

# Instructions for using VoiceOver on iPhone

When the VoiceOver feature is activated, you need to know how to use it on your iPhone phone. This feature may initially embarrass you, but you'll quickly get used to it.

When the VoiceOver feature is activated, you need to know how to use it on your iPhone phone. This feature may initially embarrass you, but you'll quickly get used to it.

Here are the main actions you should take into account when using VoiceOver:

- + **Touch an item** , VoiceOver will read the name of the item.
- + **Double click on the item** to open the application.
- + **Use three fingers** to turn pages.

*Tip: If using two or three fingers at the same time is too difficult, you can use one finger in one hand and use one or two fingers on the other. When double-clicking or triple-clicking, you must execute them at the same time and quickly.*



These are additional actions to use VoiceOver.

**Act**

**Purpose**

Swipe left or right

Select the next or previous item

Click the screen with 2 fingers

Stop charging up VoiceOver

Swipe up with two fingers

Automatically read all applications in order from top to bottom

Swipe down with two fingers

Automatically read applications from the current position to the bottom

Use three fingers to swipe up or down

Scroll the page up or down

Use 3 fingers to swipe left or right

Go to the next page on the screen

Tap the screen with three fingers

Read the status of the scroll bar (line 20 of 100)

Use 4 fingers to swipe up or down

Go to the top or bottom of the page

Use 4 fingers to swipe right or left

Go to the previous or next section (on the website)

**Tip:** Check some settings of VoiceOver: select Braille language, Language Rotor; image navigation; Install to receive voice notifications.
