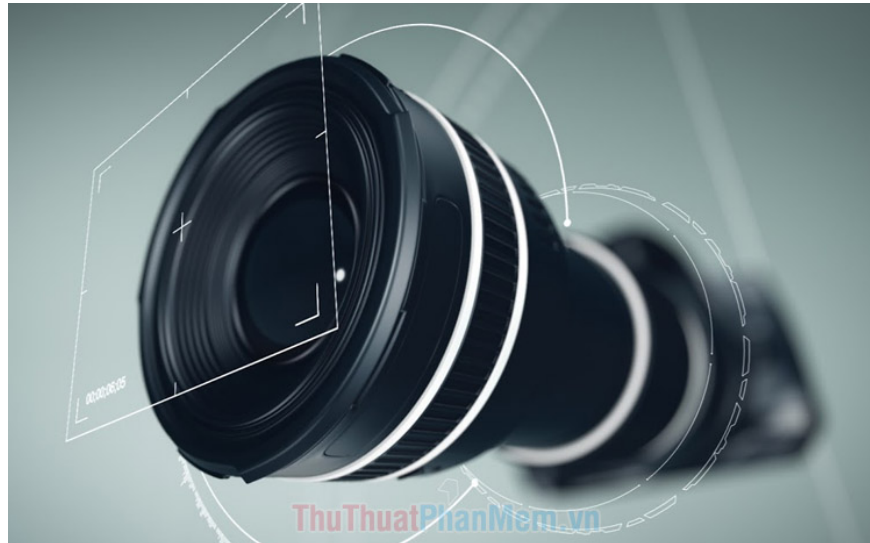


Instructions to record video on Windows 10 screen without software

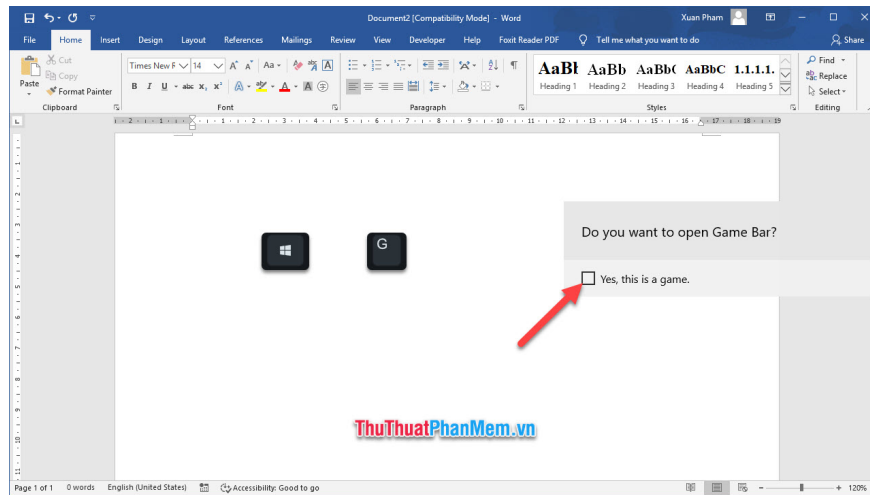
When you want to record video on your screen but don't want to install a second software, Windows 10 can meet your needs with its Game Bar function. Let TipsMake.com learn the method of video screen recording, which will not need other software.



The Game Bar function of Windows 10 only helps to record the screen of an enabled software. Therefore, to use this function, you need to open a certain software.

After turning on the software to turn the screen on, you use the **Windows G** key combination .

