

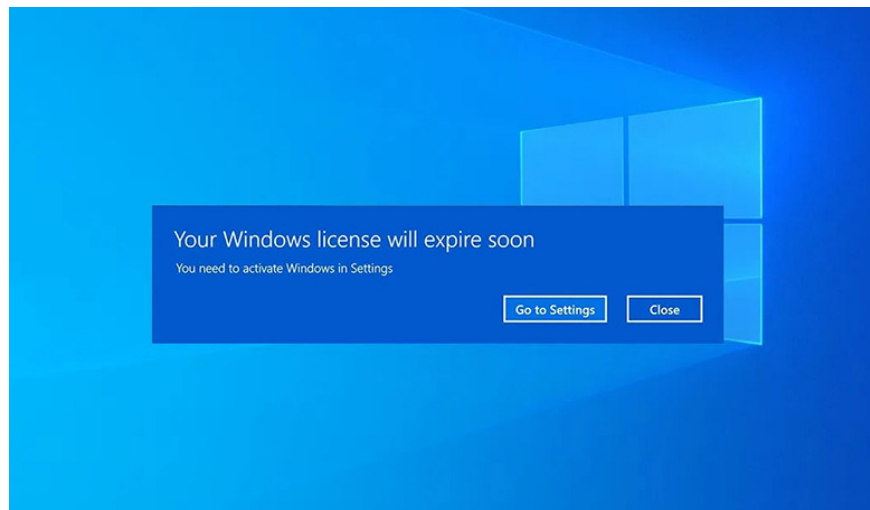
Instructions on how to quickly fix the error your windows license will expire soon

The error your windows license will expire soon is a common error on the windows operating system. Find out more details with HACOM here.

When using Windows operating system, you may encounter the annoying message " **your windows license will expire soon** ". This often causes anxiety and confusion for users because they may not know the cause and how to solve the problem quickly and easily. What is the problem when the screen shows your windows license will expire soon?

The message " **Your windows license will expire soon** " is one of the messages that often appears on Windows 10 when users start the operating system and access the screen interface.

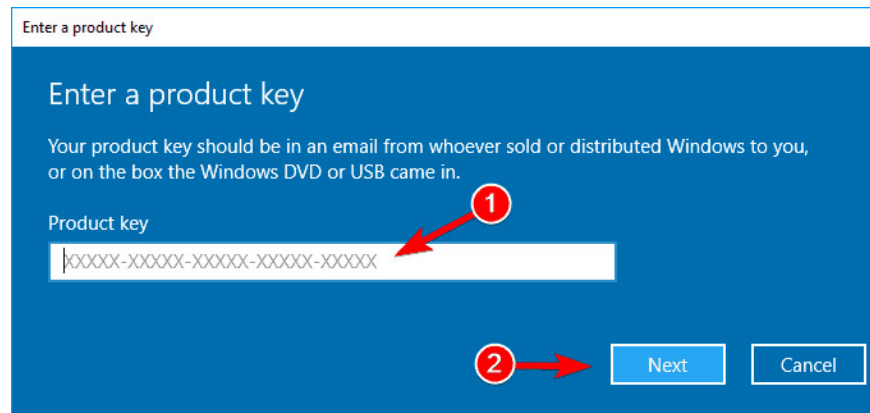


Many people often try to close this message, but often see it appear again shortly after, causing annoyance to users. However, this error is not too worrying. This message is simply a warning that your Windows license is about to expire, suggesting you to reactivate to continue using it.

Cause of the error your windows license will expire soon

There are a number of reasons why you might see the " **your windows license will expire soon** " message on your computer, including:

License Expiration: If your computer has been upgraded from Windows 7, 8, or 8.1 to Windows 10 via a one-year free trial, this message will appear when the license period has ended. This indicates that your computer needs to be updated to a new version of the Windows operating system to continue using it.



Problem with activation: In case you install Windows 10 without a product key or license, you can only use the free trial for 30 days. When the period expires, the error message "your Windows License Will Expire Soon" will appear.

Hardware changes : When you change major hardware components on your computer, such as **the motherboard** or **CPU** , the Windows operating system may identify your computer as a new device and ask you to reactivate your license.

How to fix the error your windows license will expire soon effectively

To fix the error your windows license will expire soon on your computer, you can try the following solutions.

