Instructions for turning on/off Windows 10 firewall in Control Panel

Using Control Panel is one of the basic and simple ways you can use. The following are specific steps to turn off the firewall on Windows 10 that you can follow:

1. **Step 1:** Access the **Control Panel** section on your computer. Next, click on **System and Security** > Select **Windows Defender Firewall** .

1. **Step 2 : In the Windows Defender Firewall window** > In the **Control Panel Home** column on the left, click on **Turn Windows Defender Firewall on or off** to start setting up the firewall for your computer.

1. **Step 3** : Customize the option to enable or disable the firewall at **Customize Settings**.
 1. **In case you want to turn off the firewall:** In both **Private network settings** and **Public network settings** , check the box **Turn off Windows Defender FireWall** .

1. **In case you want to turn the firewall back on for your computer:** In both **Private network settings** and **Public network settings** , check the box **Turn on Windows Defender Firewall** .

1. **Step 4:** After making your selection, press the **OK** button to save the changes you just made.

Instructions on how to turn on and off Windows 10 firewall using CMD

Besides using the Control Panel tool, users can also use the CMD command available in the Command Prompt software to disable the firewall on the computer. You just need to follow the 3 simple steps below:

1. **Step 1** : On the **Start** bar , select **the Type here to Search** box > Enter the keyword **cmd** > Right-click **Command Prompt** > Click **Run as administrator** to access with Administrator rights.

1. **Step 2 : The Administrator** window appears, type into the program the command '**netsh advfirewall set allprofiles state off**' to turn off the firewall > Press **Enter** and when **OK** appears , you have successfully completed turning off the firewall.

1. **Step 3** : To turn the firewall back on on Windows 10, type into the program the command '**netsh advfirewall set allprofiles state on**' > Press **Enter** > If the screen displays **OK** , then turning on the firewall has been completed.

Once completed, you can use the Control Panel tool in step 1 to check again and make sure you have successfully turned on and off the Windows 10 firewall.
