Send encrypted emails on Gmail.

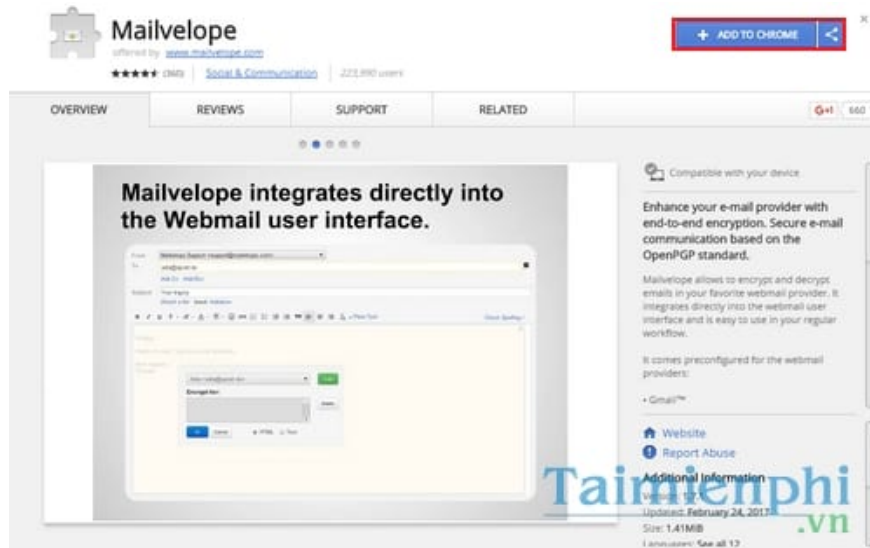

Instructions for sending encrypted emails on Gmail

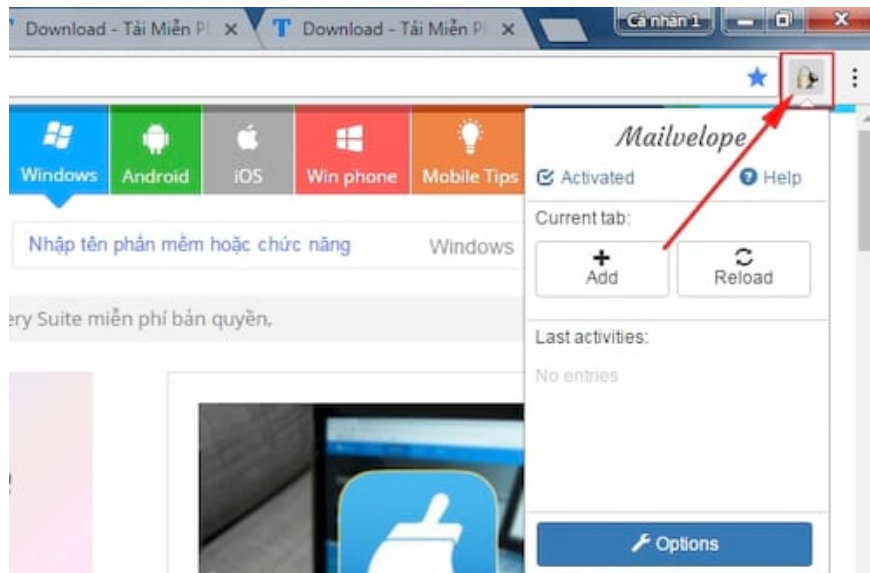
Step 1: First, you need to download and install an extension called Mailvelope, which will help protect your Gmail password.

Step 2: Now this extension will be added to your browser and you will see a padlock icon added to your Chrome or Mozilla browser.



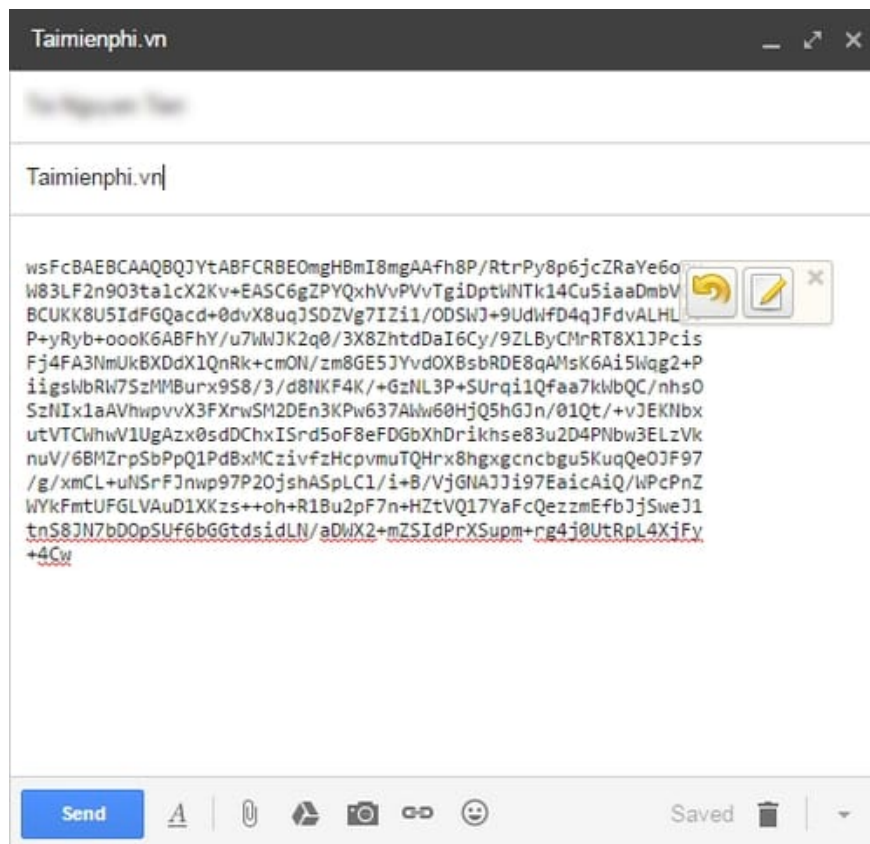
Step 3: Log in to the email address you want to protect. Then click the padlock icon in the upper right corner of the browser, click the **Add button** > select the **Key Management** tab , and then click **Generate key** .



Step 4: On the next screen, fill in your account details and you can also change other options as desired in the **Advanced** section , then click **Generate** to confirm.



Step 5: Finally, go back to your email, compose a message to send to someone, and your email will be securely protected.



So, with just a few simple steps, you can send encrypted emails securely on Gmail. From now on, you won't have to worry about your sensitive data anymore because it's encrypted using this method.