In case you have a genuine Windows key

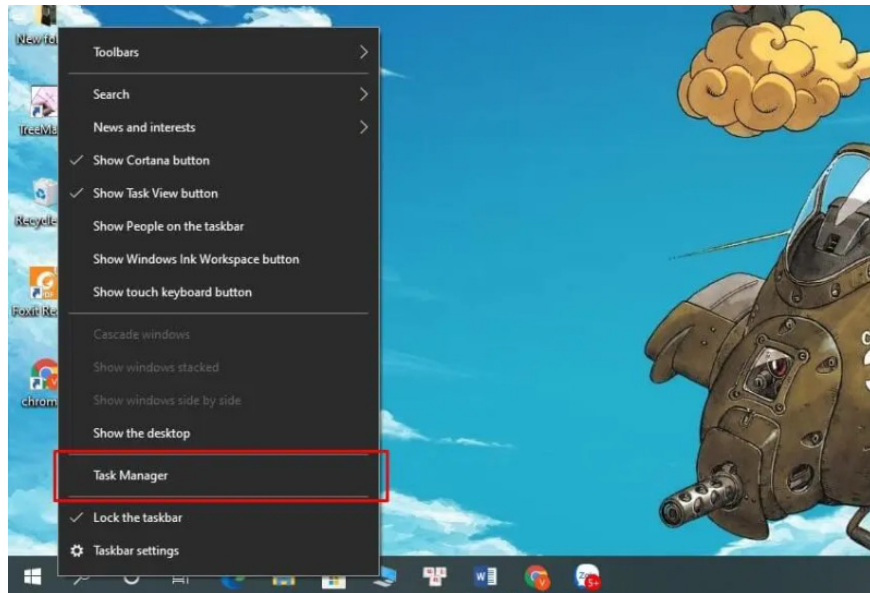
If you bought a new computer with a genuine Windows 10 license pre-installed and you get the above message, it may be because your key has expired or has been rejected. In this case, you should contact the store where you bought the computer for support.

If you have a genuine Windows key, try activating Windows again by entering the key. If you don't have a genuine Windows key and are using a trial/temporary version, disabling the your windows license will expire soon notification will not activate Windows, it will just make the notification disappear.

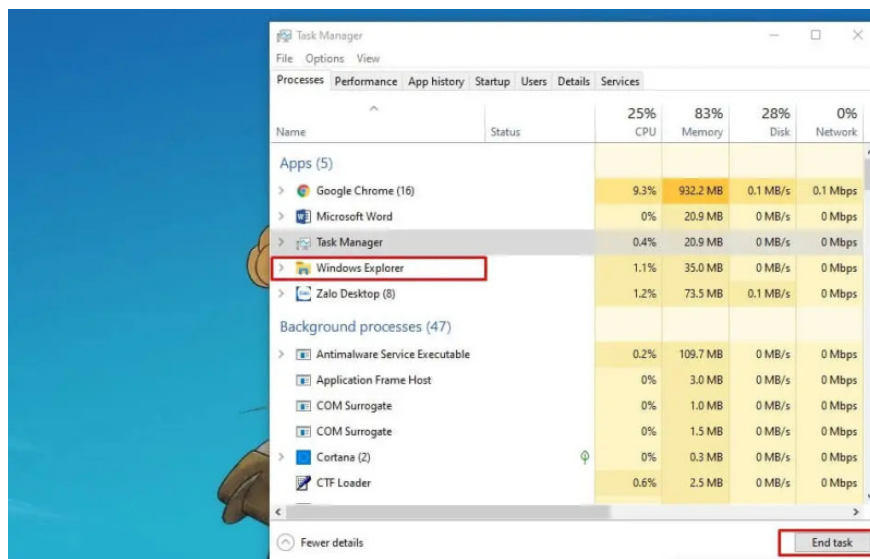
Restart Windows Explorer

To fix the error **your windows license will expire soon** on Windows, you can try restarting Windows Explorer. Here are the specific instructions:

Press the Ctrl, Alt and Del keys at the same time or right-click on the Taskbar to display the corresponding menu. Select "Task Manager" from that menu.

