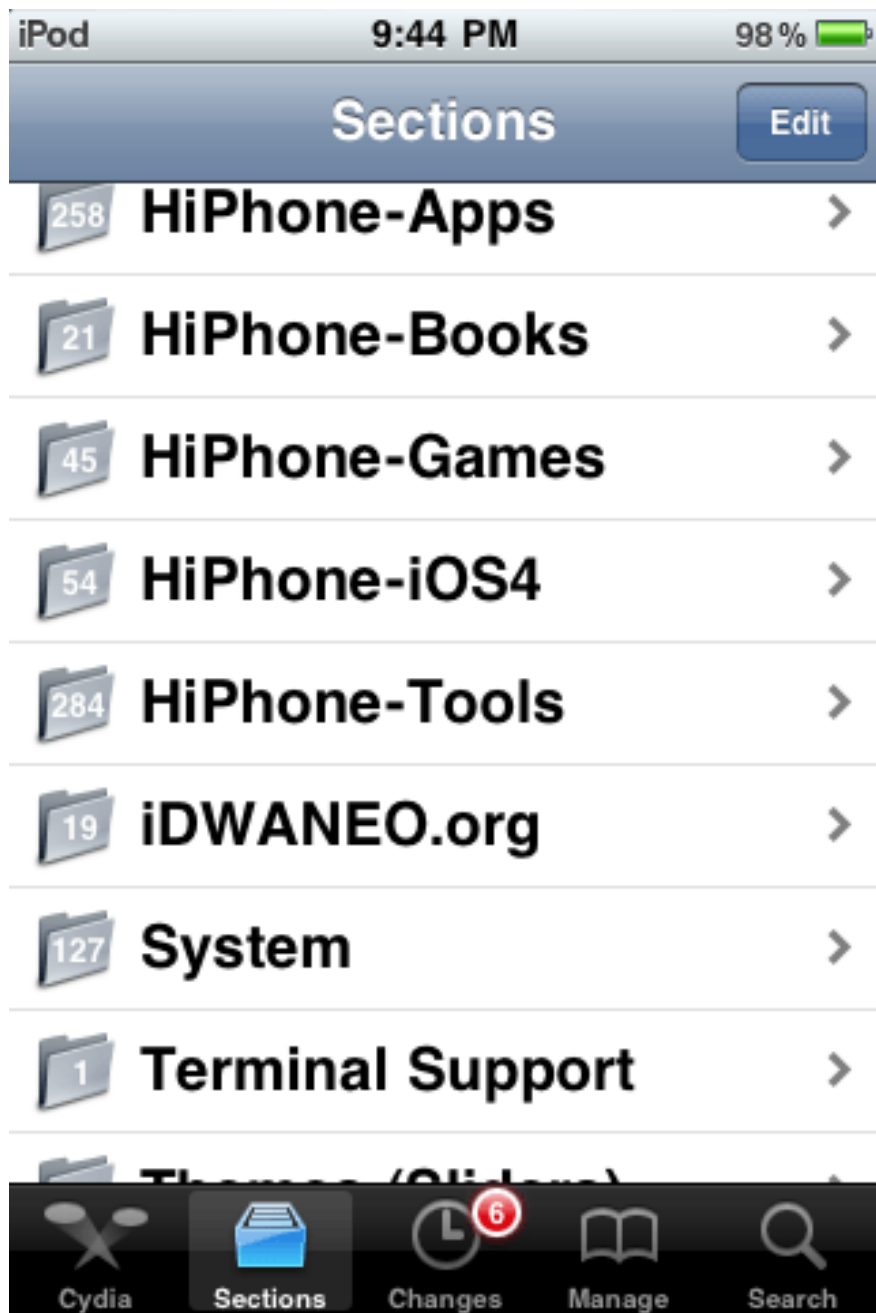
## Delete a source

To delete a source in Cydia, click on **Manage** > **Source** . Then click **Edit** , and you will see a list of sources listed below with a red mark next to it. Click the red mark of the source you want to delete and select **Delete** to delete the application in Cydia.



