

Instructions to turn off Wifi notifications on iPhone

To no longer be bothered when the iPhone jumps to a new Wi-Fi connection notification, simply follow the simple steps below.

One of the features of iOS makes users uncomfortable, always displaying a pop-up message when a new Wi-Fi connection is detected. Here's how to turn off this notification easily.

Step 1 : Select **Settings** item and select **Wi-Fi**.



Step 2 : Turn off the option **Ask to Join Networks** .

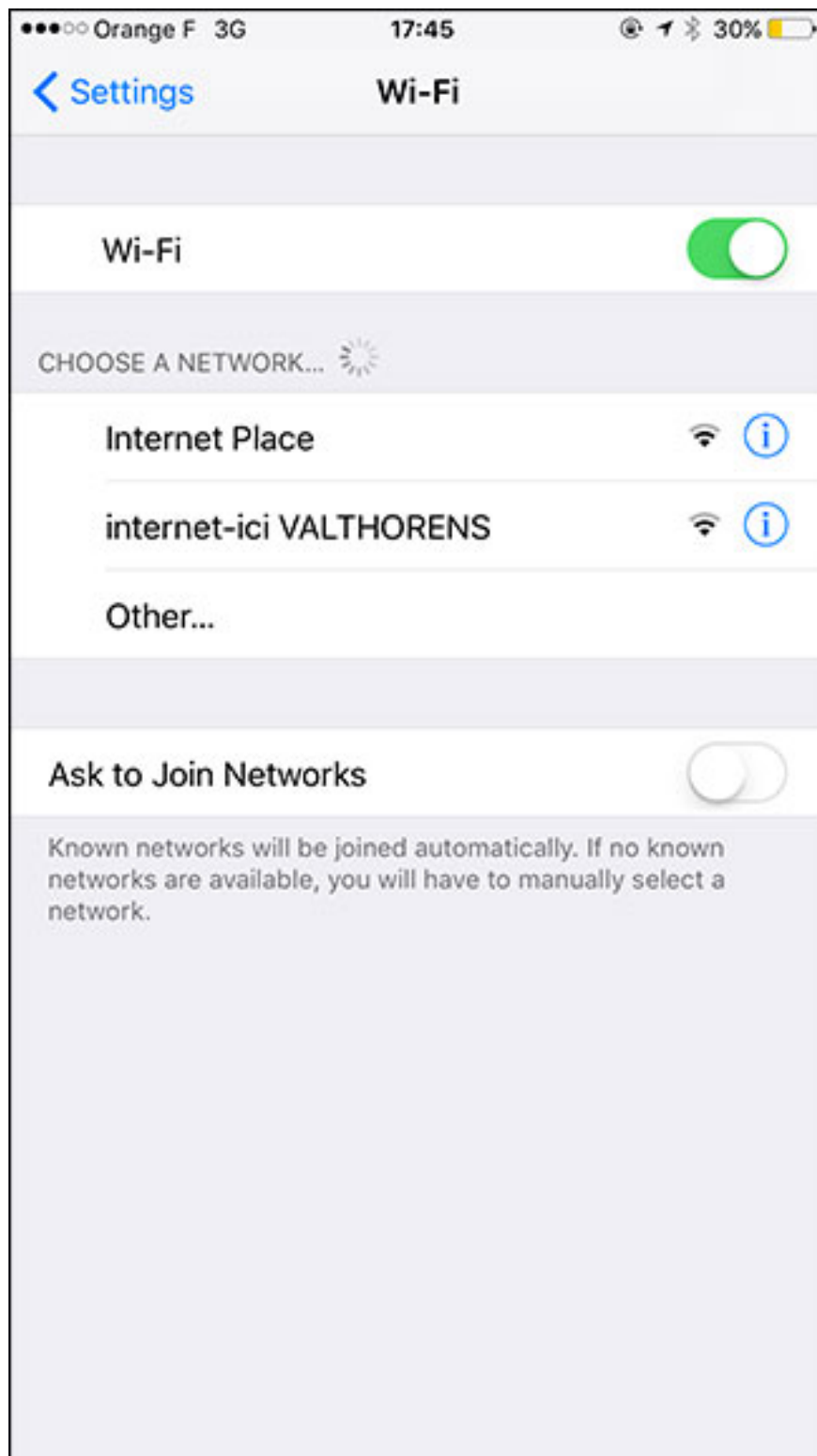

Known networks will be joined automatically. If no known networks are available, you will be asked before joining a new network.



With just a few quick steps, your iPhone will no longer display notifications every time a new Wi-Fi network is detected. If you want to turn it back on, you only need to do the same steps and turn the feature off.
