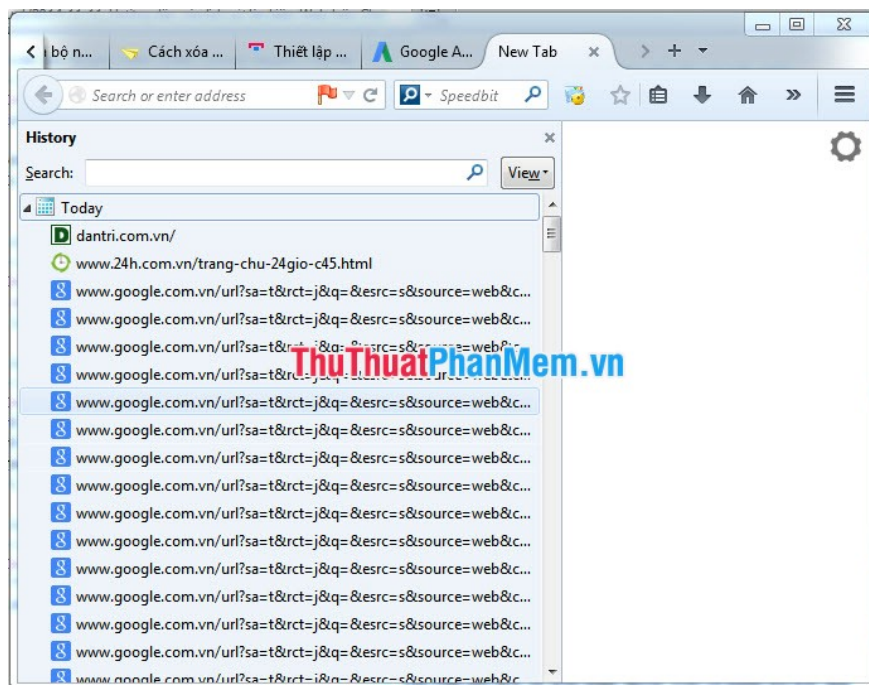


Instructions to delete Web search history on Chrome, Firefox

Instructions to delete Web search history on Chrome and Firefox to protect privacy while browsing the web.

