How to install Vietnamese for Android phones by application

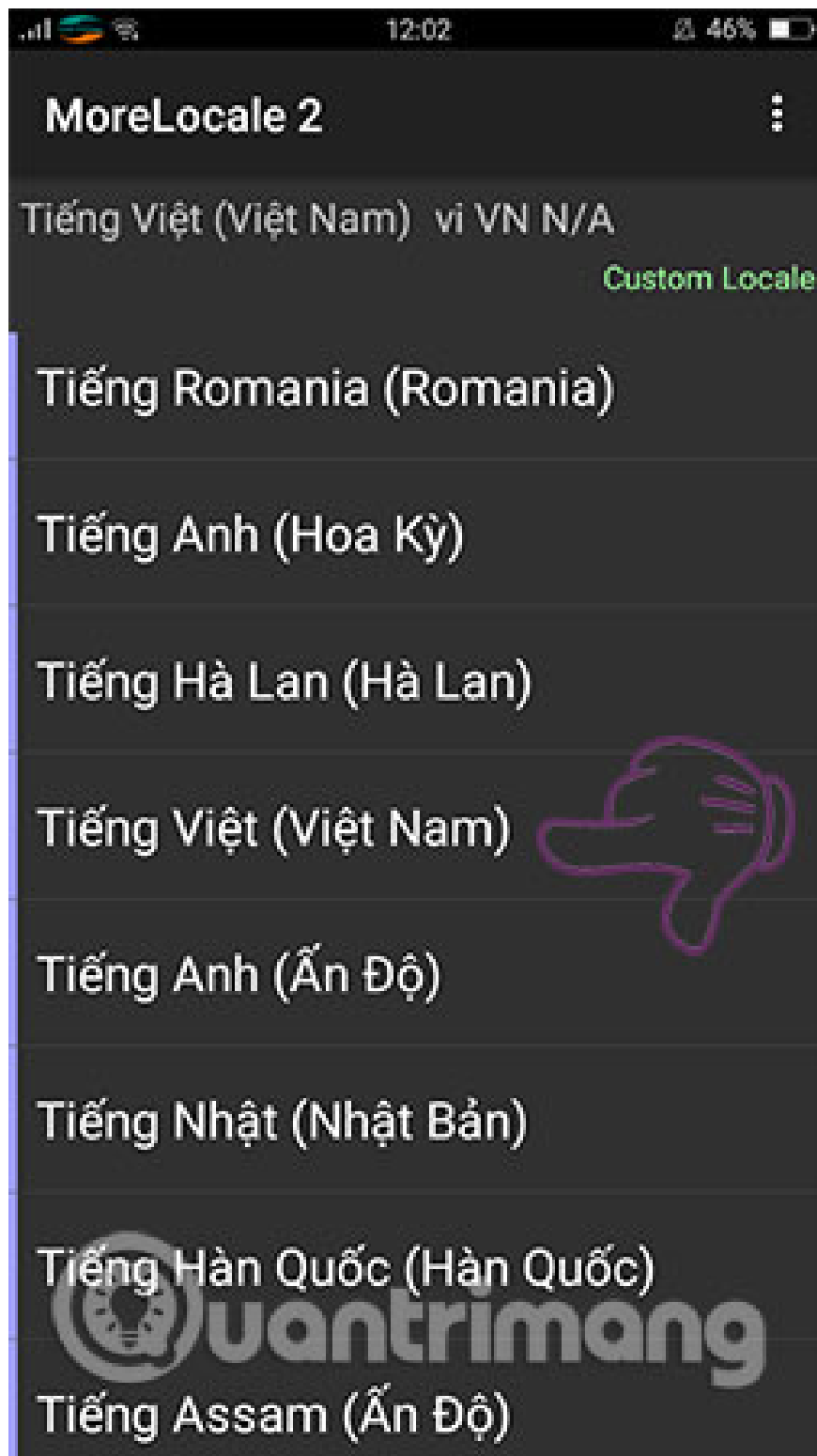
Step 1:

First of all, you need to download and install the **MoreLocale 2** application for your device.

1. Download MoreLocale 2 for Android

Step 2:

Start up the application, here you can set Vietnamese language for Android by clicking on the display language Vietnamese (Vietnam). Then, choose **Vietnamese** like the picture below.



