

Instructions on how to clean the mouse pad at home are extremely simple

1. Let's see what type of mouse pad it is

First, you need to determine what type of mouse pad you have. Currently, based on material, characteristics and functions, people will be divided into 3 main lines of mouse pads, including: soft mouse pad, hard mouse pad and gaming mouse pad (usually with lights on the edge of the mouse pad).

2. Material that makes up the mouse pad

Material is also an important factor that you need to keep in mind. Find out what material your mouse pad is made of to have an effective cleaning method and minimize possible risks. Because you cannot clean a cloth pad with a rough brush and strong rubbing movements. Otherwise, your pad will lose its friction and greatly affect your future experience.

Similarly, you need to know whether the material of the mouse pad is plastic or fabric to have the right way to clean it.

3. Color of Mouse Pad

A good, high-priced mouse pad will often bring an eye-catching appearance and high color fastness. Of course, compared to a cheap mouse pad, an expensive product will help you spend less effort in cleaning and maintaining the color. However, you should also clean it thoroughly, meticulously and properly to avoid affecting the color of the mouse pad.

On the contrary, poor quality mouse pad models may 'discolor' when cleaned. At that time, you can only accept or clean gently and carefully and reduce the frequency of cleaning the Mouse Pad to limit this situation.

4. When to clean the Mouse Pad

People often set a fixed cleaning time or frequency for themselves, such as once a year or once a week. However, if cleaned too often, the mouse pad can be affected on the surface, while cleaning every year creates conditions for bacteria and dirt to accumulate over time. Therefore, it is best to clean it once a month to ensure the newness and cleanliness of the mouse pad.

In addition, you can also clean the Mouse Pad if you notice that the mouse surface is no longer smooth, the Pad is discolored and older than before, or has a lot of food, dirt, etc.

How to clean the mouse pad effectively?

As mentioned above, each type of mouse pad will have a separate cleaning method. Therefore, you need to classify correctly and follow the instructions shared below.

1. How to clean the soft mouse pad

Soft mouse pad is the most commonly used and popular type of mouse pad today. This product has a number of outstanding advantages such as: Low price, can be rolled and folded compactly without breaking or tearing, has diverse sizes and many colors,. However, compared to hard mouse pads, Pads Soft mice will have poorer quality and durability, especially those with low prices.

Things to know before cleaning the soft mouse pad

Soft mouse pads often get dirty very easily. In addition, because it is mainly made from fabric, durability is not highly appreciated. Therefore, you need to avoid cleaning the soft mouse pad with strong detergents such as bleach, strong detergent, etc. Otherwise, the Pad may fray and unravel, affecting the user experience.

Instead, you should use gentler cleaning products such as shampoo, conditioner, shower gel, dishwashing liquid, etc. to avoid negative effects on the product.

Prepare supplies

Materials needed to clean the Mouse Pad will include: Clean water, mild cleaning solution (shampoo, shower gel, dishwashing liquid), soft brush and dry towel.

Steps to clean the soft mouse pad

1. **Step 1:** Place the Mouse Pad in the washing basin or sink and add clean water to wet the Mouse Pad.
2. **Step 2:** Take a little dishwashing liquid (or shower gel, shampoo, etc.) and put it in the mouse pad.
3. **Step 3:** Rub the entire mouse pad surface gently with a brush.
4. **Step 4:** Rinse with water, then wrap around the mouse pad with a dry towel.
5. **Step 5:** Spread and dry the Mouse Pad in the shade, avoiding direct sunlight.

2. How to clean the hard mouse pad

The hard mouse pad is made from aluminum fiber, hard plastic or fiberglass. With the above material, this product will have higher quality and durability. At the same time, hard mouse pads are also loved for their ability to provide a solid, precise mouse feel. However, most of these types of mouse pads on the market are quite expensive, so their popularity will not be as popular as soft pads.

Things to know before cleaning the hard mouse pad

Hard mouse pads are usually made from liquid-absorbent materials. Accordingly, this product will not absorb water or sweat. This makes cleaning the hard mouse pad much simpler and easier.

Prepare supplies

To clean the hard mouse pad, you need to prepare warm water, a soft towel, detergent (detergent, shampoo, shower gel, dishwashing liquid), sponge brush or soft brush.

Steps to clean the hard mouse pad

1. **Step 1:** Put the mouse pad in a bowl with warm water mixed with detergent.
2. **Step 2:** Rub the mouse pad surface and can scrub vigorously if desired.
3. **Step 3:** Rinse with clean water until soap is completely removed.
4. **Step 4:** Drain the water and let it dry and you're done.

3. How to clean Gaming mouse pads

Gaming mouse pads are specially designed mouse pads aimed at the main customers who are gamers and professional Esport players. Therefore, manufacturers of this type of Pad focus on quality to bring the best experience to gamers.

Things to know before cleaning the Gaming Mouse Pad

Today's top famous Gaming Mouse Pad brands will all be equipped with many modern effects and technologies such as: RGB light strips around the edge, wireless charging.

Therefore, when cleaning the Gaming Mouse Pad, you need to follow the instructions below, otherwise you will accidentally affect the microchips in the Mouse Pad.

In particular, do not immerse the Gaming Mouse Pad directly in water, otherwise the Pad will lose its charging ability and damage the eye-catching light strip it possesses.

Prepare supplies

You need to prepare some items as follows: Mild detergent dish soap (or shower gel, shampoo.), warm water and a soft towel.

Steps to clean Gaming Mouse Pad

1. **Step 1:** First, you have to unplug the RGB touchpad.
2. **Step 2:** Dip a soft cloth in warm water and wring it until there is only moisture, then use the towel to clean the mouse pad surface.
3. **Step 3:** Continue to dip the soft cloth in soapy water and wring it until it is still slightly damp to wipe thoroughly again. This step will help remove persistent dirt such as grease, dirt, etc.
4. **Step 4:** Rinse the soft towel with warm water until the soap is gone and continue squeezing until slightly damp. At this point, you continue to clean the surface and can repeat the above steps if necessary to completely clean the mouse pad surface.
5. **Step 5:** Leave the mouse pad to dry on a flat surface and slightly facing up for a few hours.
