- You can freely use the **laptop** screen vertically or horizontally, easily and appropriately for work.
- You can adjust the laptop screen to default, and fix errors when they occur.

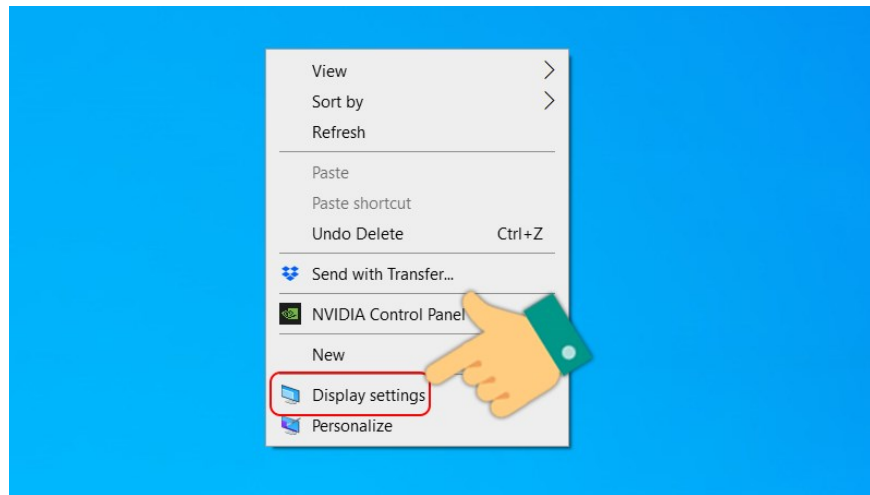
How to rotate laptop screen win 10, 7

Rotate screen using NVIDIA Control Panel

Note: This method is only suitable for PCs with NVIDIA graphics with NVIDIA drivers installed.

Step 1: Right-click on the Desktop screen > click on NVIDIA Control Panel.

Step 2: Click on Rotate display in Display in the left control panel > If multiple screens appear, select the screen you want to rotate > Select the following screen rotation options:



Landscape: default screen is horizontal

Portrait: the screen rotates 90 degrees to the right and the right edge of the screen will be the bottom.

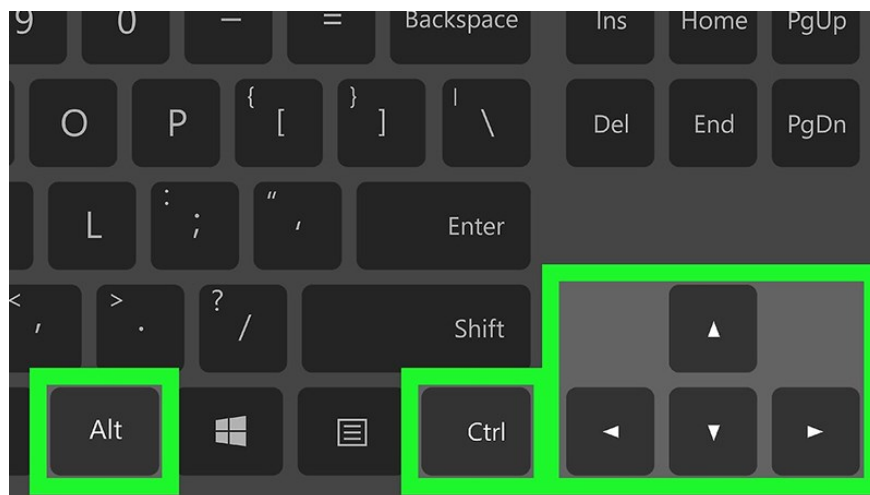
Landscape (flipped): The screen is flipped upside down, the top edge becomes the bottom of the screen.

Portrait (flipped): The screen rotates 90 degrees to the left and the left edge of the screen will be the bottom.
Click Apply.

Step 3: The screen will then rotate to the direction you selected above and you have 20 seconds to click Yes or No before Windows returns to the previous display orientation.

Rotate screen with shortcut key

In addition, to rotate the laptop **screen**, you can use shortcut keys. However, this method can only be used on computers with Intel graphics cards, while NVIDIA or AMD will not support shortcut keys for this function.



Press Ctrl + Alt + Up Arrow: Rotate the screen to standard landscape orientation

Press Ctrl + Alt + Down Arrow: Rotate the screen upside down

Press Ctrl + Alt + Left Arrow: Rotate the screen 90 degrees to the left.

Press Ctrl + Alt + Right Arrow: Rotate the screen 90 degrees to the right.

Rotate the screen using Display Settings

Step 1: Right-click on the Desktop screen > Select Display settings.

Step 2: In the Display orientation section, rotate to the direction you want.

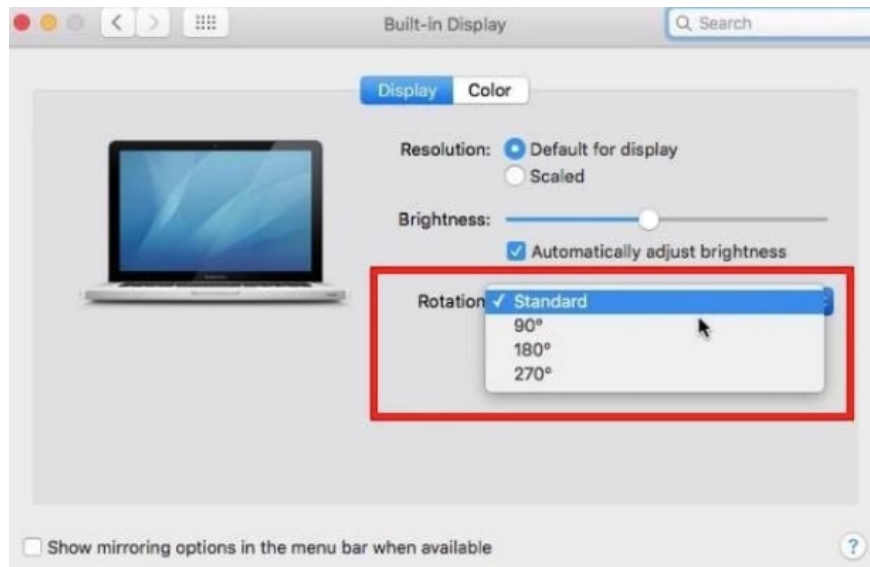
Step 3: Click Keep change to save the changes you want or click Revert to return to the beginning.

How to rotate computer screen on Macbook

Open System Preferences (or click the Apple icon in the top left of your screen and select 'System Preferences...' from the menu). Select Displays, it's the first option in the second row.

Under Displays, there is a rotation option called Rotation, which is Standard by default. Change the option to 90 degrees to rotate your screen clockwise by a quarter of a screen, or you can choose 180 degrees or 270 degrees depending on your needs.

(Note that if two windows appear on the screen, the rotation will appear at this point: one window for each screen. You can rotate each window separately if you want.)



How to rotate your MacBook's built-in display

MacBooks don't typically offer a built-in screen rotation option. Another way to rotate your screen is to hold down the Alt + Cmd key combination while opening System Preferences > Displays, then select the new Rotation setting that appears that will automatically rotate your MacBook screen.

However, you need to consider carefully because while rotating the screen on a Macbook if you do it this way it may leave some serious problems later.