And now your screen has switched to displaying Vietnamese interface already, it's simple and easy right?

In case you feel that the MoreLocale 2 application for Android is not suitable and has not really met the requirements you want, you can find out and refer to a Vietnamese application installed on Android called **MoreLangs** . Similar to the above application, but MoreLangs for Android has an advantage of being compatible on more phone lines, especially portable Android devices.

Note:

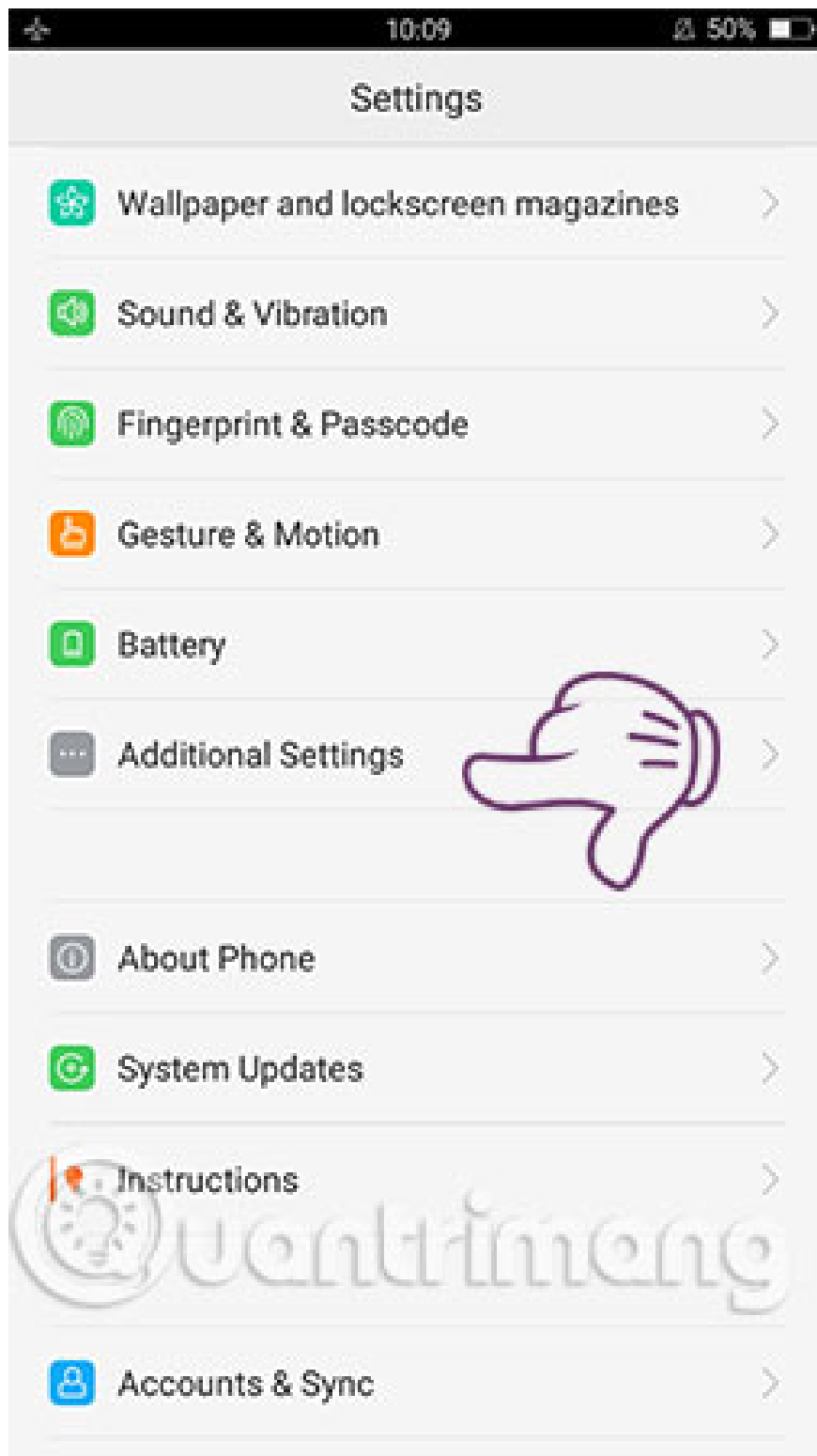
Using these two applications may sometimes involve some translation-related problems on the device, but we don't need to worry about this error because it only happens when you restart your device. I only.