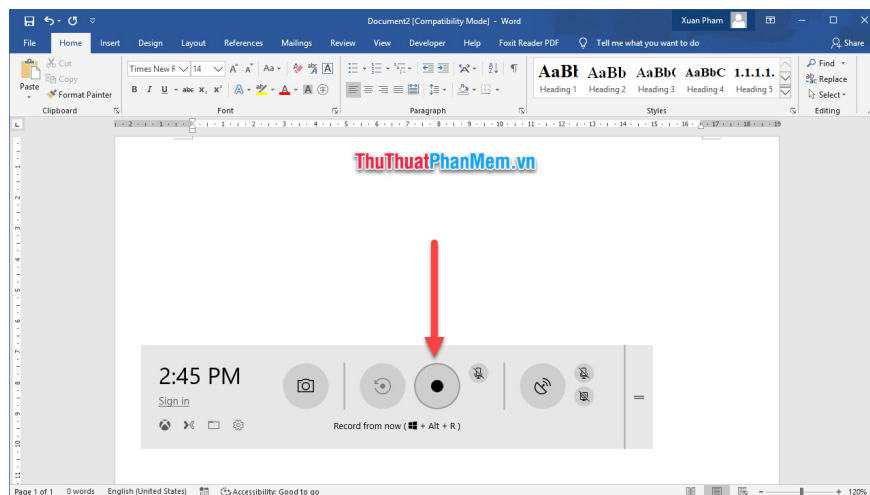
The system will ask if you want to open the Game Bar or not, click **Yes, this is a game** to enable this function.



You will see the Game Bar tray appears on the screen (if you click to open to other software, this Game Bar will temporarily disappear, Windows G again for it to appear).

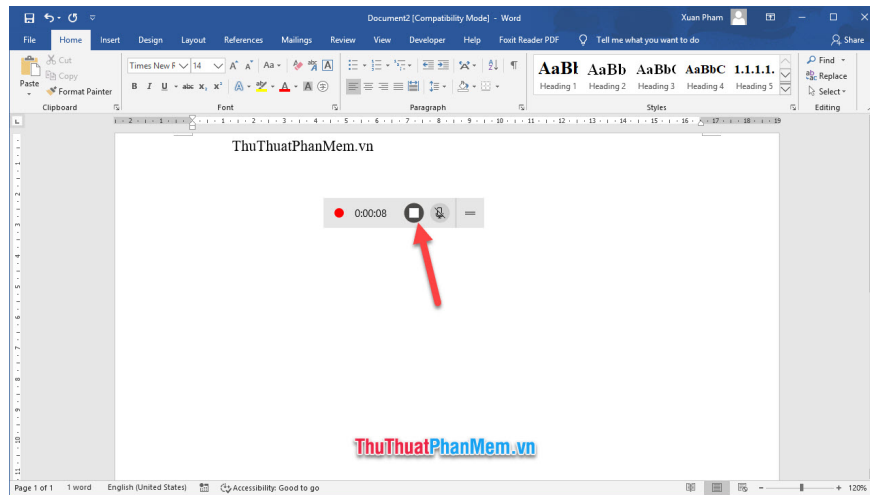
Click the round button of the **Record from now** icon to start performing video recording.

Or you can also use the **Windows Alt R** key combination to start recording.



When recording, there will be a smaller Game Bar tray that shows you how long you've been recording. When you want to stop recording you can click the square **Stop** icon on this Game Bar.

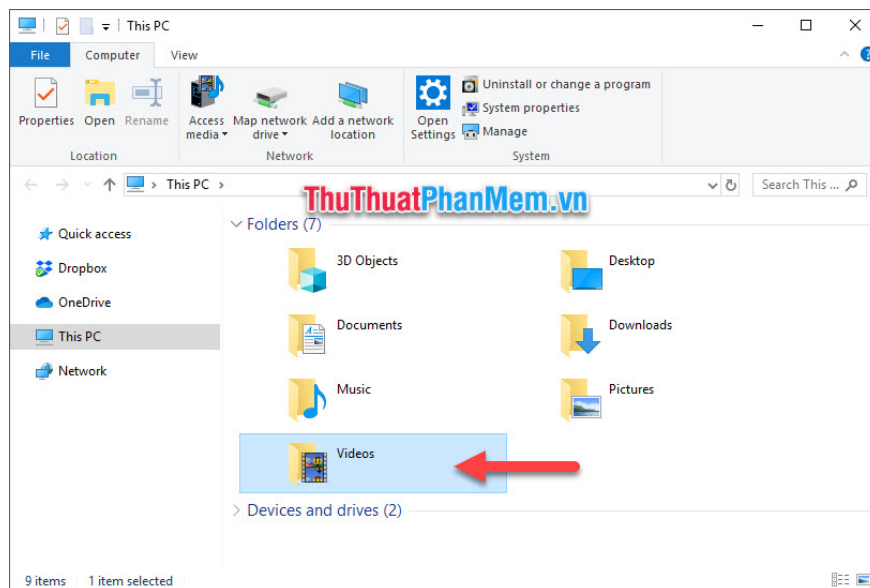
Microphone icon next to you can record your voice during recording.