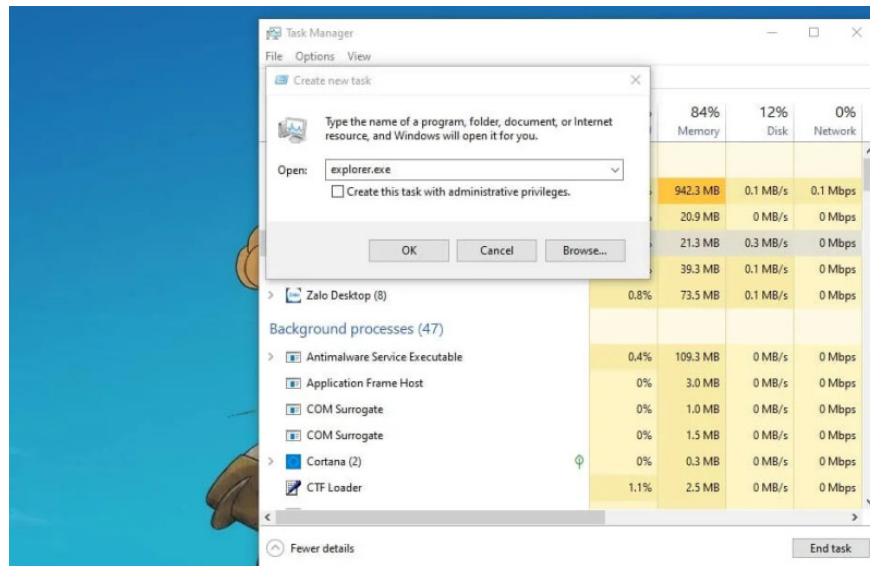


In the Task Manager window that appears, switch to the "Processes" tab. Scroll down until you see "Windows Explorer". Right-click on this entry and select "End Task".



Next, on the menu bar at the top of the window, select "File" => "Run New Task". The "Create new task" window will appear.

In the "Open" dialog box, type "explorer.exe" and select "OK" or "Enter". When the Windows interface reappears, check to see if the "You need to activate Windows in Settings" error has been fixed.

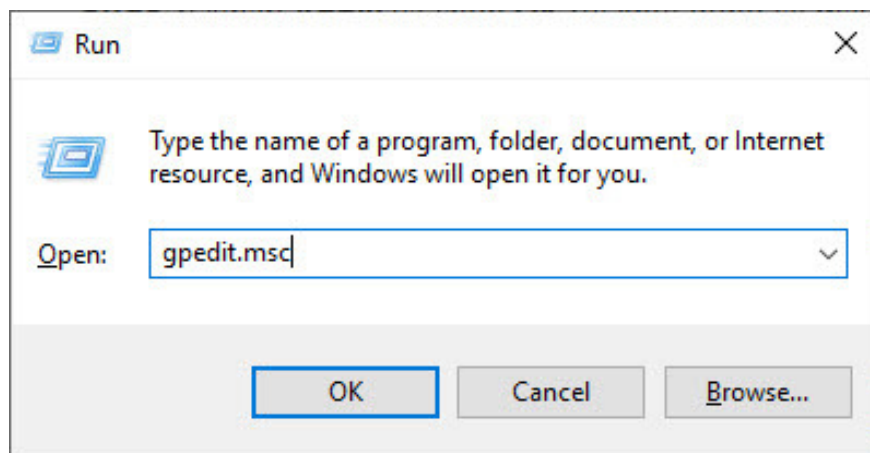


Use Group Policy to turn off notifications

Another way to fix your **windows license will expire soon laptop** is to change the information in Group Policy. Here's how to do it:

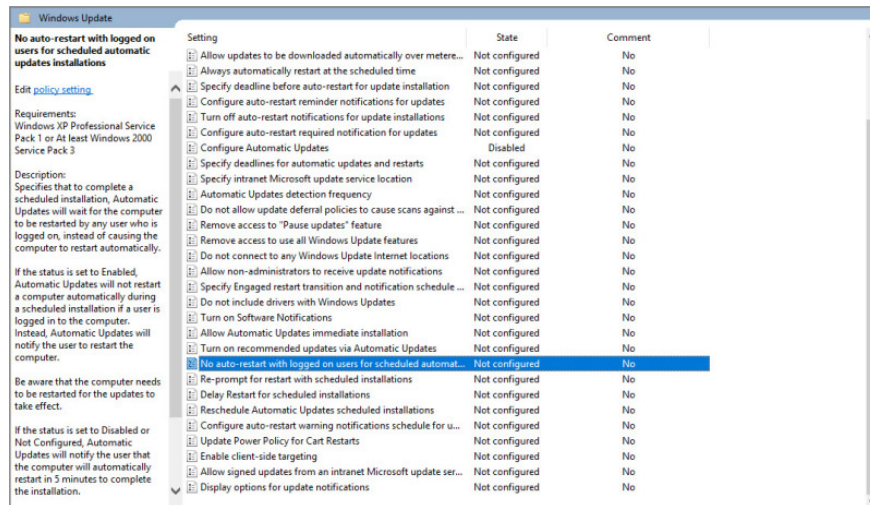
Press Windows + R to open the "Run" command window.

Type the command "gpedit.msc" and press Enter.



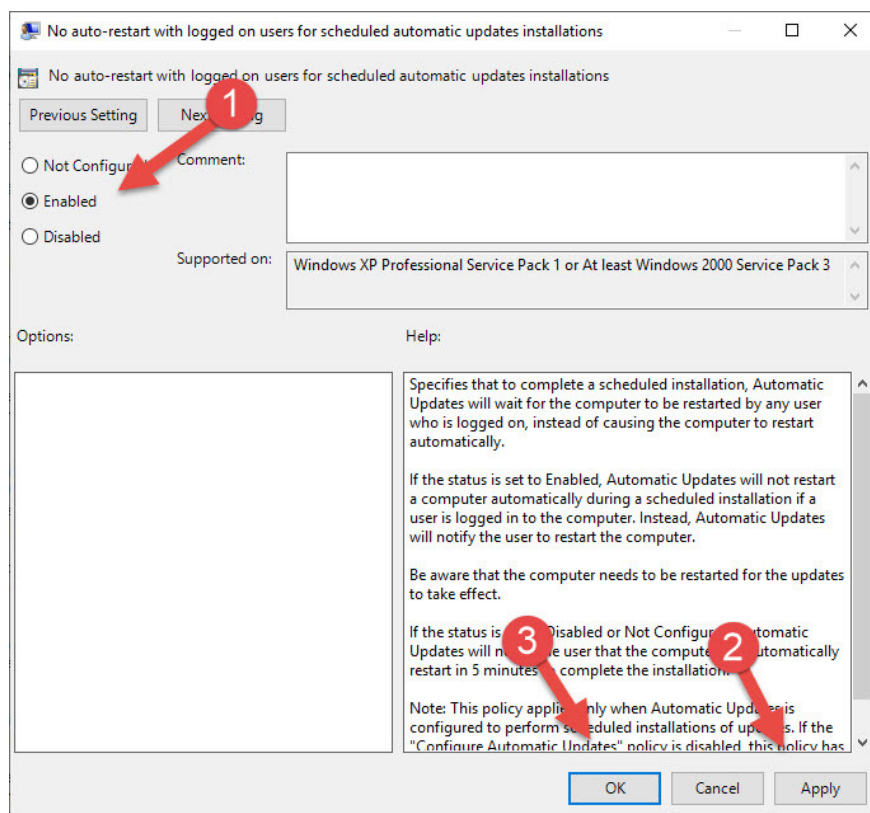
Navigate to Windows Update in the Local Group Policy Editor window. The path to Windows Update is: Computer Configuration > Administrative Templates > Windows Components > Windows Update.

Look for the option "No auto-restart with logged on users for scheduled automatic updates installations".



Double-click "No auto-restart with logged on users for scheduled automatic updates installations" to open a new window.

Select the "Enabled" option in the "No auto-restart with logged on users for scheduled automatic updates installations" section.



Click "Apply" and then "OK", then restart your computer.

Disable, stop some services

If you keep getting the error message " **Your windows license will expire soon** ", you can solve the problem by disabling some services.

Step 1: Enter the command "services.msc" into the Run window or press the Windows + R key combination.

Step 2: In the Services interface, find and double-click the "Windows License Manager Services" option.