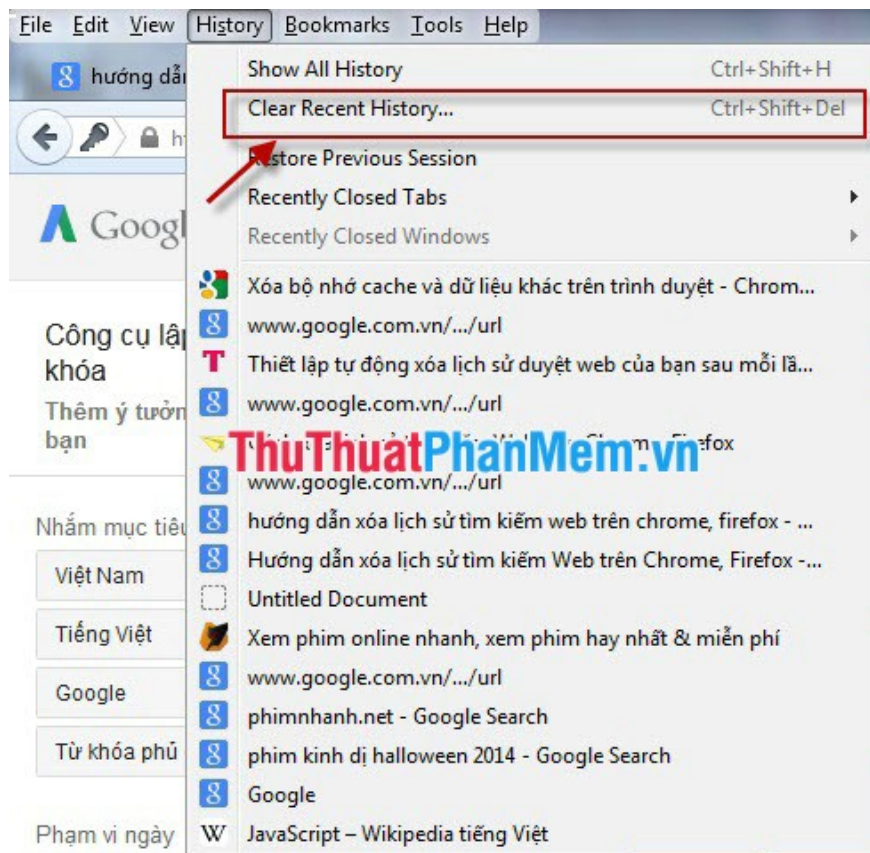

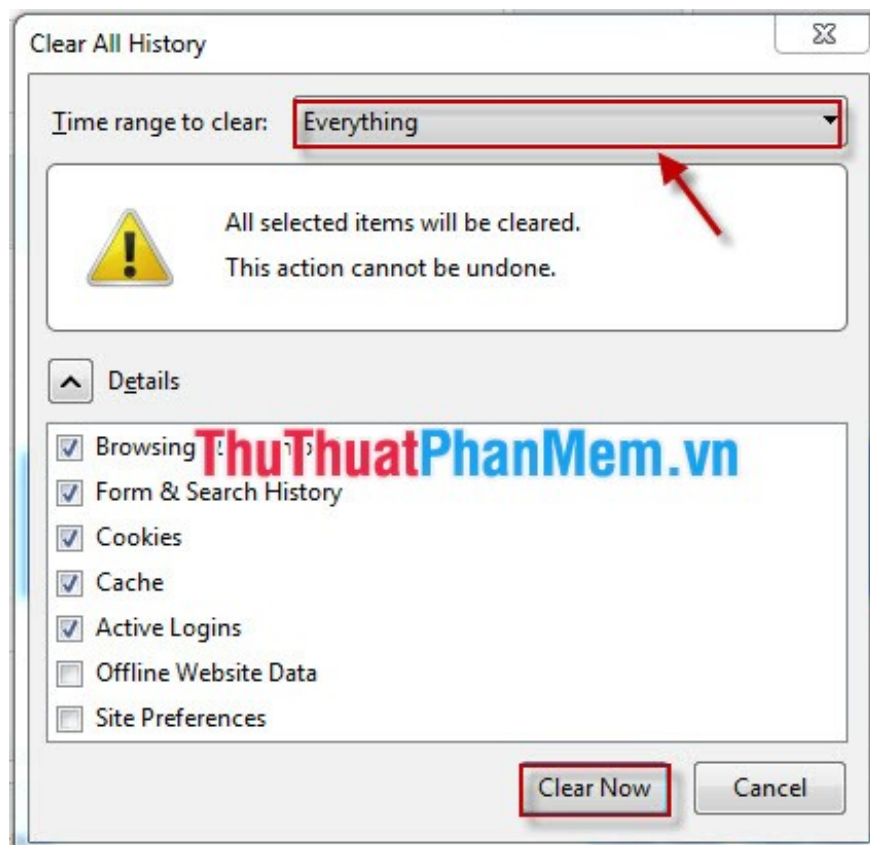
Instructions to delete web search history on Chrome, Firefox

Step 1: On the toolbar of the browser (If you do not see you press Alt), select History and select Clear Recent History:

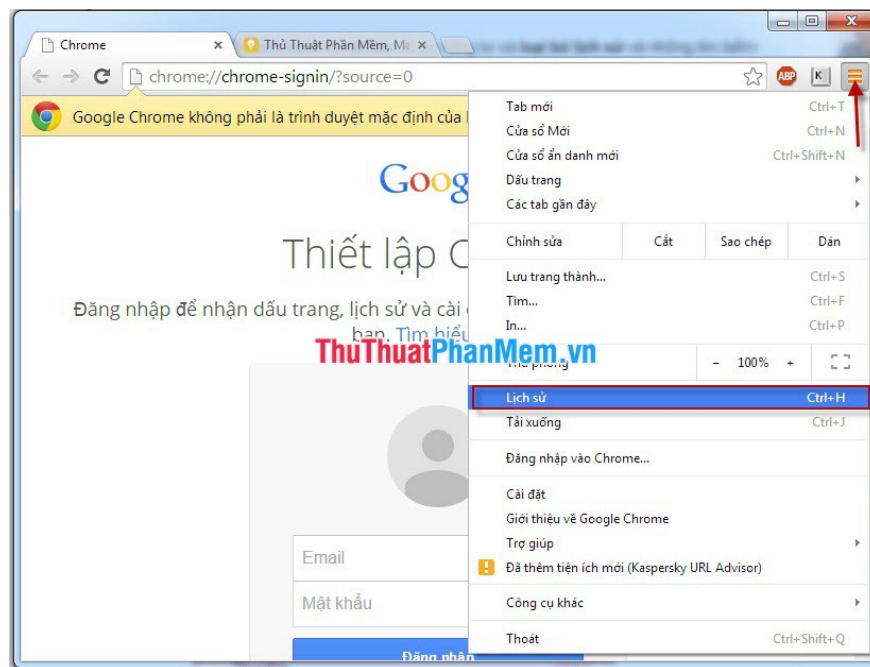


Step 2: The Clear all history dialog box appears, select everything and then clear now

