

Instructions to collapse the WinRAR menu on the right-click menu

WinRAR decompression tool allows users to collapse the menu when clicking on the right mouse button, making the list of commands when clicked right and neat.

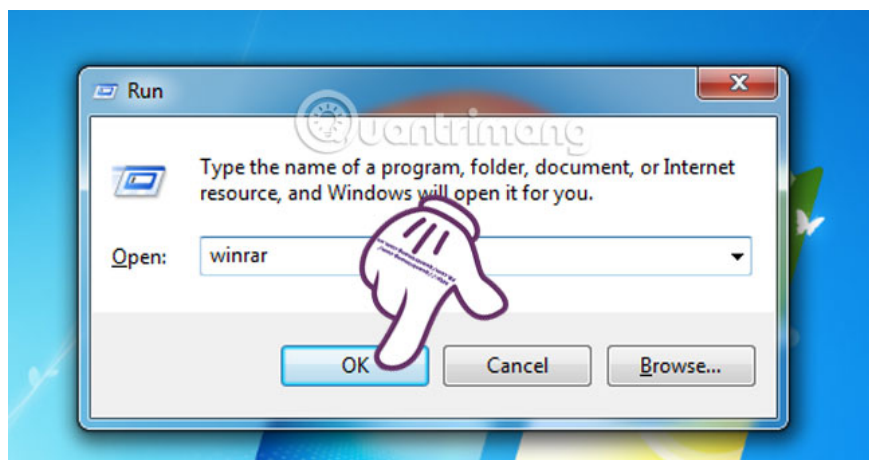

Not only allows you to compress and decompress a file, but you can compress multiple files at the same time, reduce operations and save time in extracting files.

During use, right-clicking will see the WinRAR menu has a lot of options, while we only need 1 or 2 items to use. So why not shorten the list and leave only the necessary items when using the software? In this article, Network Administrator will show you how to shorten the WinRAR menu when using the right mouse with just a few simple steps:

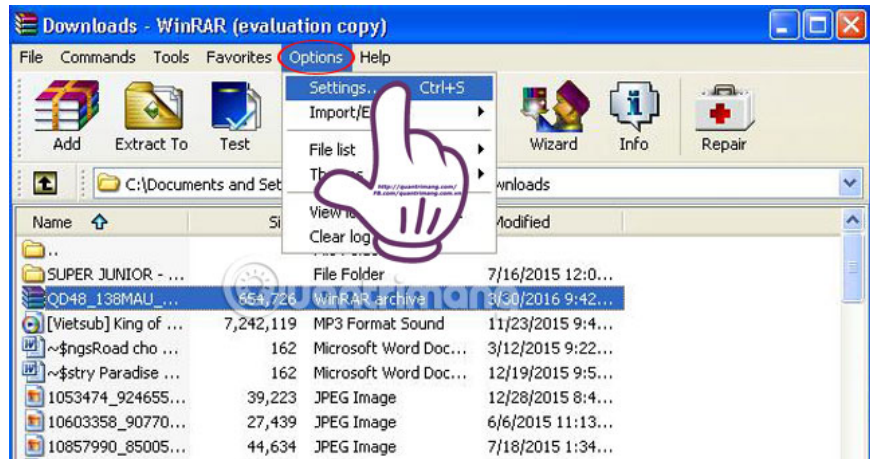
Step 1:

Open the **Run** window by pressing **Windows + R** or on the **Start menu** and enter the **winrar** command. Click **OK** to access.



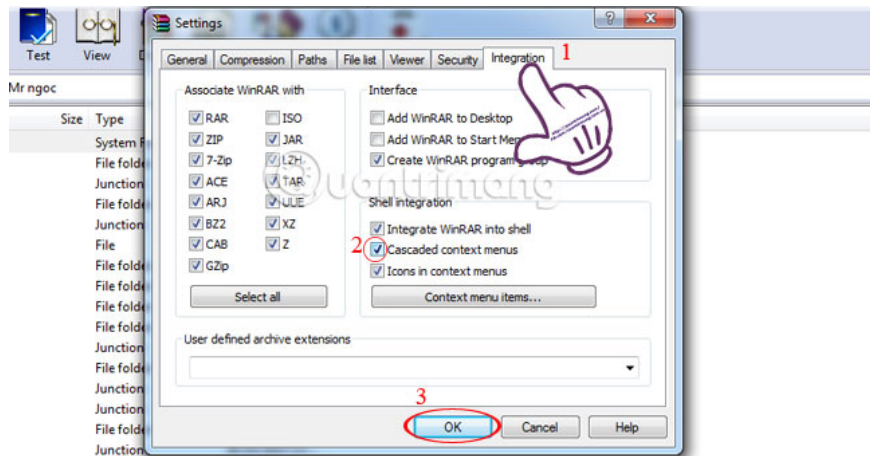
Step 2:

At the interface of the program, select **Options** and select **Settings** .

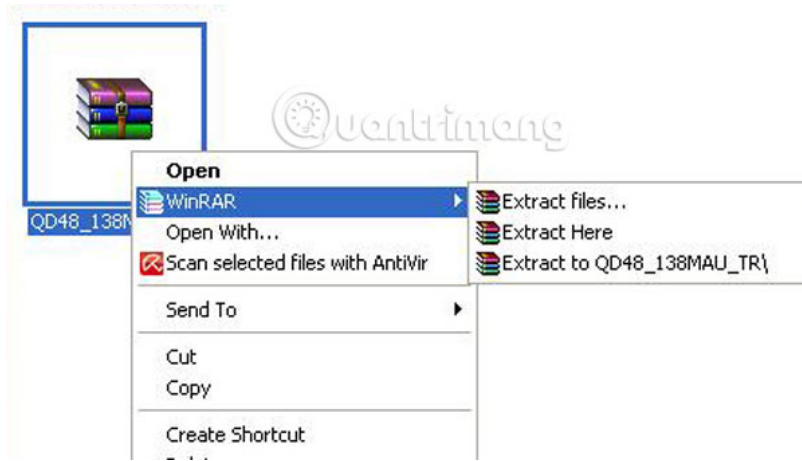


Step 3:

A new window appears. Click on **Integration** , check the **Cascaded context menus** . Click **OK** to save the new settings for the software.



As a result, WinRAR has been collapsed and only appears to serve the need to extract files.