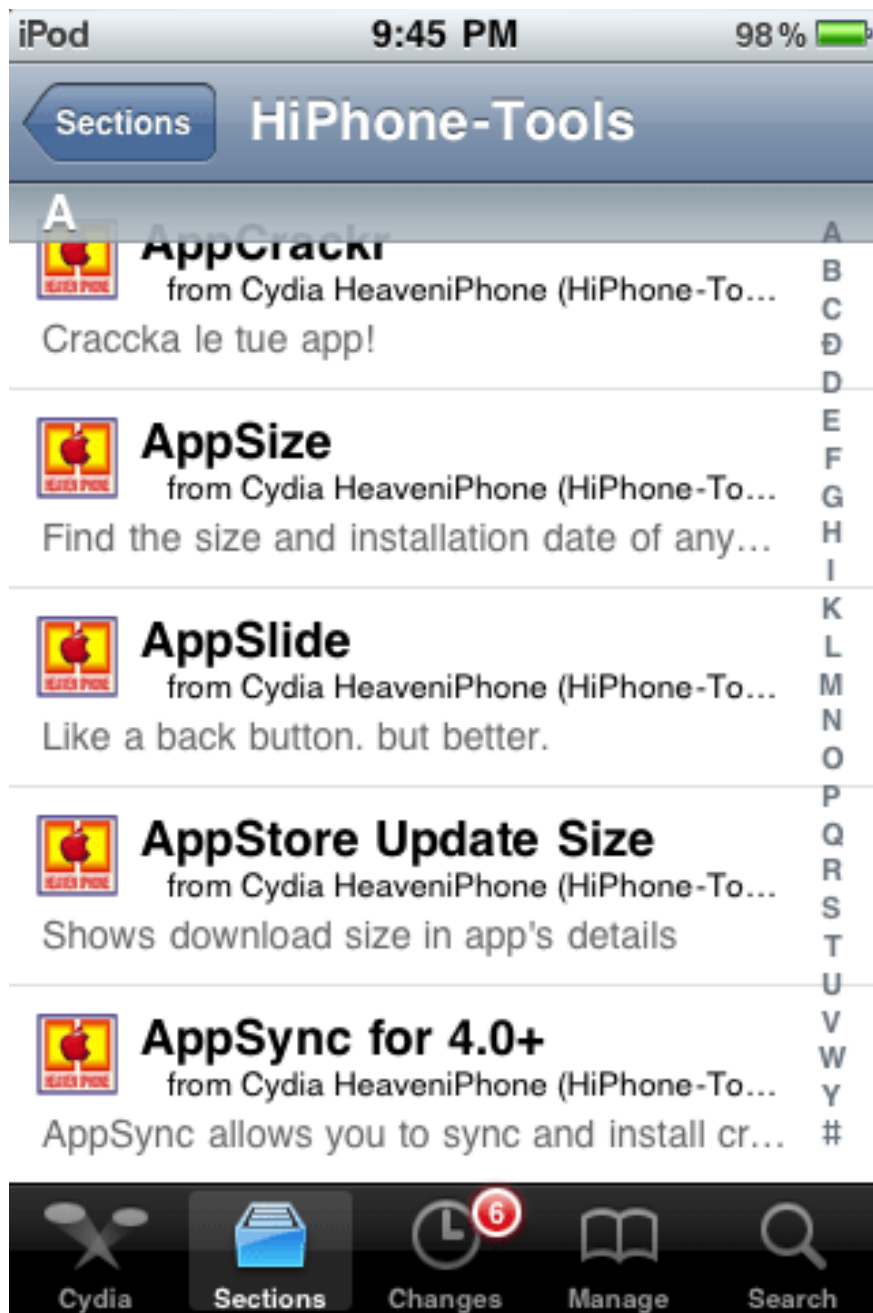
## Install an application

You can view the applications listed in the **Sections** section and then click on a folder you want.

