Block websites from opening automatically on Chrome

Step 1: At the Chrome browser interface screen, select the three-dot icon and then click on Settings .

Step 2: Next, select **Privacy & security** and then continue to select **Website settings** as shown below.

Step 3: Scroll down to the bottom of the display page and then click on **Pop-up windows and navigation links**.

Step 4: In the **Blocked (Recommended)** section, swipe the toolbar to the left so that it turns blue to **block the website on Chrome**.

In case you want to allow or block pop-ups from a specific website, click **Add** in the **Allow** or **Block** section and paste the link you want.

With just 4 simple steps above, you can easily block a specific **website** or **many strange websites** from **opening automatically**.

How to block websites on Chrome using Block Site

Besides **the way to block websites on Chrome** introduced above, you can also use Block Site software to **block annoying websites** while surfing the web. This software is rated quite well and can be used on both Chrome or Coc Coc.

How to block strange websites with Block Site is done in 5 simple steps as follows:

Step 1: Open Chrome Extension here: <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/search/Block%20Site?hl=vi> and type the keyword **Block Site** in the search box in the Chrome Web Store.

Step 2: Then click **Add to Chrome** located in the upper right part of the window.

When you click here, a pop-up window will appear at the top of the browser window as shown below.

Step 3: Next, in the new pop-up window that appears, click **Add Extension**.

Step 4: The system will send you a notification asking to allow the software to extend information to the websites you visit. You just need to click on **I Agree**.

Step 5: On the Block Site search bar, **how to block 1 website** or multiple websites by clicking **Add** the website(s) you want to block. To add more websites, click on the green plus sign on the right as shown below.
