However, not everyone is a fan of this Welcome page because some users already plan to use Windows in advance or they already know all these features, so the screen display This welcome sometimes annoys users.

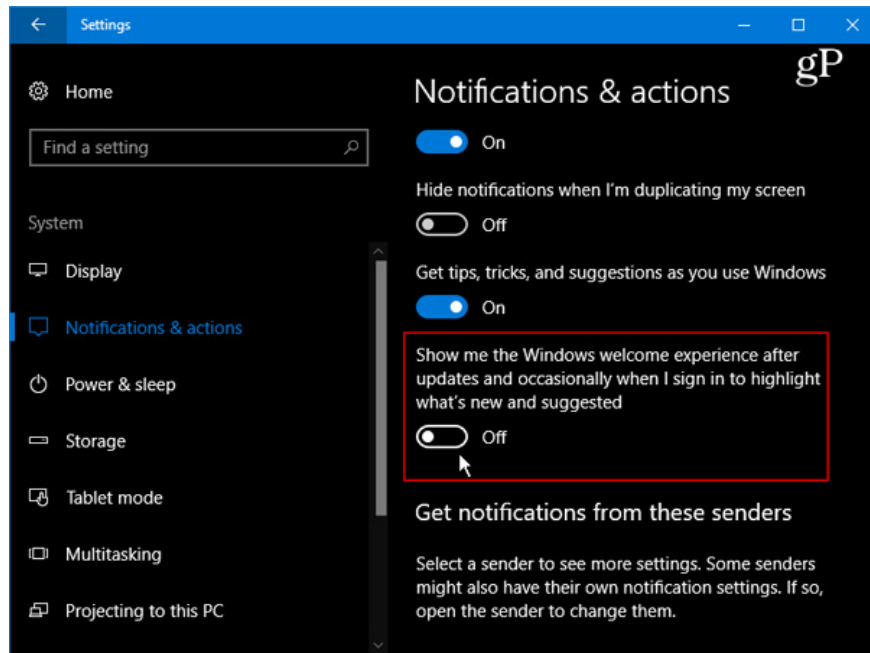
Microsoft has implicitly added an option to disable this Welcome screen from the Creators Update version. This means that this option will take effect from Fall Creators Update for all users.

Open the **Settings** application . Navigate to **system, Notifications and Actions** .

Find the option called **Show me the Windows welcome experience after updates and sometimes when I sign in to highlight what's new and suggested.**



Turn it off.