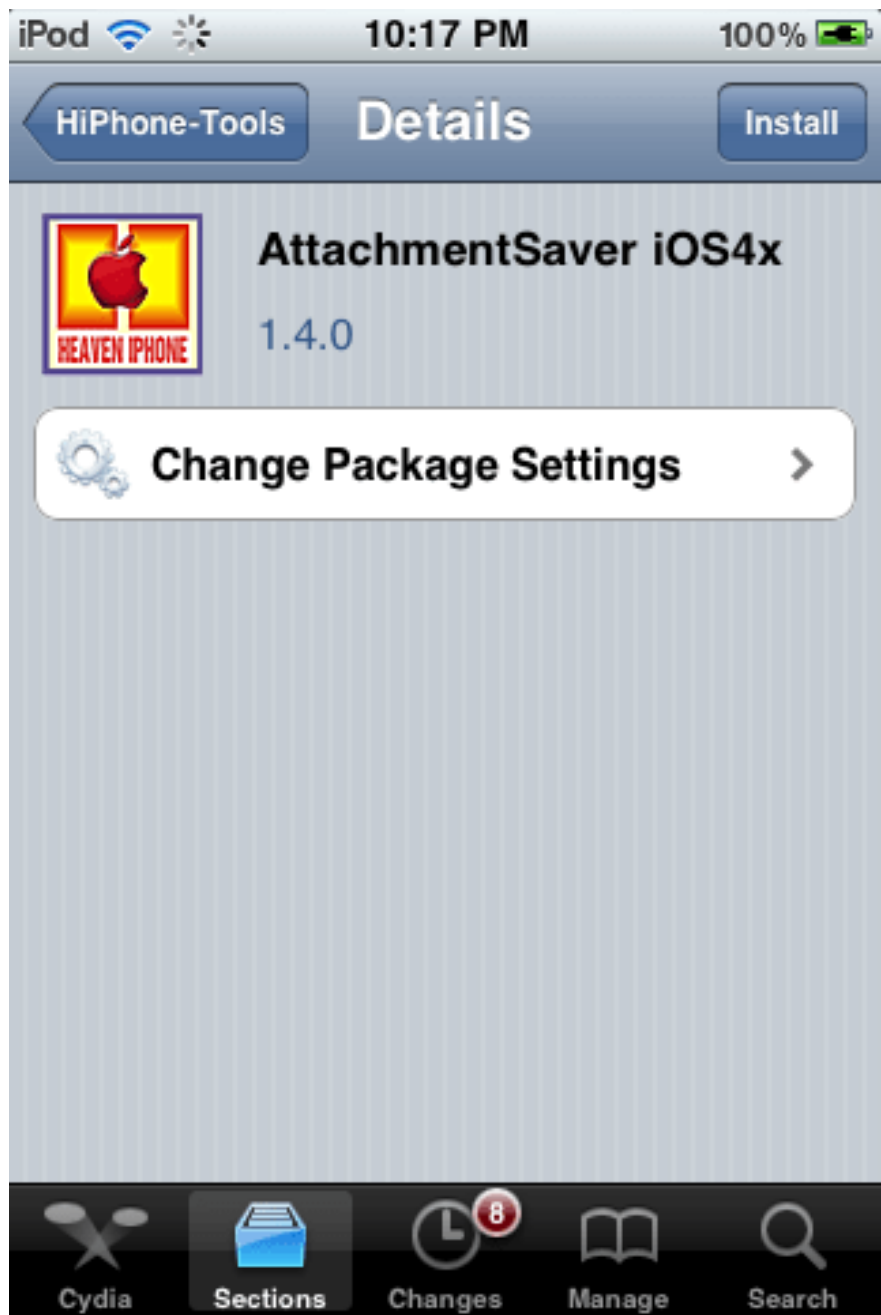

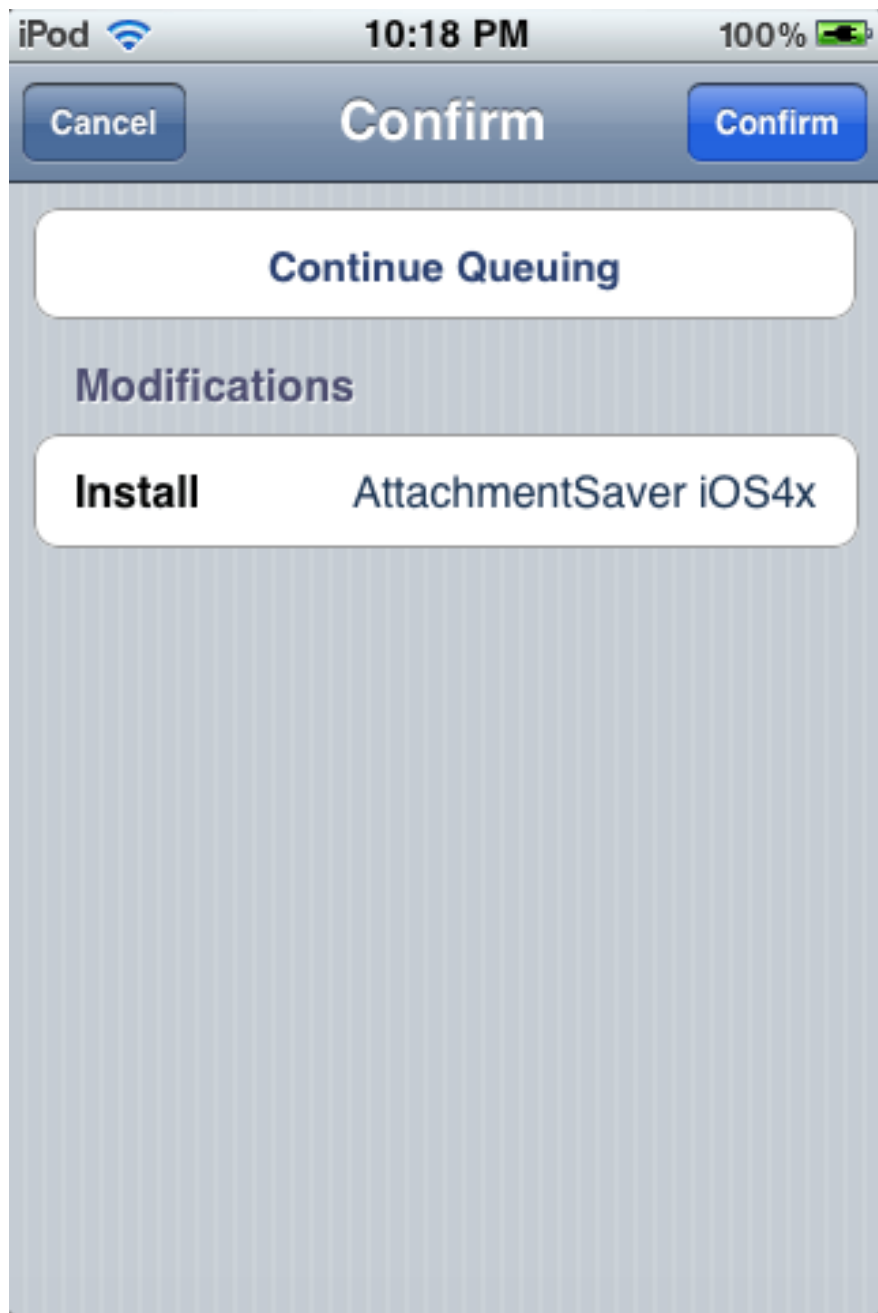
You will see the applications listed in that folder, click an application you want to install.