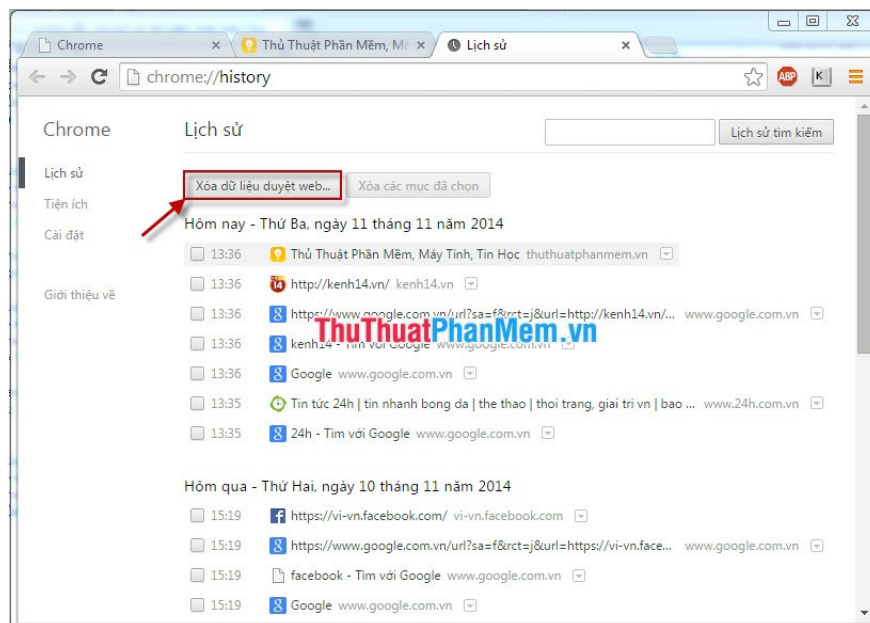


2. For Chrome browser

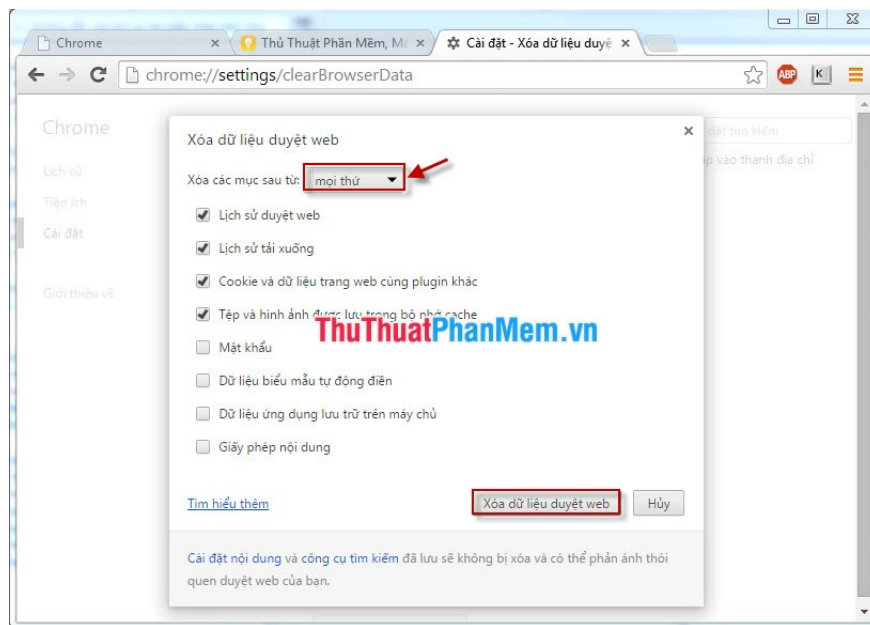
Step 1: Go to custom and control Google Chrome and select History



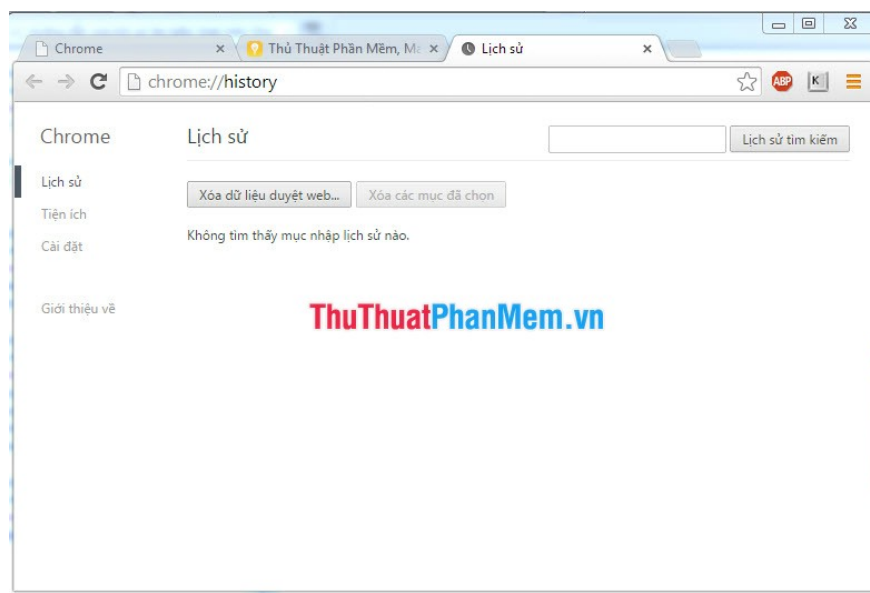
Step 2: Select delete browsing data as shown:
