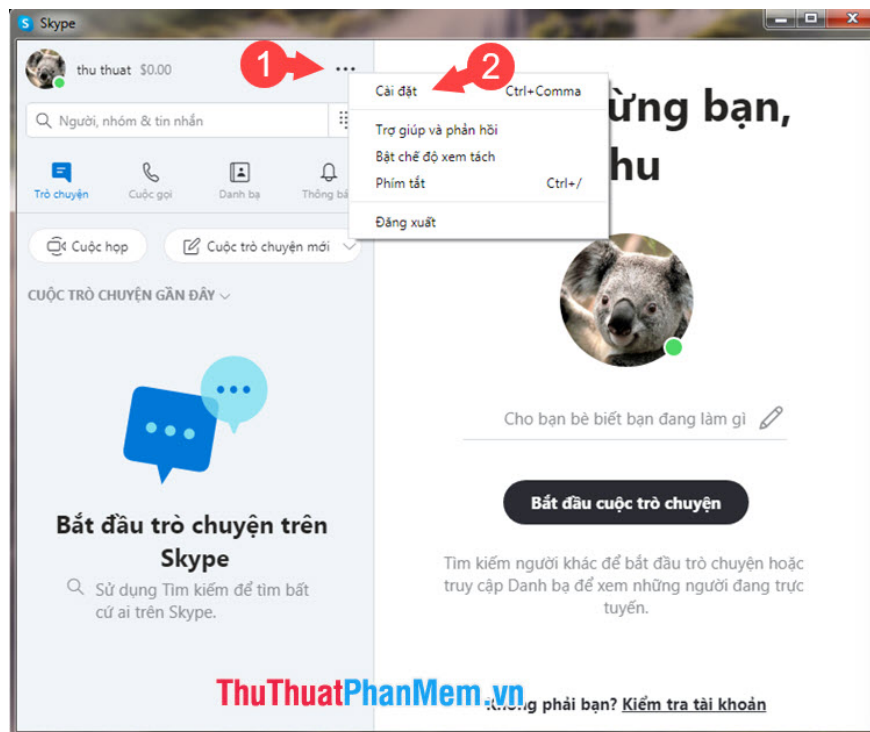

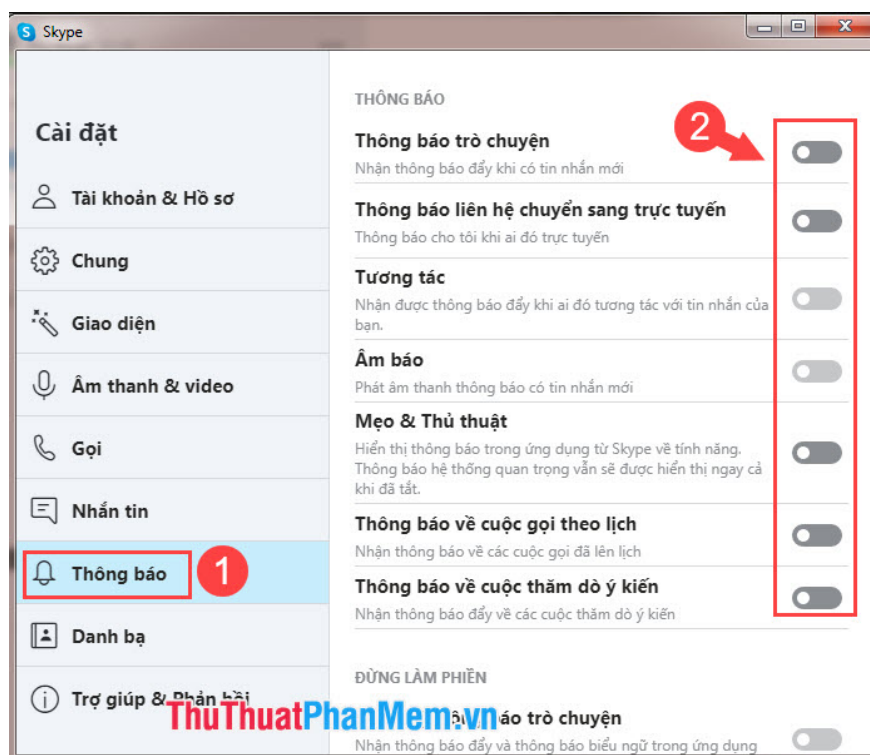
1. Turn off Skype notifications on the computer