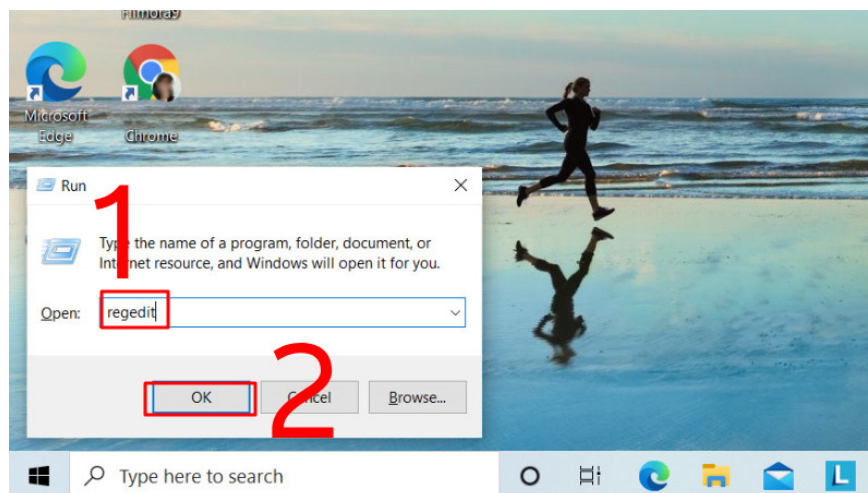
Step 3: A new window will appear. By default, this option will run on the system to notify about the expiration of Windows license. Click the "Stop" button and then select "Disabled" in the list under "Startup type" to disable the notification. Finally, select "Apply" or "OK" to save the changes.

Step 4: Next, continue to scroll down, find the "Windows Update" service and select "Disabled" in the displayed window.

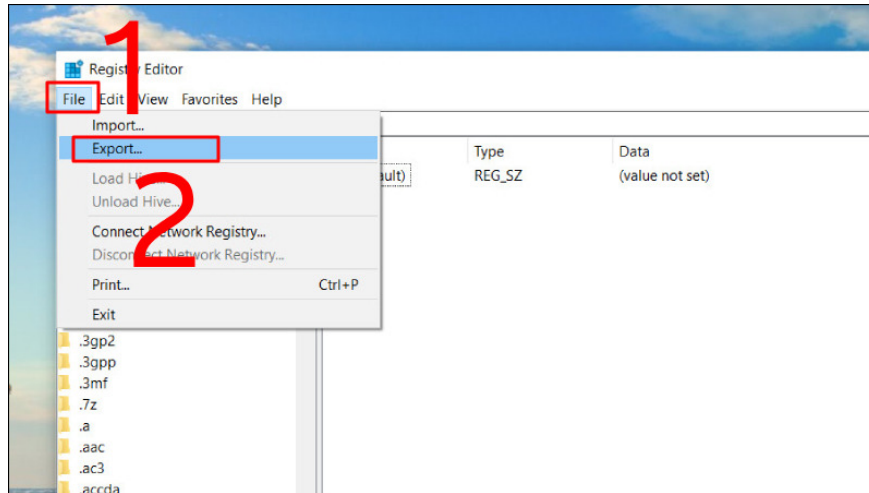
Use Registry Editor to fix the error your windows license will expire soon

Here's how to make changes in the Registry to fix the y our windows license will expire soon error :

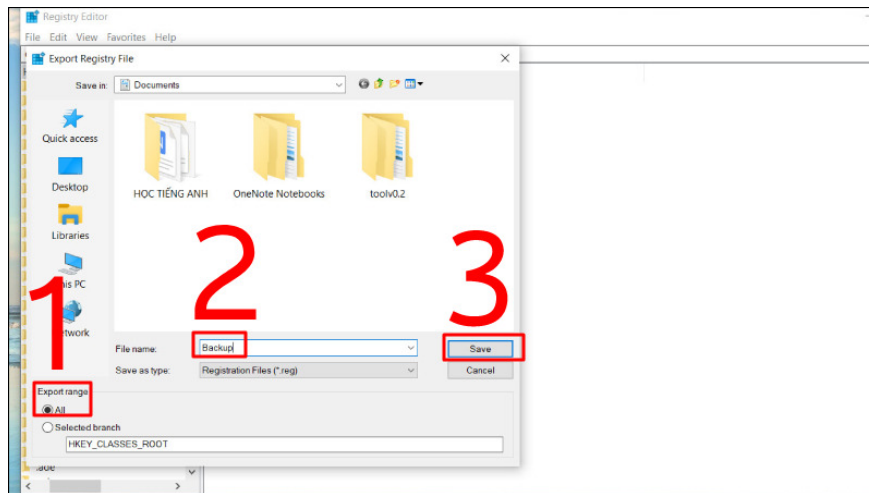
Step 1: Press Windows + R, the "Run" command window will appear. Next, type "regedit" then press Enter.