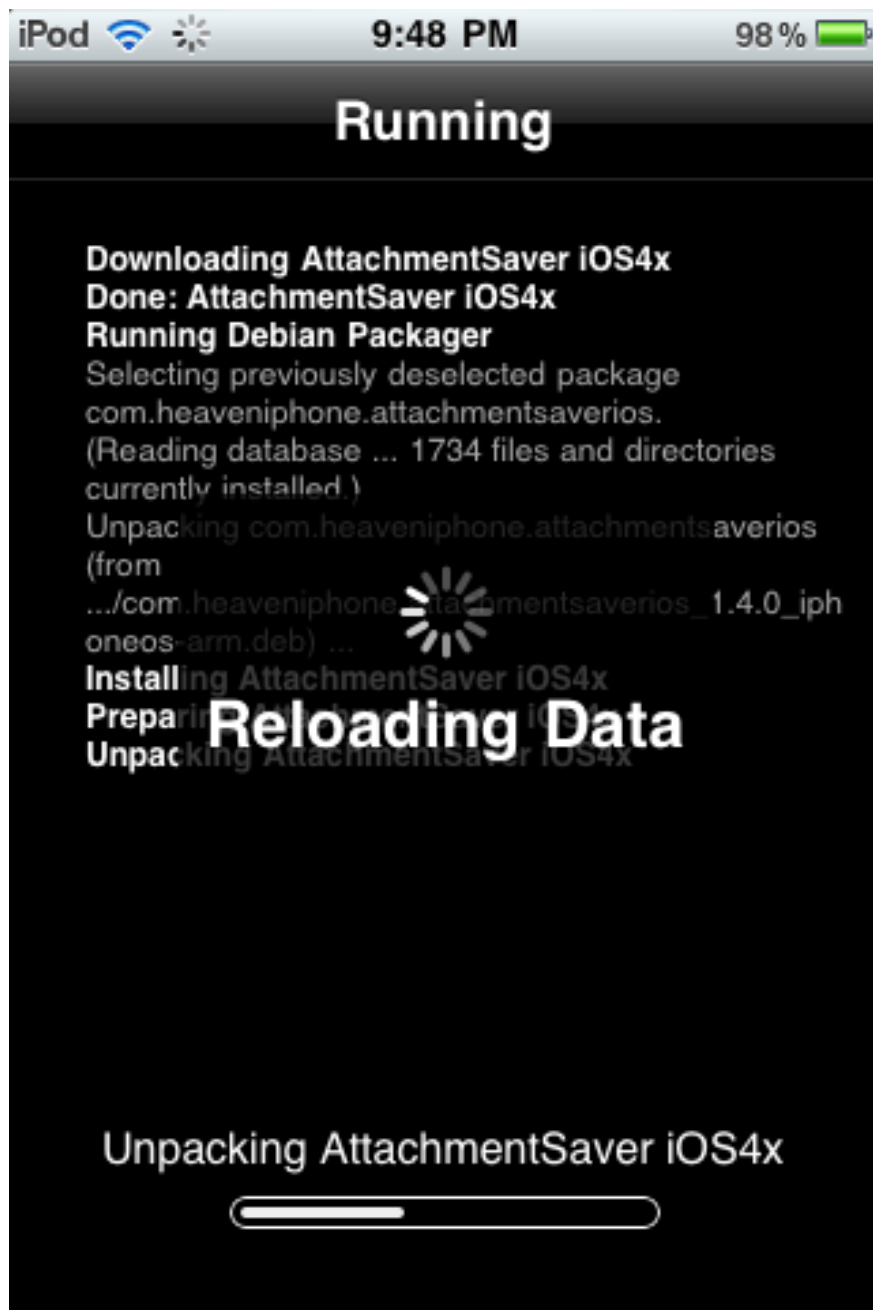
Then click **Install** .



