

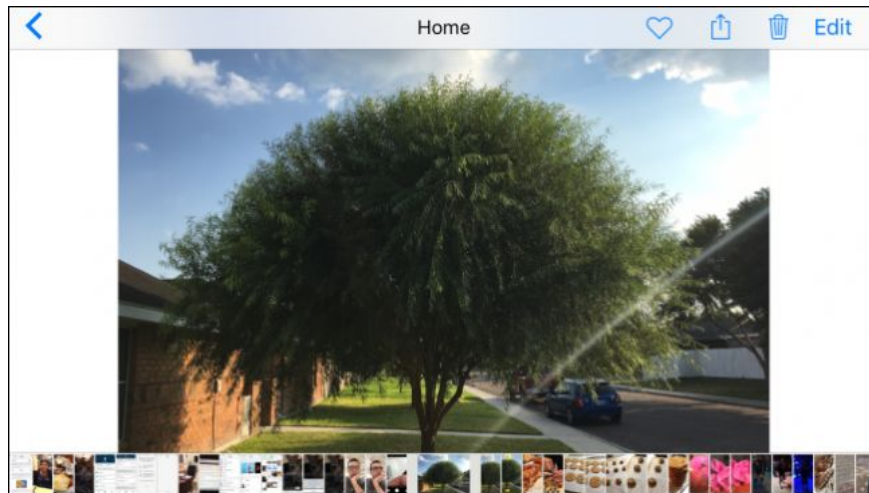
# Instructions on how to convert Live Photos to still images on iPhone

**Live Photos** is one of the new features introduced by **Apple** on **iOS 9** . This feature allows users to view extremely vivid images. However, **Live Photos** can only be shared with **iOS 9 devices** together.

First, open **Live Photo** in the **Photos app** (photo) on your **iPhone** phone. Then click "**Edit**" in the top right corner.



On the phone screen you will see the **Live Photo** image displayed as a still image. To convert a **Live Photo** image to a still image, click the icon located in the bottom left corner of the image.



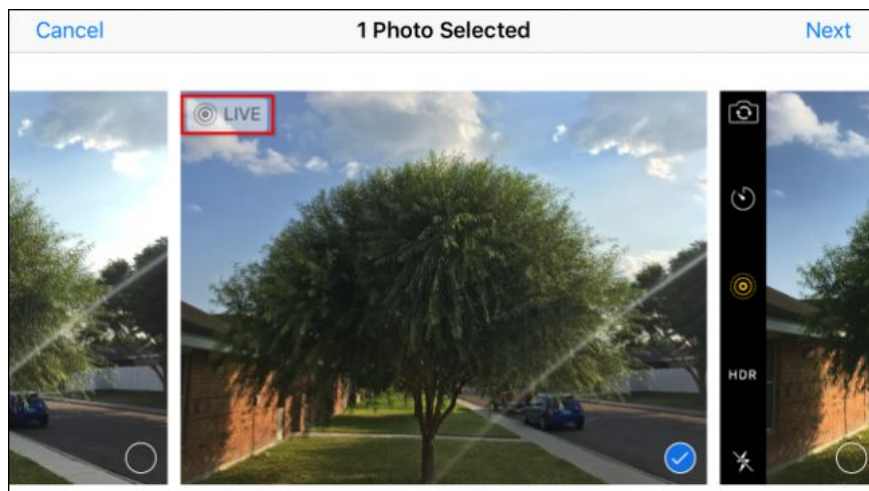
Then click on the **Live Photos** icon, click next to select "**Done**" button to save the image to a static form.



If you want the photo to return to **Live Photos** , you can click the "**Revert**" button, or simply click the **Live Photos** icon again, then press "**Done**" to finish. process.



After completing the steps, **Live Photos** will be converted to still images, just like a normal photo but with a smaller size. You can share static images for anyone you want.