Install Vietnamese for Android phones right on the device

With Android phones produced in Vietnam or Vietnamese language support, you can simply activate right on the device. Depending on the device, the interface will be different, but the steps and operations are generally the same. Following, we will perform on Oppo phone to make an example:

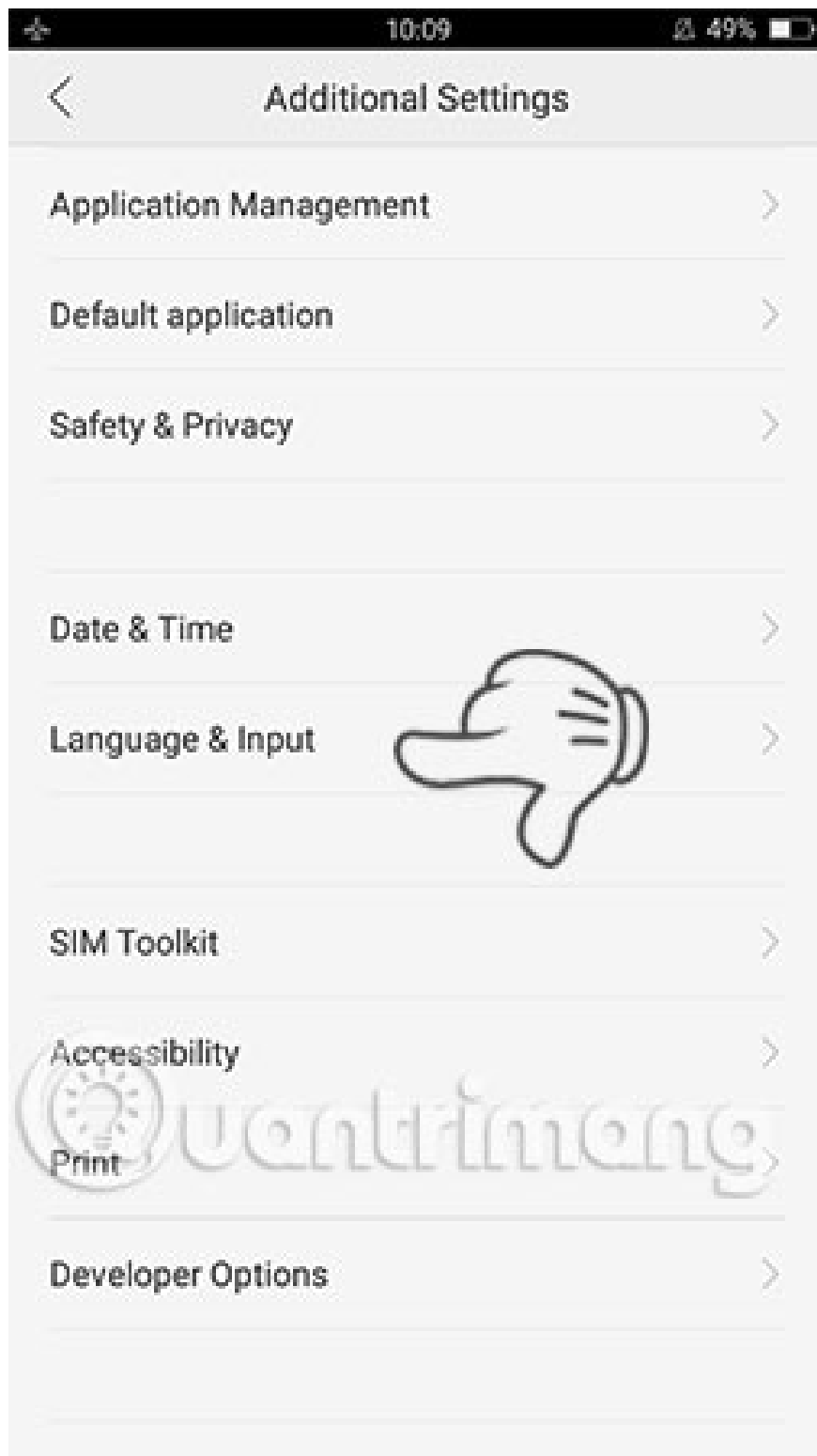
Step 1:

On the phone, go to **Settings** and select **Additional Settings** .



