

# How to use the translation feature in Messages on iPhone

The Messages app on iPhone now has the option to translate directly through the translation app without needing to install another supporting app.

The Messages app on iPhone now has the option to translate directly through the translation app without having to install another app to support it. The direct message translation feature currently applies to SMS, MMS, and iMessages. We just need to download the language to the device and then the message is translated in the language you downloaded. Here are instructions for using translation in Messages on iPhone.

## How to use the translation feature in Messages on iPhone

### Step 1:

Go to Settings, select Apps, then click on **the Translate app** . Continue to click on **Downloaded Languages ??** to download the language.



**Step 2:**















Click on **the arrow icon in the language** you want to download and use.



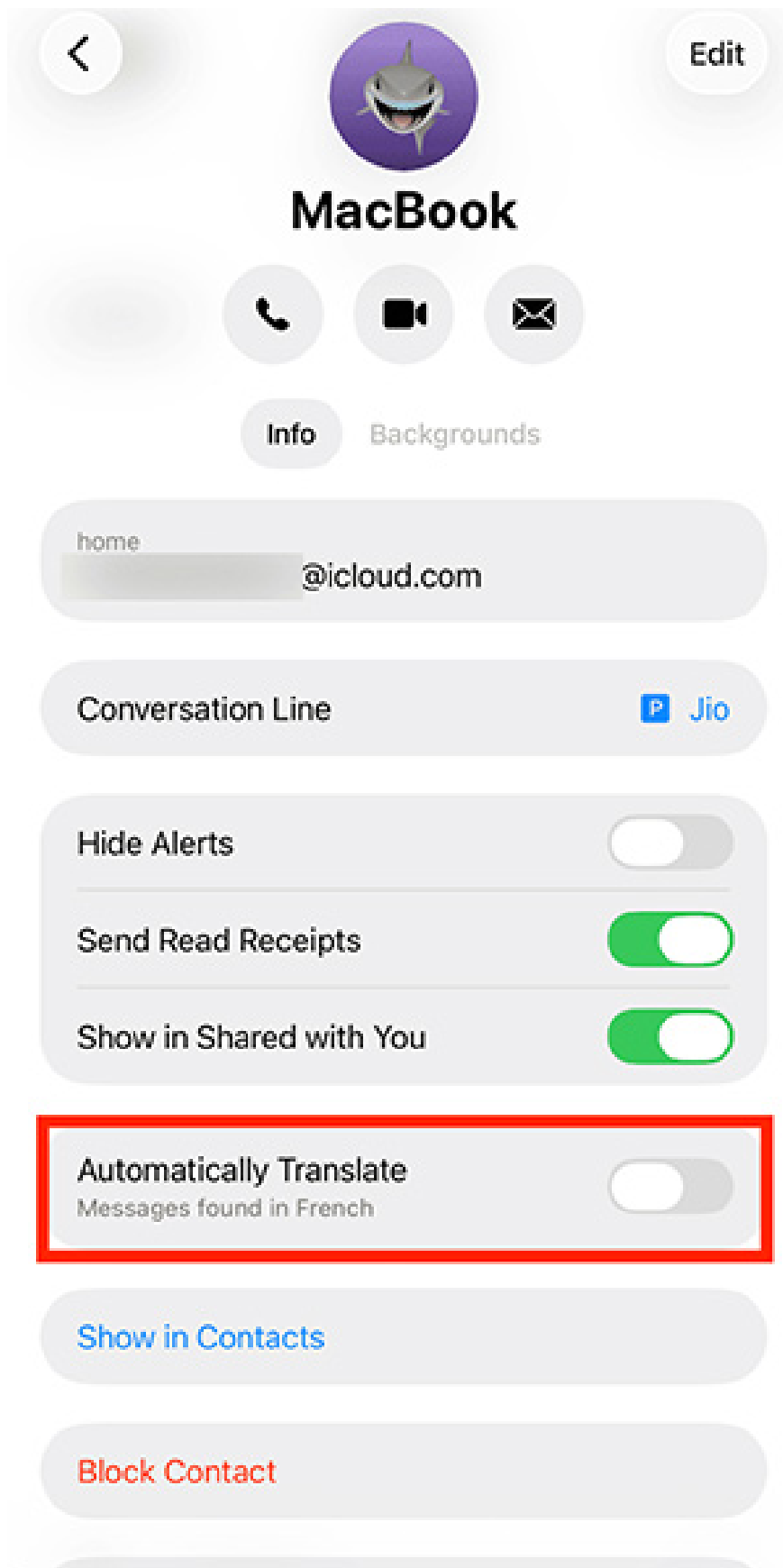
## Manage Languages

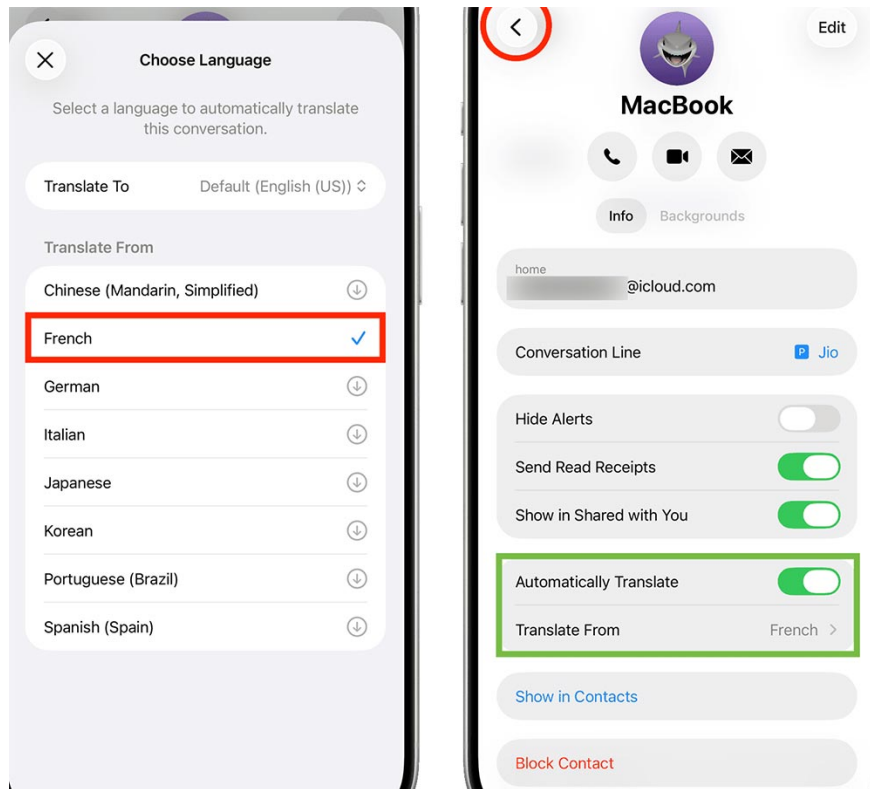

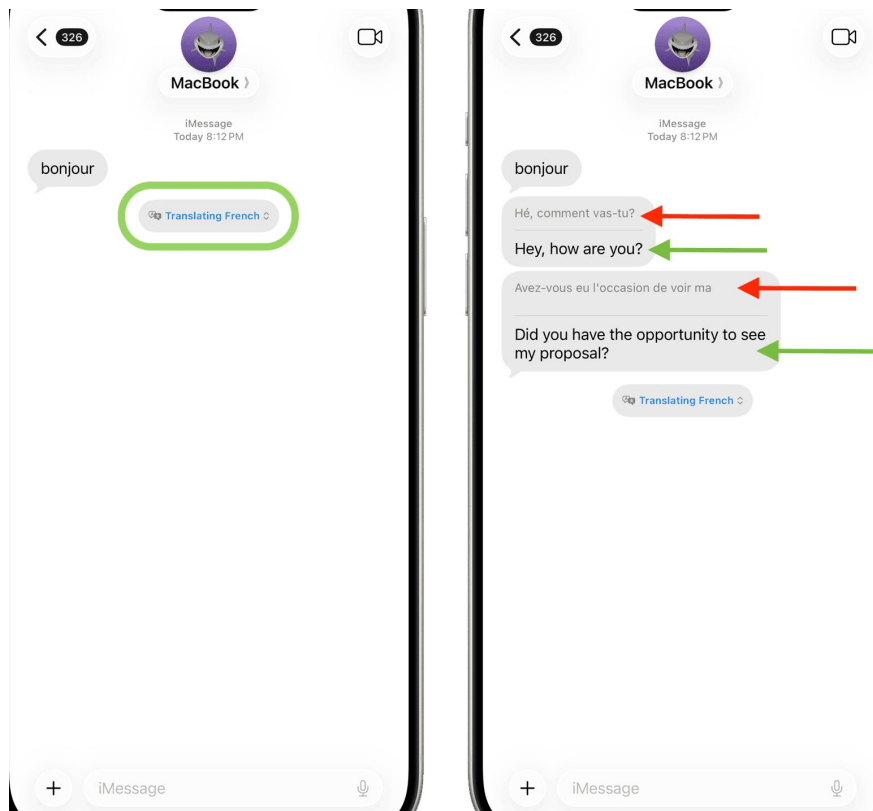