1.1. Turn off all notifications in Settings

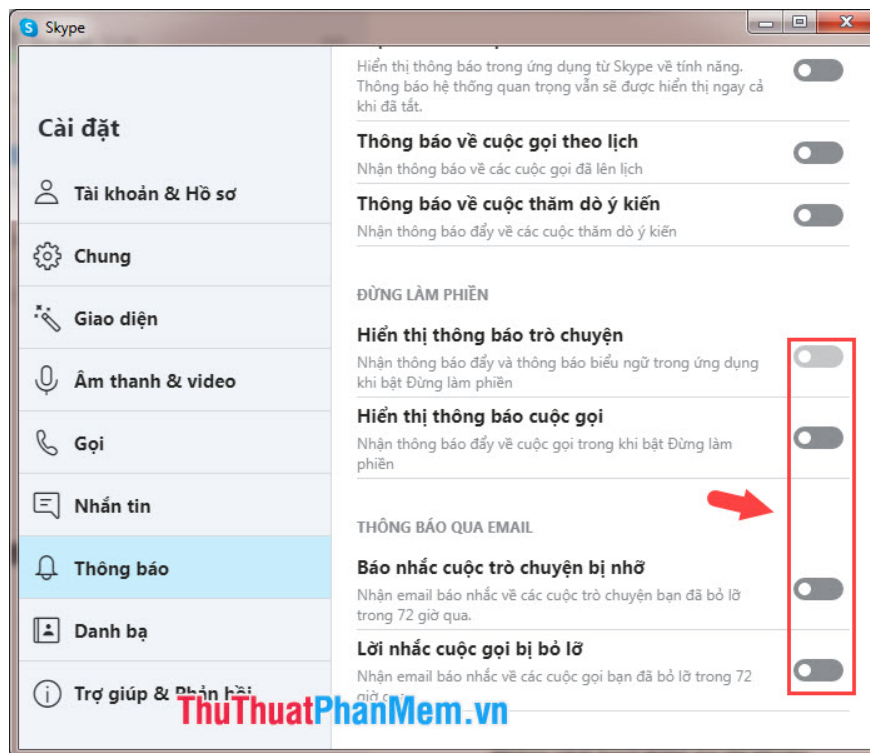
Step 1: Click on the icon 3 dots (1) in Skype => **Settings (2)** .



Step 2: Go to **Notifications (1)** => Set the switch of all notifications to **Off (2)** .

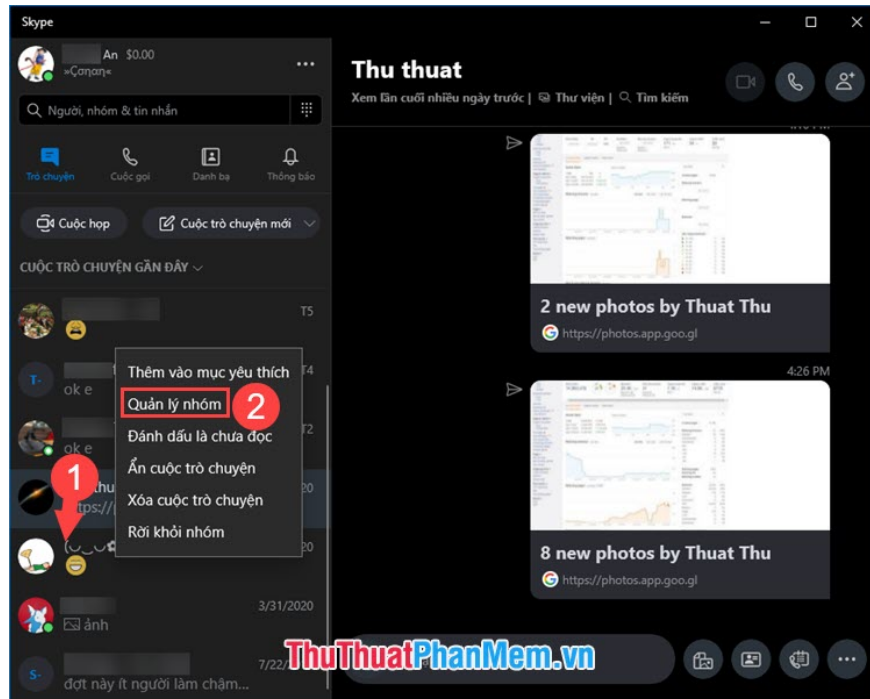


Scroll down and set notifications for the rest of the items to **Off** .

