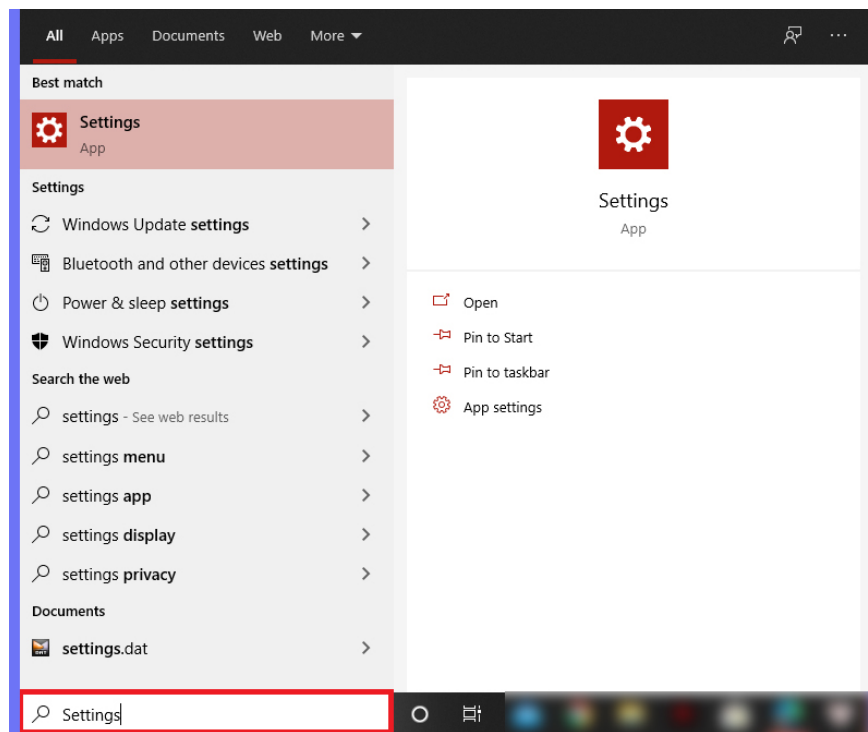
Bluetooth connectivity has become much more common thanks to the convenience it brings to modern life. As a result, enabling Bluetooth on devices has also become simpler.



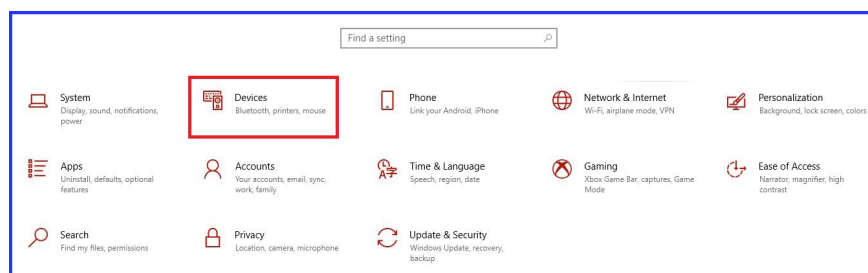
How to enable Bluetooth on Windows 10

First, we'll learn how to enable Bluetooth on a laptop or PC running Windows 10.

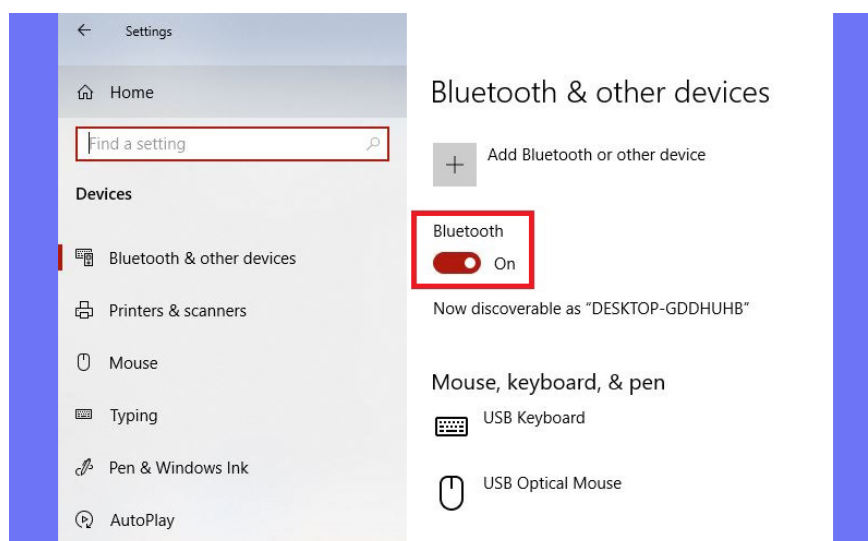
Step 1: Open the settings window by accessing Windows (bottom left corner of the screen)/Settings (gear icon). Alternatively, you can type "Settings" into the search box on Windows 10.



Step 2: Select the Devices section.



Step 3: In the Bluetooth & other devices section, you will see Bluetooth and an option to turn it on or off. Simply toggle the switch to the right to turn Bluetooth on in Windows 10.



Alternatively, you can quickly enable Bluetooth so that your computer automatically connects to the paired device by going to the Notifications section and clicking the dialog box in the bottom right corner of the screen.

If you don't see Bluetooth here, the shortcut might be hidden. You can enable it by right-clicking on the Notifications section and selecting Edit, then adding Bluetooth.

Instructions for pairing a Windows 10 computer and a wireless device for the first time.

Step 1: Turn on Bluetooth on your wireless device. Make sure it's not connected to any other devices at that time.

Step 2: On your Windows 10 computer, open the Bluetooth & other devices settings (similar to steps 1 to 3 above). Then select Add Bluetooth or other device.

Step 3: A window will pop up; select Bluetooth. The computer will automatically search for nearby Bluetooth-enabled devices to pair with.

Turn on Bluetooth on your smart TV.

First, you need to make sure that your TV supports Bluetooth connectivity.

Each manufacturer offers a different interface for their TVs. However, generally, to enable Bluetooth on a TV, users simply need to look in the Settings menu.
