

# Instructions on how to properly wash warm clothes and winter jackets

Winter clothes are often very thick and made from materials that are difficult to wash and store, so to properly wash and store warm clothes and winter clothes, remember to follow the following article!

Are you having difficulty washing when the weather starts to move? Especially for fabrics that cannot be washed by washing machines such as wool, leather, leather, etc. Please refer to the following article to learn how to wash warm clothes, durable winter jackets and properly at home

## 1. The velvet coat

This is a fabric that is at risk of being ruffled and discolored, easy to catch dust and stick to fibers, so when washing clothes in velvet, to achieve the best washing effect, you should follow the following method:

**Step 1 :** You need preliminary treatment for clean coat and dust before washing.

Put the shirt on a solid surface, then use a soft cloth or sponge that has been soaked in water below 45 degrees (if it is too hot to damage the fabric), squeeze the water down, put a towel on the shirt and gently soak it to dirt clinging to the towel.



**Step 2 :** Wash the towels when the towels are dirty and repeat several times to ensure the removal of dirt and hairs from the coat and proceed with washing as usual.

**Note :** Do not wash together with cotton, yarn, to avoid the hairs sticking to the washing process.

## 2. Leather jacket

Most young people are possessing a leather jacket, both keeping warm and extremely stylish. However, not everyone knows how to properly wash the leather jacket so that it can be long-lasting.

The advice for you is to absolutely not soak, wash with soap or wash the machine. Clean your leather jacket with these simple steps:

**Step 1 :** You just need to use a towel soaked in warm water (not too hot) to clean the stains on your shirt.



**Step 2 :** Brush again with a soft soap-soaked brush, gently manipulate to avoid scratching the fabric.



**Step 3 :** Wipe with clean water.

So you've finished washing your leather jacket, extremely simple and fast without worrying about damage.

**Note :** Leather shirt after washing, should be dried in the shade, there is plenty of cool air, should not be exposed directly to the harsh sun to avoid damaging the shirt.

### 3. Fur coat

The coat is one of the "difficult queen" in winter, if not careful when washing, it is likely that the shirt will be deformed and you cannot wear it again. Please apply the following method to avoid that situation.

**Step 1 :** Soak the clothes in cold water before washing for about 20 minutes.



**Step 2 :** Squeeze and continue to soak in 35 degree water and mix washing powder for about 5-10 minutes to penetrate the detergent.



**Step 3** : Place the coat on a hard surface and use a soft brush to brush the fur from inside to outside. Perform alternating soaking and brushing several times in a row to achieve the best effect and then rinse with water.



**Note** : You will need to perform a downward and extremely gentle brushing operation to avoid ruffling, shedding and damage to the hair.

## **4. Life jacket**

Life jackets are made of water-proof materials so it is best to wash them effectively as follows:

**Step 1** : Soak the clothes with warm water for about 10 minutes, soaked in the shirt and the dirty stains.

**Step 2** : Wash again with liquid soap with soap (about 35 degrees) and then perform as normal washing.



**Note :** For this type of shirt, you should only lightly scratch, avoid squeezing or rubbing strongly because it may damage the water repellent to damage the shirt.
