

Instructions to fix Windows Update 80070422 error

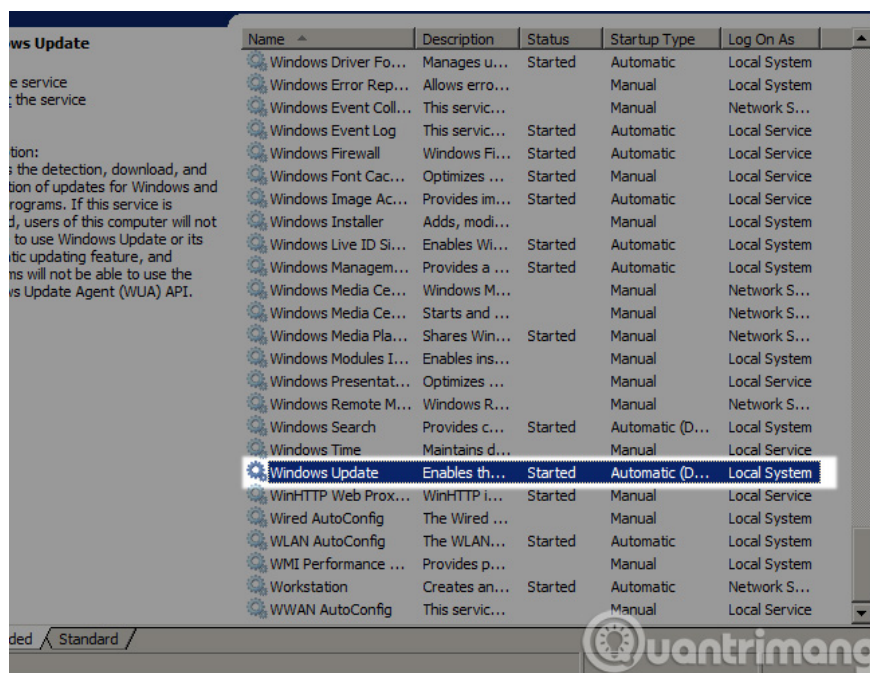
In some recent versions of Windows (since Windows 7, to date), Microsoft has decided to remove WinHlp32.exe as a component in the Windows installation file. As a result, if you need to use the Windows Help Program (WinHlp32.exe file), you will have to download and install separately.

In some recent versions of Windows (since Windows 7, to date), Microsoft has decided to "remove" the **WinHlp32.exe** file as a component in the Windows installation file. As a result, if you need to use the **Windows Help Program** (**WinHlp32.exe** file), you will have to download and install separately. However, most of these cases have **Windows Update error 80070422 error** . The following article of TipsMake.com will help you fix the above error.



Steps to fix errors Windows Update error 80070422:

When you encounter the above error, open the **Services Manager** (**Run > services.msc > Enter**), find the **Windows service Update** and switch to **Automatic** mode (if you're in another mode):



After that, restart the computer and proceed with Update as usual, check if the problem has been fixed. Or use the following method, simply because there is no need to interfere with the Windows Services:

1. Please download and install Microsoft Fix It code 50776
2. After successful installation, restart the computer and check again.

However, there will be some problems after the user installs WinHlp32.exe:

1. You may not be able to access some files on Intranet sites. In this case, use **Microsoft Fix It 50237** . Refer here (**How to unblock files that are stored on an intranet**) .
2. Some macros will be disabled: use **Microsoft Fix It 50105** (**Macros are disabled**)