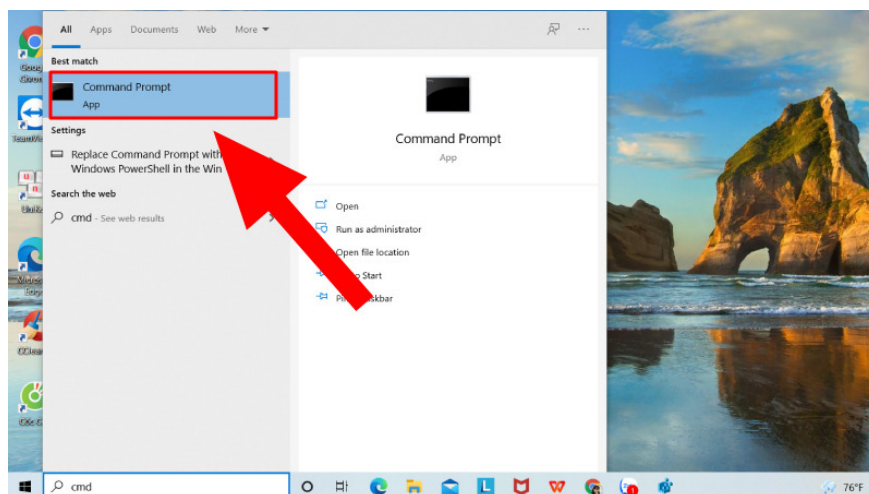
Step 2: Before you make changes in the Registry, back up your data first. To do this, select "File" > "Export".



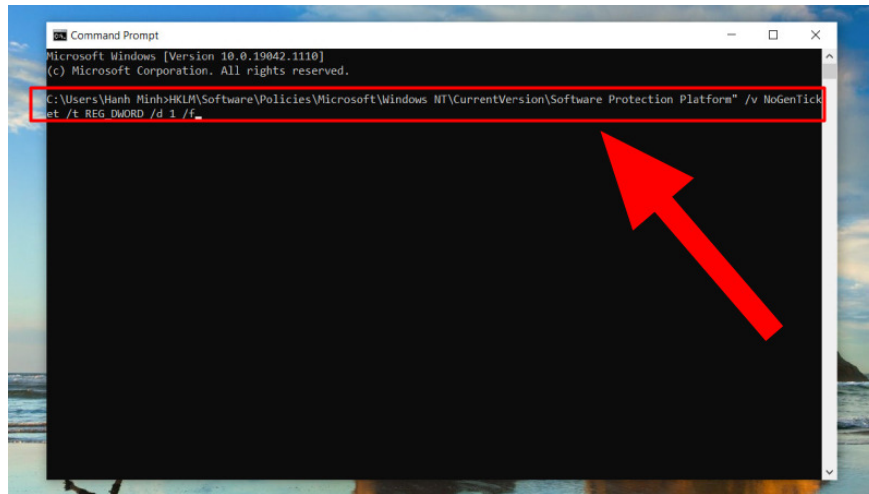
Step 3: Select "All" in "Export range", enter a name for the file and select a location to save the Registry backup data, then click "Save".



Step 4: Open Command Prompt.



Step 5 : Enter the following command: reg add "HKLMSoftwarePoliciesMicrosoftWindows NTCurrentVersionSoftware Protection Platform" /v NoGenTicket /t REG_DWORD /d 1 /f.

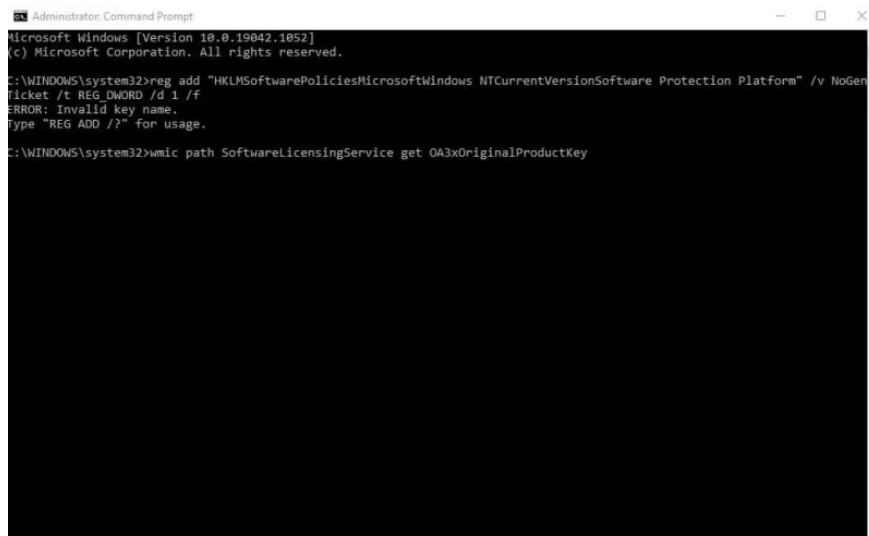


Use Command Prompt to find product key

Besides the above solutions, you can also find the product key through Command Prompt. Follow these steps:

