

Instructions on how to set the Valorant mouse from A to Z for beginners

Before embarking on the gun battle, beginners do not forget to learn how to set Valorant mouse according to the instructions below.

Valorant is a very hot shooting game in recent times. If you are going to experience this super interesting game then first of all need to learn how to set Valorant mouse first.

Parameters to know when setting Valorant mouse

First, let's get acquainted with the indicators in the mouse customization section of the game. Unlike many other FPS games, Valorant has a very low kill time. By comparison, its kill time is even lower than CS: GO. That is why the game requires more precise manipulation. The key metrics are:

1. **DPI (dots-per-inch):** The DPI determines the distance the mouse travels. It corresponds to the distance that the computer mouse actually travels. As a standard, each dot is equal to 1 pixel on the display. This indicator should be set to 400 or 800. High DPI level above 1000 will help reduce wrist fatigue while playing but will require much more agility, suitable for familiar players.
2. **In-game Sensitivity** index: should be at 1 or 0.75 or 0.5
3. **eDPI:** This is also a mouse sensitivity index, but an average. The formula for calculating eDPI is DPI x ingame Sensitivity. Calculate the customization at 277 eDPI or lower. Low eDPI is only suitable for professional players.
4. **Polling Rate:** The index shows the rate of receiving information from the mouse to the machine. This should be adjusted to 1000 if you use a high-end gaming mouse.

The custom parameters suggested above are just for reference based on the habits of the majority of players. You can completely adjust the index as you like. Most importantly, we have a feeling of unity, the best when playing games is. The secret for beginners is to go to the practice room to shoot and get the perfect parameters yourself.



Instructions on how to watch Minimap while playing Valorant

In addition to Valorant mouse settings, in order to get the best gaming conditions we also need to customize before a few other issues. The first is the Minimap. Like when playing Dota or League of Legends, playing Valorant we also need an overview.

The information in Valorant's Minimap is varied and important. They are information about bombs, teammates, skills that have been used before.



Guide to setting the best screen when playing Valorant

Valorant is not a game with terrible graphics. So we can play games on mid-range computers. In general, most people will have no difficulty in meeting Valorant's configuration requirements.

But always the same, if the higher the screen scan frequency, the smoother the game, the better. If the computer or laptop can respond, players should pull up 240Hz Refresh Rate. The aspect ratio of the screen set at 1920 x 1080 is reasonable.