Click **Confirm** to confirm the installation.



Installation will take place.

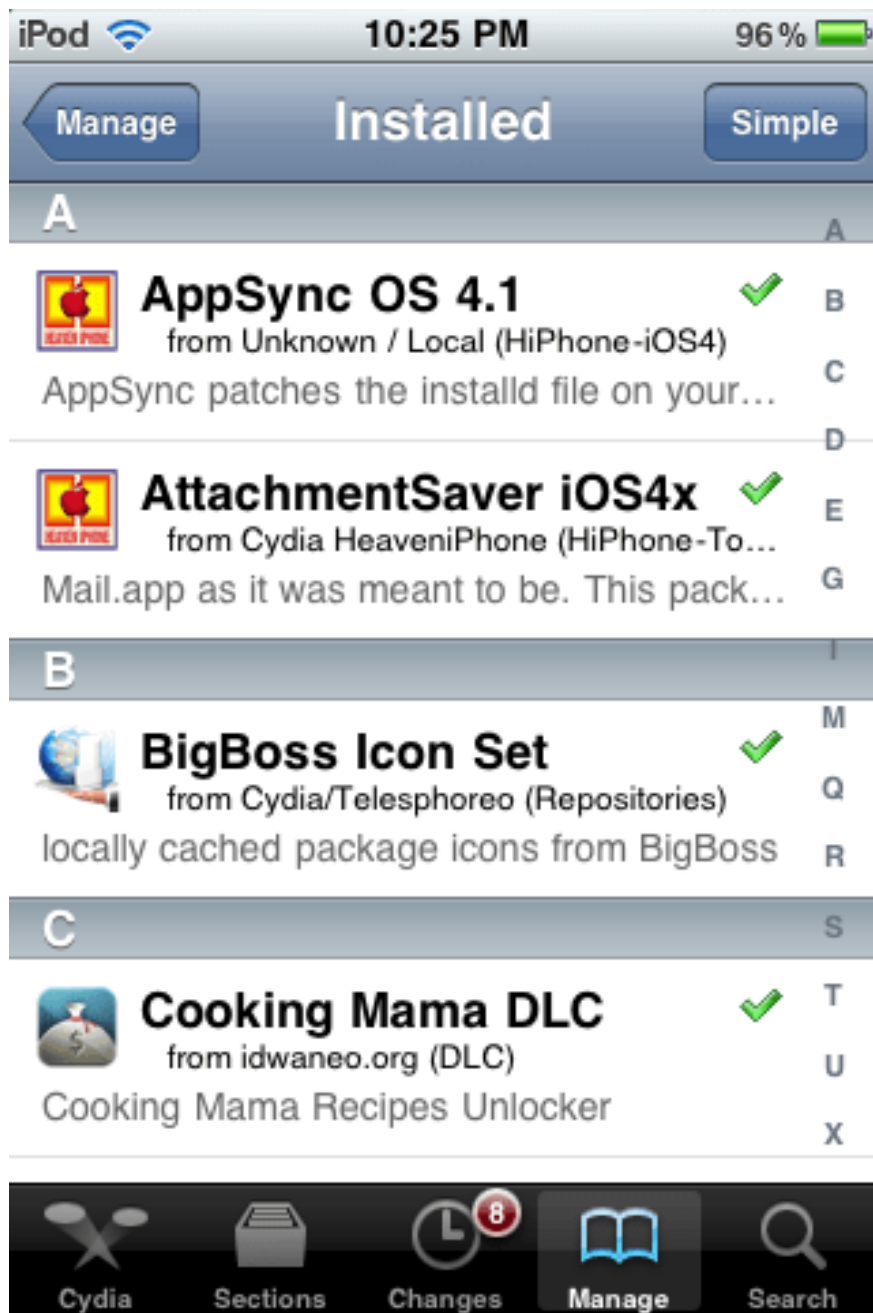


## Delete an application in Cydia

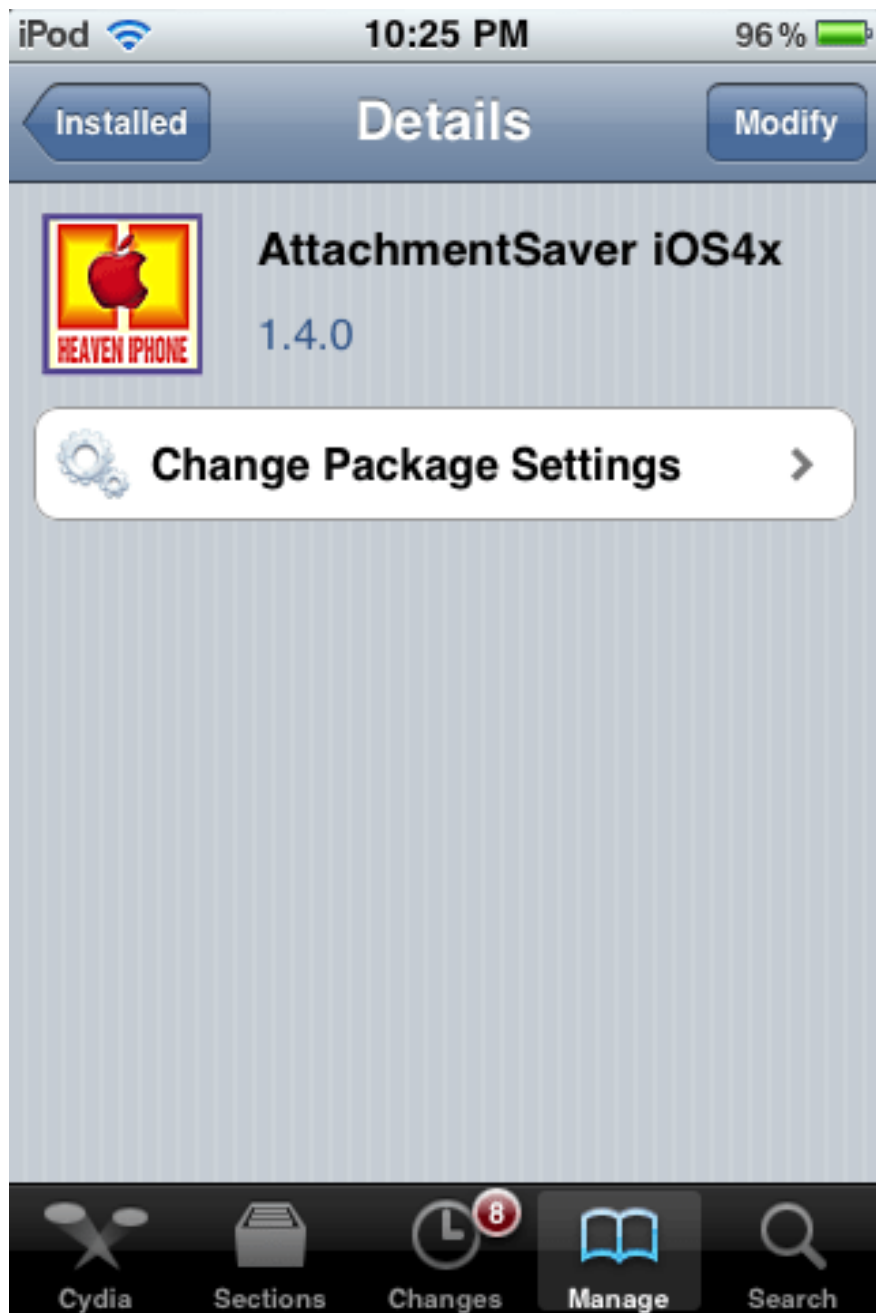
