

Instructions on how to cut video with VLC Player simple and fast

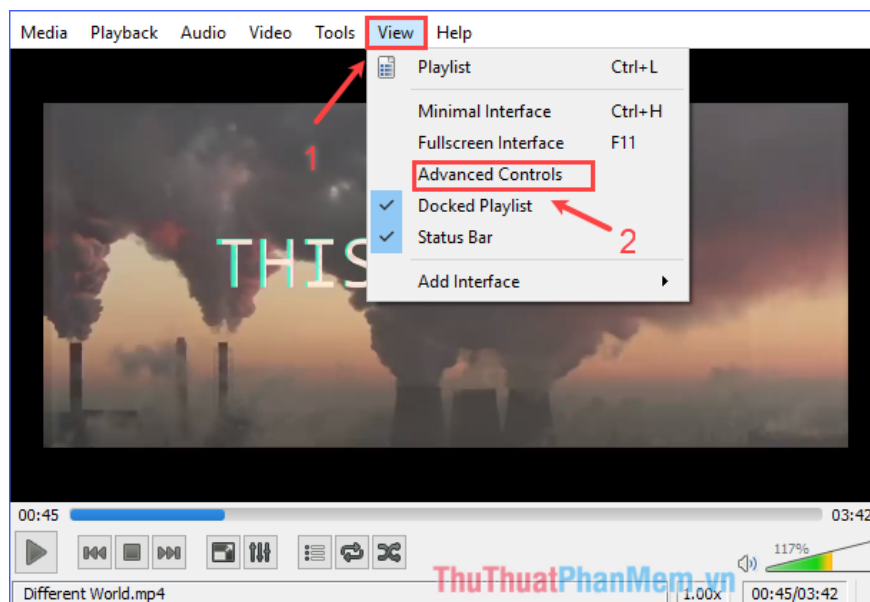

(If you do not have VLC, you can download it here, please choose the correct 32-bit or 64-bit version.)

Step 1: Open the video to be cut with VLC.

Step 2: Select **View > Advanced Controls** .



Step 3: At the beginning of the video you want to cut, click the **Record** button (start recording).

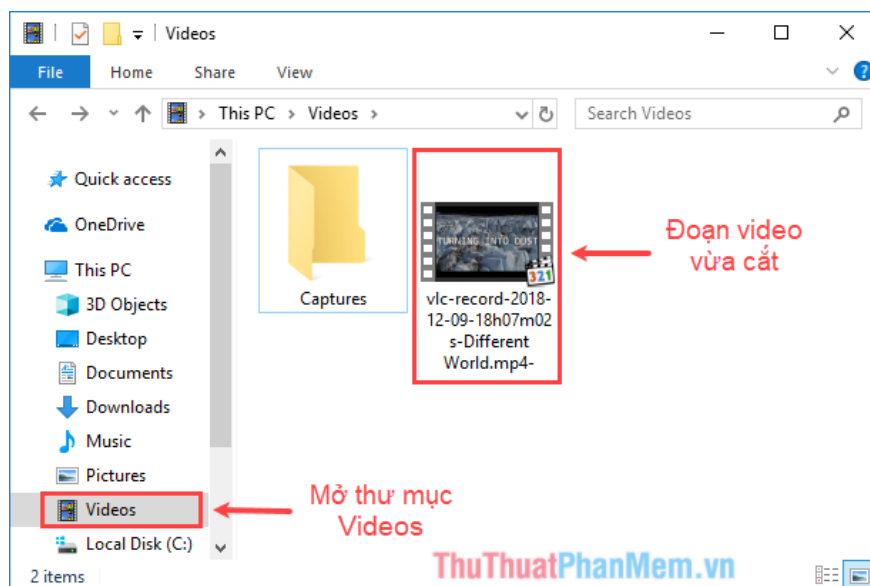


Step 4: At the end of the video you want to cut, click the **Record** button (finish recording).



As the two pictures above, I started to cut from the time 00:45 and finish cutting at the time of 00:50, ie the cut out video will last 5 seconds.

Step 5: Navigate to the Videos folder, here you can see your results.



This way, you can also cut multiple segments continuously while still playing the video. Just click the Record button at the beginning and end of each cut.
