

Instructions to customize the lock screen on iOS 16'

With iOS 16, Apple introduced a brand new overhaul to the iPhone's lock screen. It is now more customizable than ever and can display widgets with full information.

This article shows people how to customize their iPhone's lock screen in ?iOS 16? beta. iPhone users can refer to the iOS 16 beta installation guide to experience the new features of this operating system.

Instructions to customize the lock screen on iOS 16''

In ?iOS 16?, users can for the first time customize the lock screen with fonts, colors, and widgets. To get started, all people need to do is unlock their ?iPhone? with Face ID or Touch ID, and then long-press on the lock screen to enter the lock screen gallery.

Lock screen gallery

If you own an Apple Watch, everyone will find this interface very familiar, because it is very similar to how watch face customization works. Lock screens are categorized here into **Collections** (Apple's built-in lock screens), **Photos** , and **Colors** . People can swipe left and right to choose a different existing lock screen, and then long-press one to set it up.



Alternatively, tap **Customize** to personalize the currently selected lock screen, or tap **the blue + button** to create a new one. This article will focus on customizing an existing lock screen.

Customize lock screen

Tapping **Customize** brings up an interactive view of the lock screen with several options depending on the lock screen type. If people are customizing the **Colors** lock screen, people can tap **the color circle** on the left to change the color and tint, and swipe left and right to apply different styles to the image.



If you're customizing the **Photos** lock screen, the bottom options allow you to select another photo (or select multiple photos if you want the background to shuffle) from your photo library, set filters, and toggle the mode on/off. effect perspective zoom/depth.



At the top, users will see frames surrounding the date and time, as well as an empty area below the time. The middle pane indicates that people can tap to edit the time display style, while the upper and lower panes are used to add custom widgets.



Widgets that users can add above the time include other time zones, set alarms, next calendar events, weather conditions, reminders, etc. Widgets can be placed inside under time shows more information, including device battery level, Calendar, Clock, Fitness, News, Reminders, Stocks, Weather,.

When you're done customizing your lock screen, just tap **Done** , then tap the screen again to exit the lock screen gallery. Note that users can also customize the current lock screen by going to **Settings > Wallpaper & Lock Screens** .