To remove an application in Cydia, go to **Manage > Packages** .



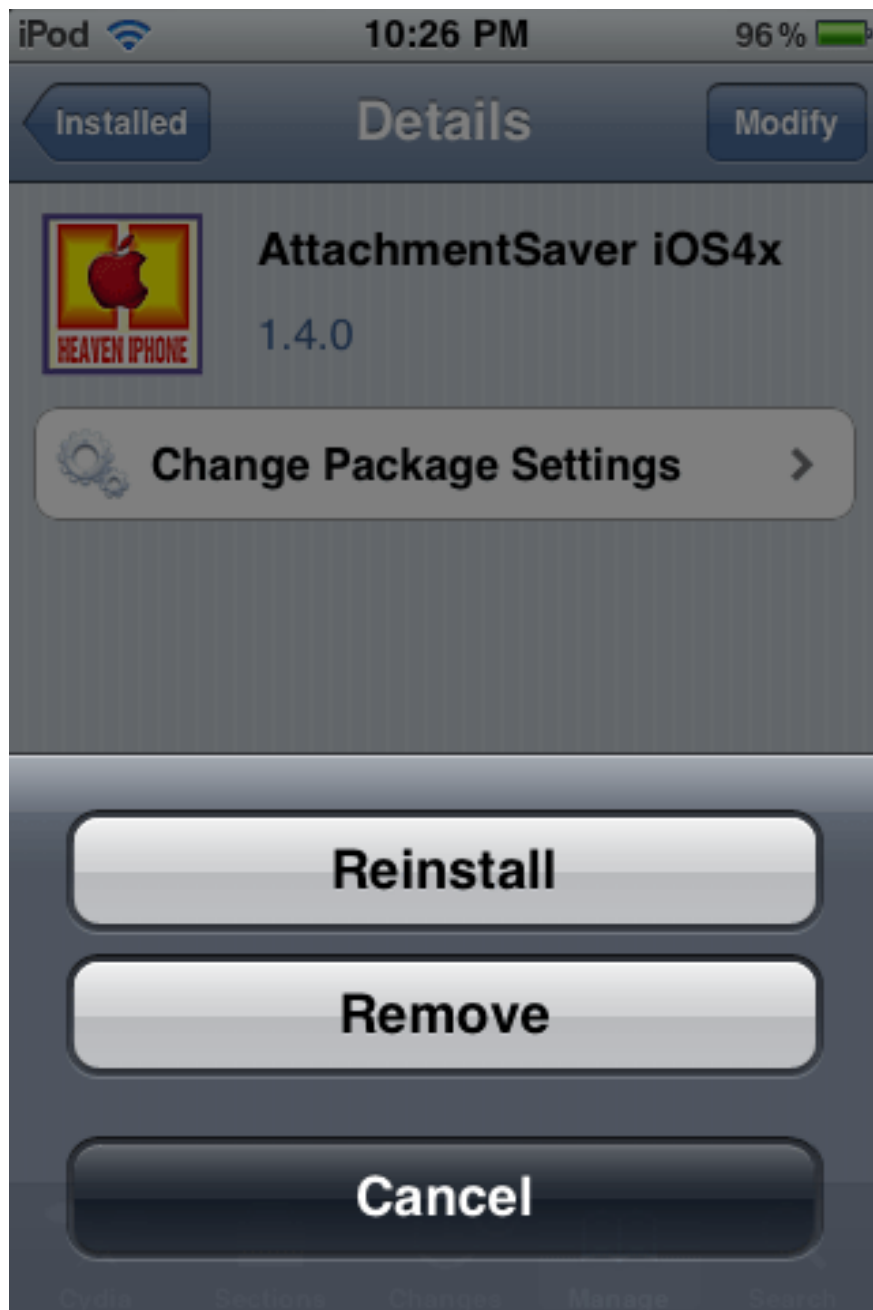
Select the application you want to delete.