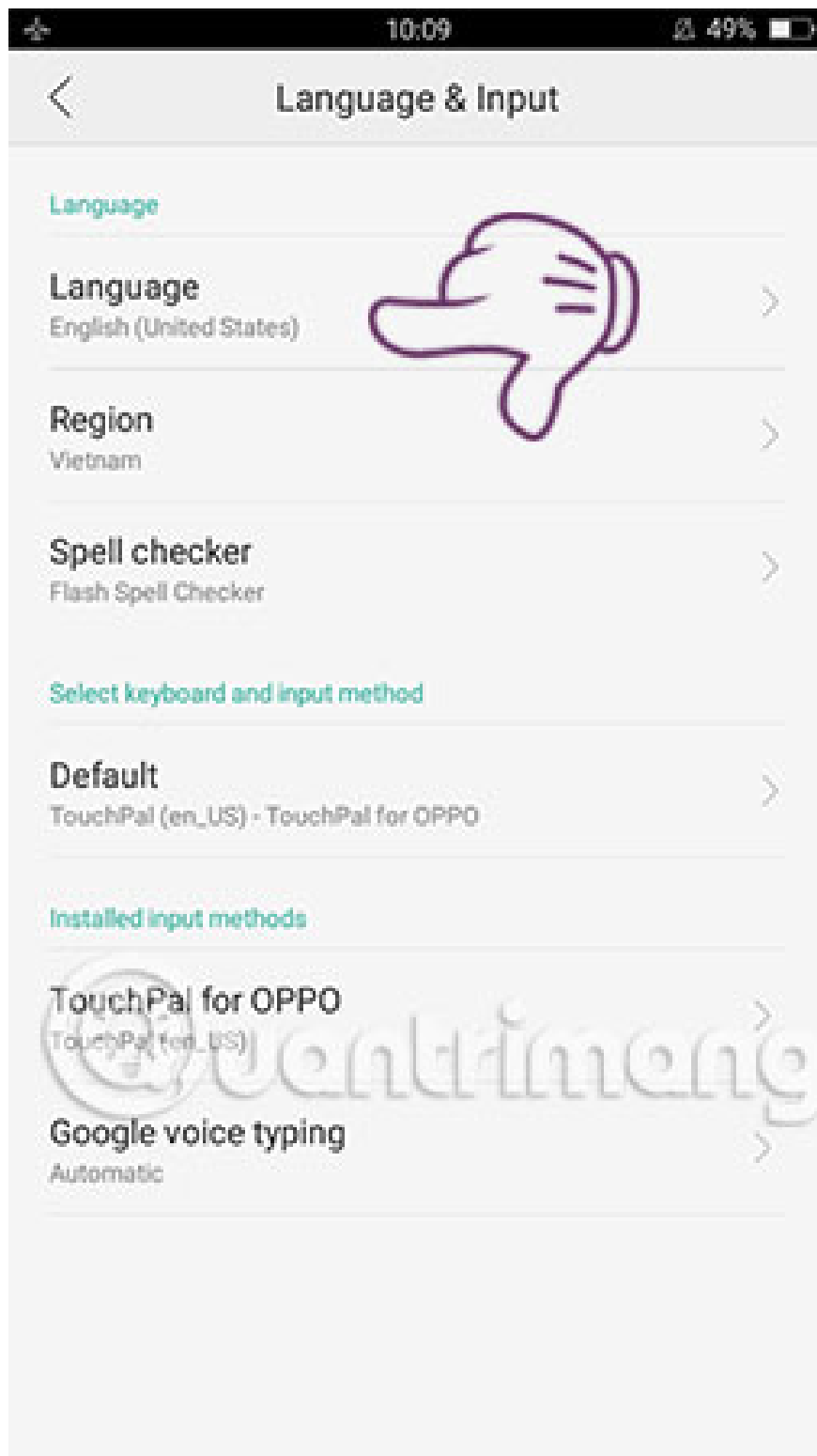
Step 2:

Here, you select **Language & Input** item (**Language and keyboard**) .



