Use Command Prompt

Step 1: Select **Start ? Run** or press the **Windows + R** shortcut key combination to open the Run dialog box. Then, type **cmd** into the Run dialog box and press **OK** .

Step 2: When the Command Prompt window appears, type the command ``net stop spooler`` and press Enter to cancel the print command.

Use the Printers and Scanners window.

Steps to follow:

Step 1: Select **Start > Control Panel > Printers or Printers and Scanners** to open the Printers and Scanners window.

Step 2: Right-click and select **Cancel All Documents** to cancel the print job.