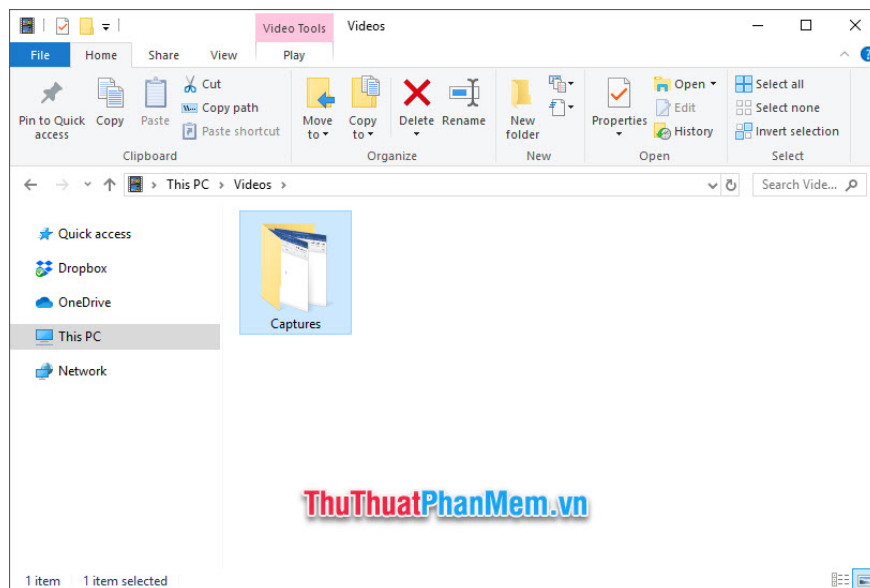
The video after recording will be saved directly to the device. To open the folder containing the video, go to This PC.



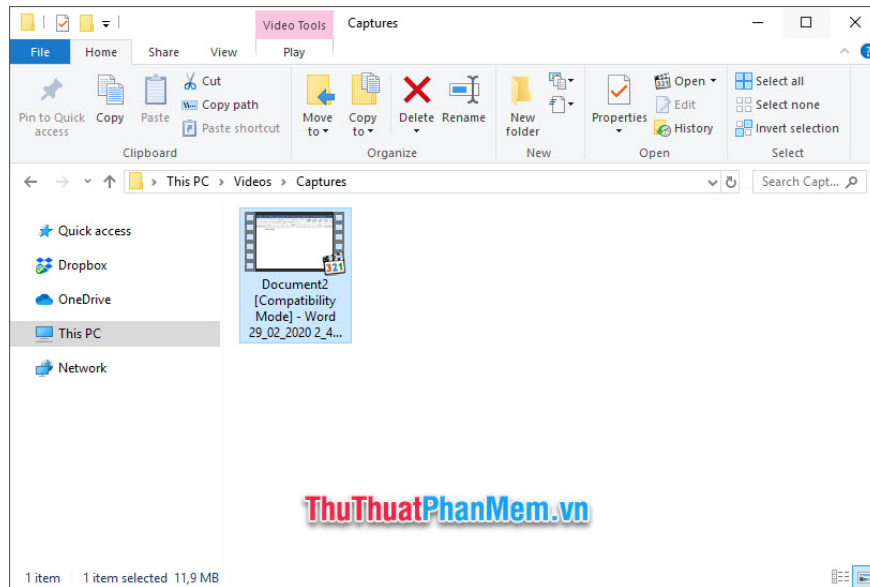
Continue to open the **Videos** folder of **This PC** .



Open the **Captures** folder in **Videos** .