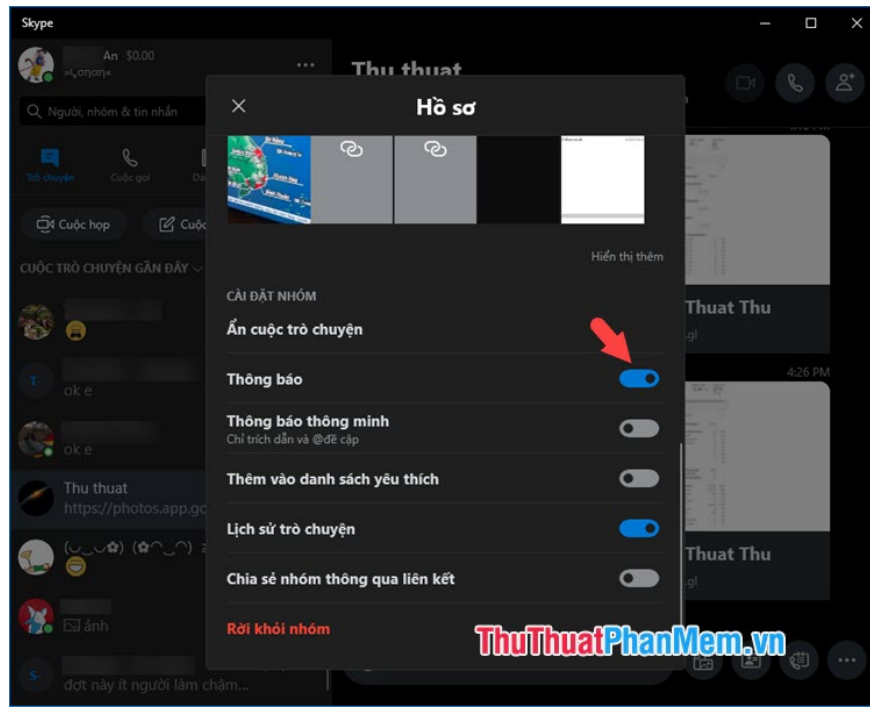


1.2. Turn off notifications for groups and individuals

Step 1: Right-click on the group (1) you want to turn off notifications => **Manage groups** (2) .



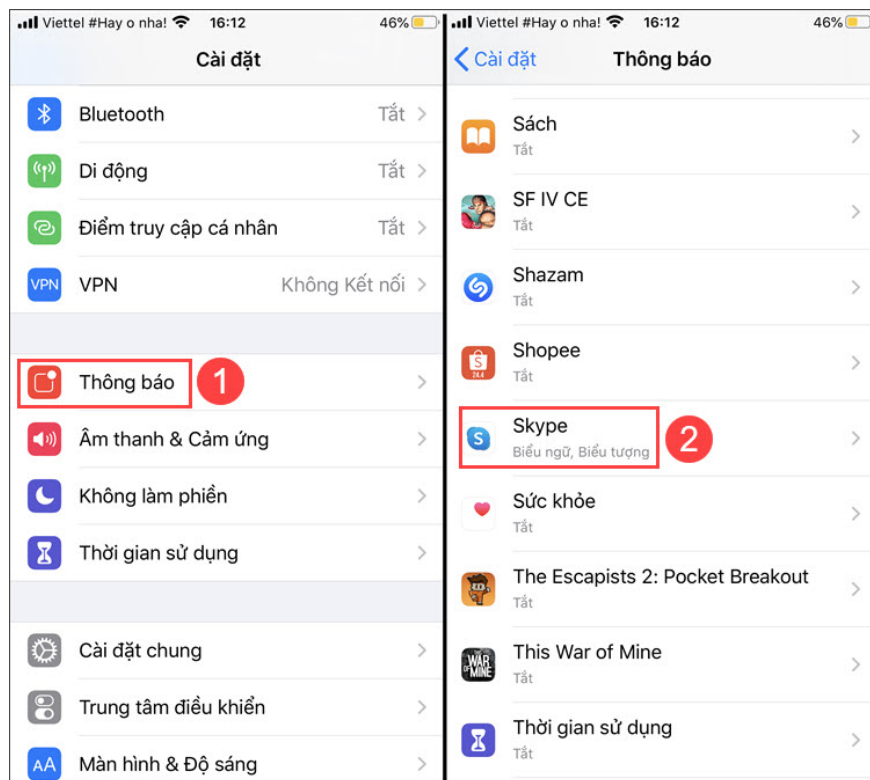
Step 2: Scroll down and find **Notifications** section >> switch off the **Notification** switch to **Off** .



