What is iMessage

iMessage is Apple's messaging service exclusively for Apple devices such as iPhone, iPad, etc. Although this feature is useful, it will prevent you from sending SMS messages to current users. Android phone. Therefore, immediately apply the method below to turn off iMessage on iPhone and iPad if you find it unnecessary.

Why do you need to turn off iMessage on iPhone?

An iMessage vulnerability on older iPhones running iOS can be exploited by hackers to send malicious code and take control of the device.



Russian security firm Kaspersky said it accidentally discovered the vulnerability after some employees' iPhones ran unusually slow and could not update to new iOS. The company then backed up the data of the suspected

infected device and found evidence of malware intrusion. Kaspersky calls the vulnerability a "triangle campaign".

Specifically, crooks will use iMessage to send messages with malicious code attached to the target iPhone. Malware can then get inside iOS without the user's knowledge. After successful installation, they will "listen to commands" from remote hackers every time the device connects to the Internet.

"Operation Triangle" is estimated to have been active since 2019 and is still continuing to this day. Apple is said to be aware of the vulnerability and patch it, because only iPhone models running iOS 15.7 and earlier are vulnerable.

Apple this week said that more than 80% of iPhone users have updated to iOS 16, meaning the majority are no longer at risk of attack. However, with 1.36 billion active iPhones in the world, 258 million iPhone users could still be targeted.

How to turn off iMessage on iPhone and iPad

Step 1 : Go to **Settings** .

Step 2 : Select **Messages** .

Step 3 : Click the slider next to **iMessage** to turn it off.

Step 4 : **Go to the main screen, select the message icon** .

Step 5: Send a few messages to your iPhone-using friends to make sure they see your messages.

After completing these operations, iMessage will deactivate you at Apple's servers.

How to deactivate iMessage from Apple servers

Even with the above method of turning off iMessage on iPhone, this service is still activated on your device. If you want to completely cancel iMessage, do the following:

Step 1: Visit Apple's support page at this address, then scroll down and enter the phone number in the Phone Number box.

Step 2: Next, enter the exact code displayed on the screen into the Please enter the code box and then click Send Code.

Step 3: Next, Apple will send you a confirmation code via SMS to the phone number you just provided. Please enter that code in the Confirmation Code box and then click Submit to complete.

With just very simple steps, you can quickly turn off iMessage on your iPhone and iPad to protect personal information on your phone.