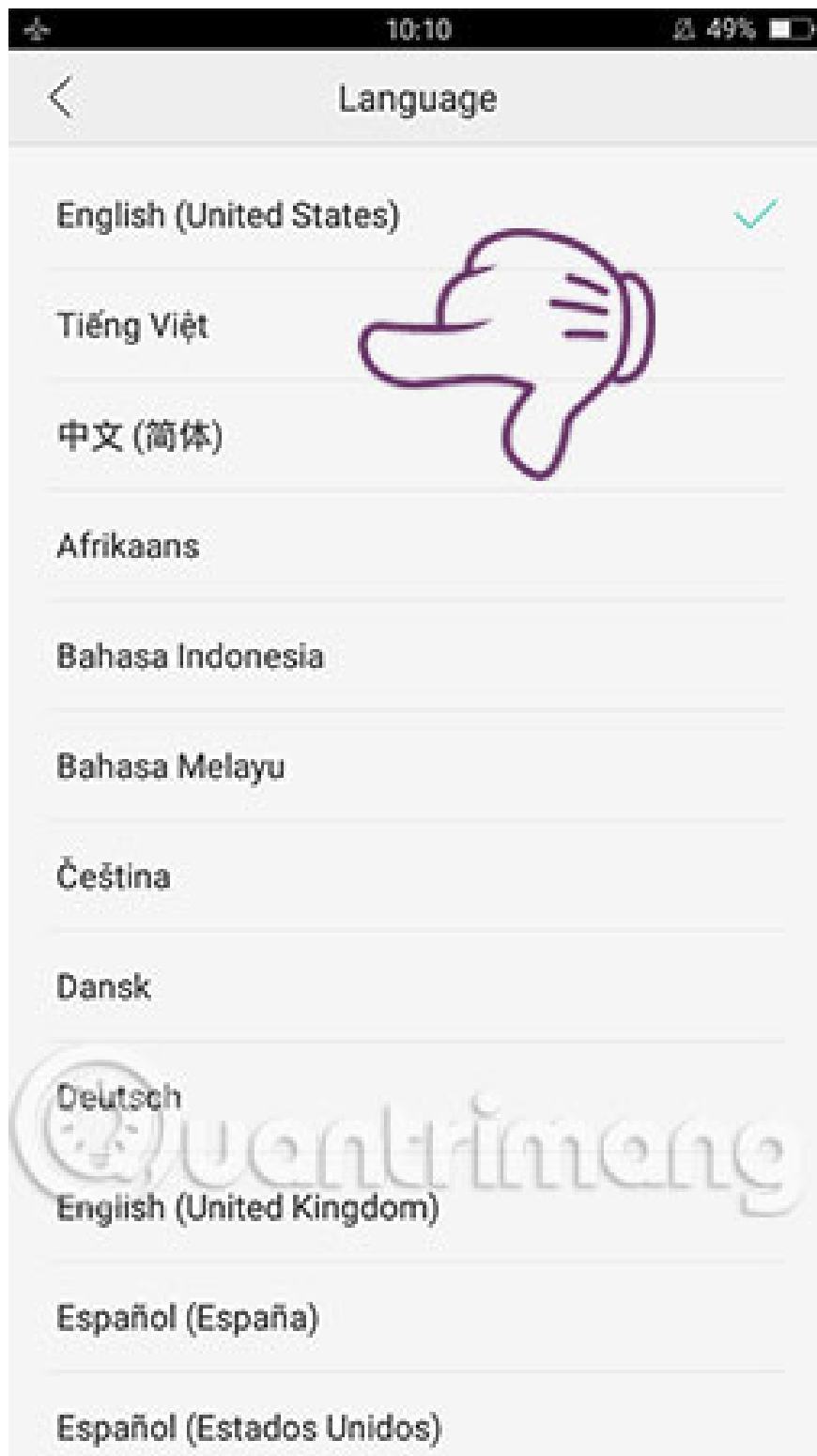
Step 3:

Next, click **Language** .



Step 4:

The list of languages appears, you search and select **Vietnamese** to complete the **Vietnamese** installation for Android phones.



As you can see, the system has now switched the device's default language to the language we need to use. And now you can freely use the device without worrying about the different interface but the foreign language is poor.