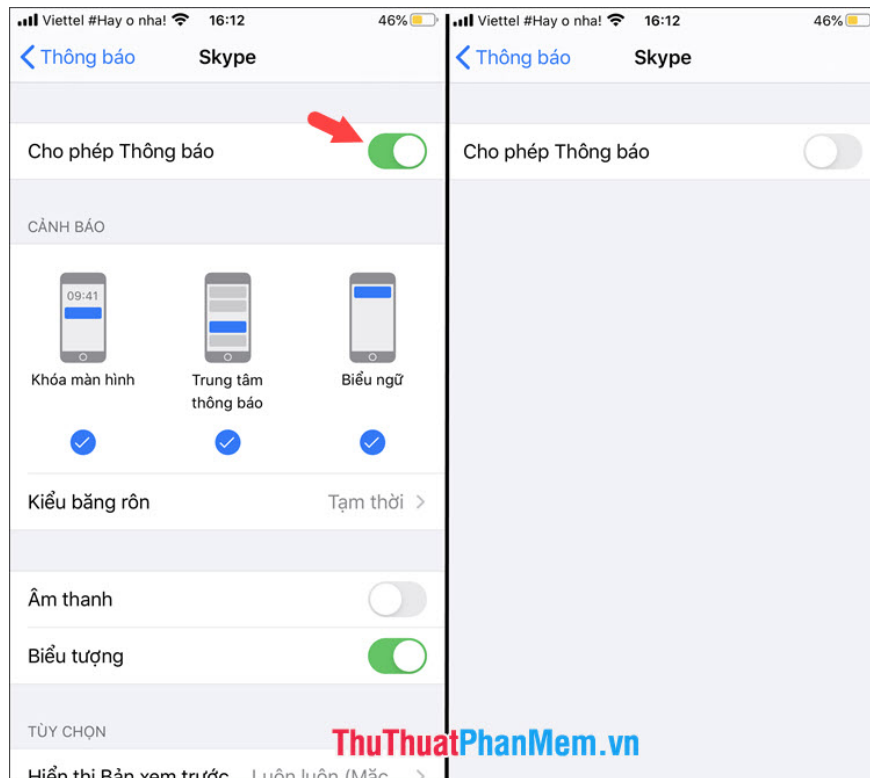
2. Turn off Skype notifications on the phone

2.1. On iOS operating system

Step 1: Go to Settings => Notifications (1) => Skype (2) .

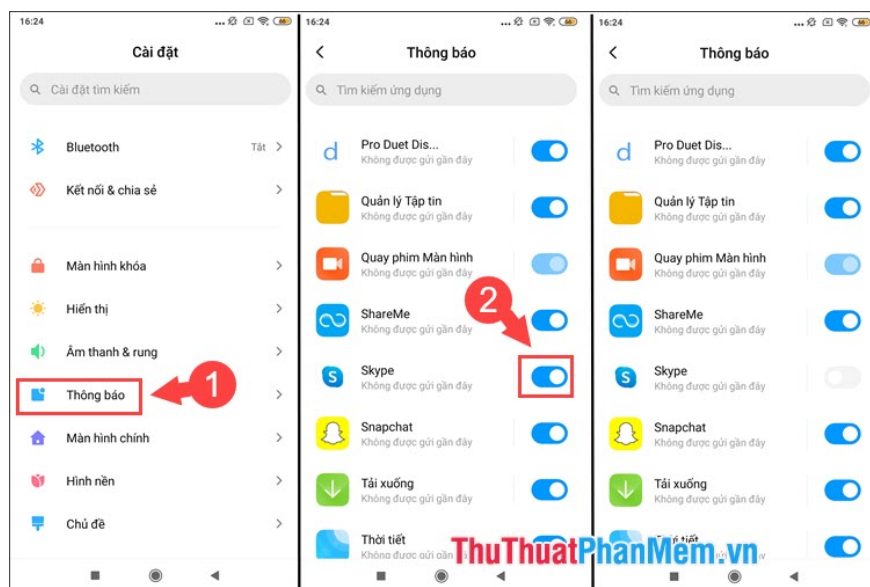


Step 2: You turn the switch **Allow notifications** to **Off** is done.



2.2. On Android phones