Step 1: Open a Command Prompt window with administrative rights as instructed above. In the displayed window, you can copy and paste the following command:

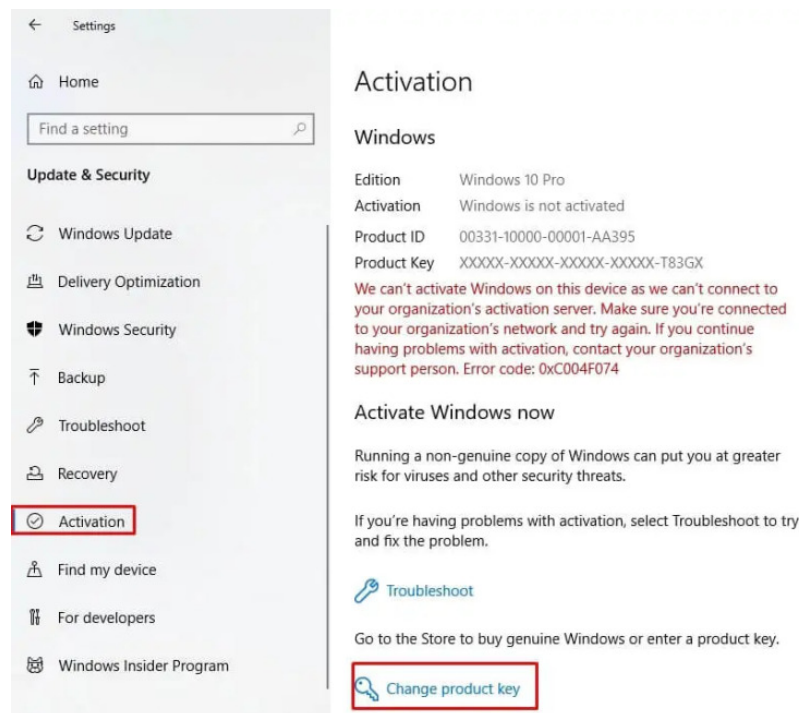
```
wmic path SoftwareLicensingService get OA3xOriginalProductKey
```



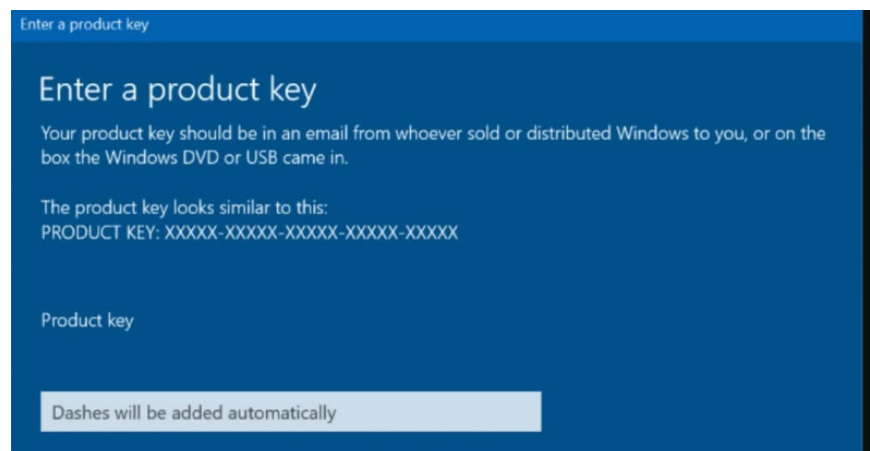
Step 2: The result will display your product key on the Command Prompt window. Copy it to a convenient location or write it down.

Then, access the Settings app using the Windows + I key combination. Select "Update & Security" from the list on the left side of the window. On the right screen, select "Activation".

Step 3: In the "Activation" section, you will see "Change product key". Click this to open the dialog box to enter the license product key.



The "Enter a product key" dialog box will appear. Enter the product key you just found and click "Next". Wait for the operating system to confirm the key you just entered. When the operating system is activated, the " **your windows license will expire soon** " message will automatically disappear.