Then click **Modify** .

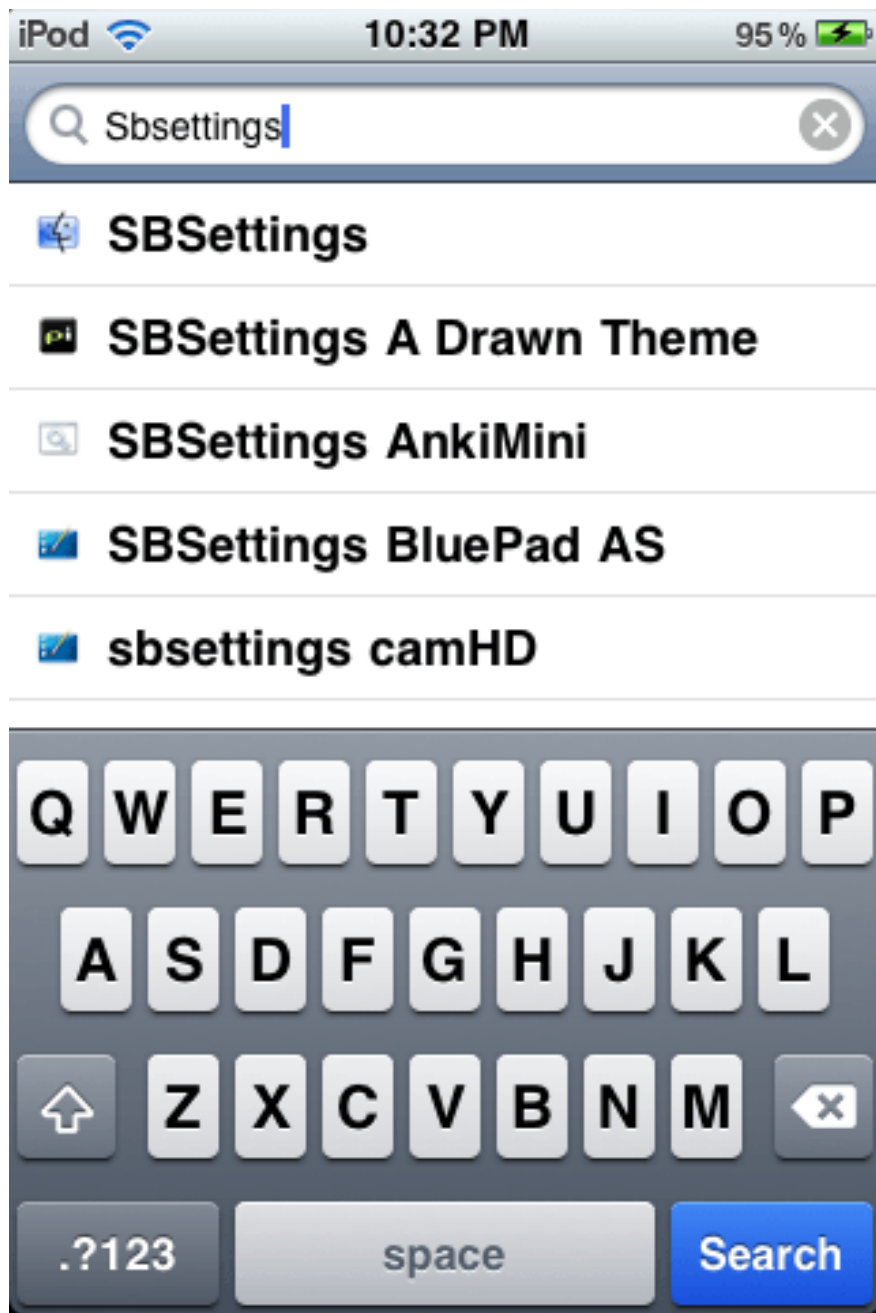


Select **Remove** to remove the application in Cydia.

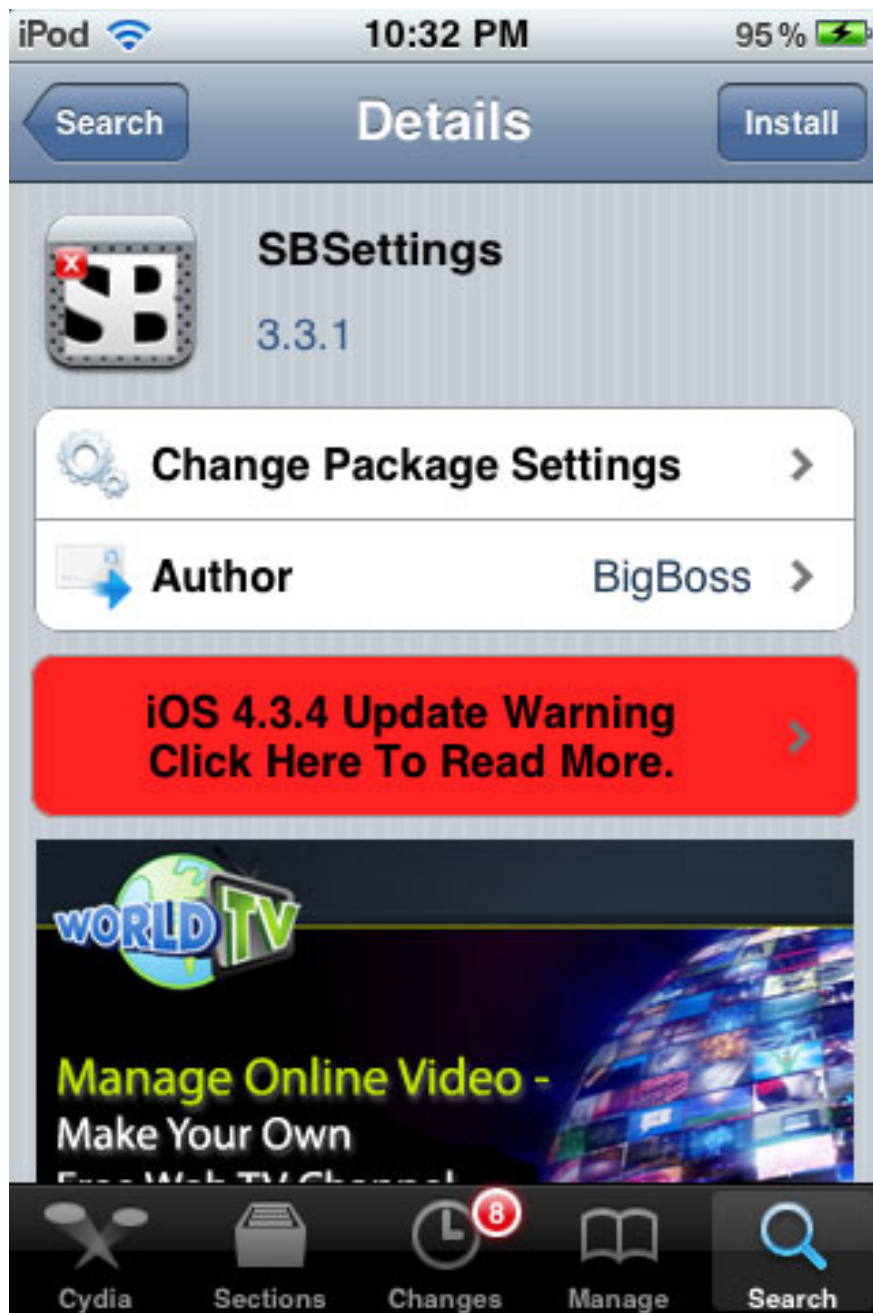


## Search for an application

Finding applications in Cydia is easy, just go to **Search** and type the application name in the search box. For example, if you want to find **SBS**ettings application, type SBS



Click to select the application to install as usual.
