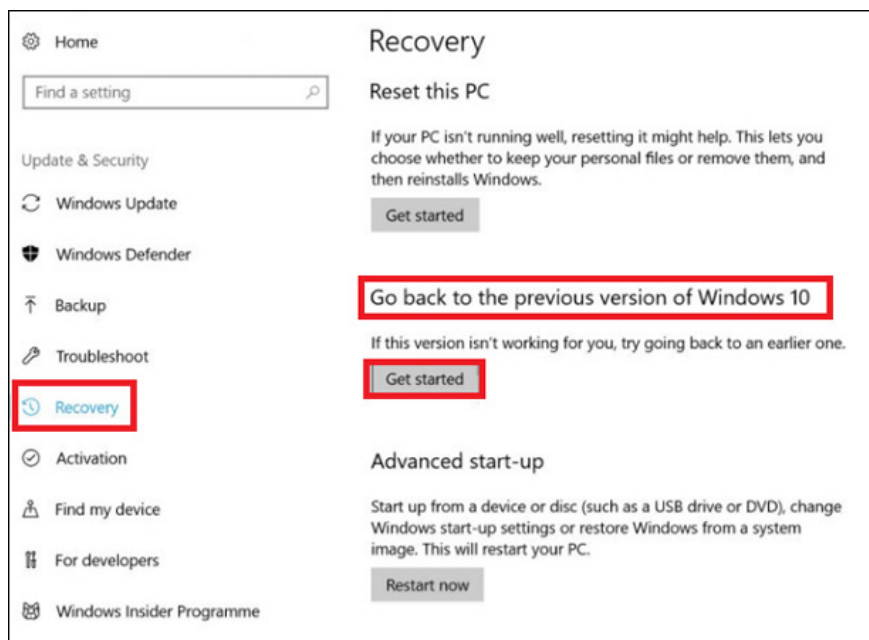
How to uninstall Windows 10 Fall Creators Update

First, you need to access **Start> Settings** .

Open the **Update and Security** section .

Then, click **Recovery** in the menu on the left.

Finally, click **Go back to the previous version of Windows 10> Get started** .



The process of returning to the previous version of Windows 10 will begin. If it does not start, it means Windows has encountered an error. You may have manually deleted the old Windows file with Disk Cleanup or installed Windows 10 Fall Creators Update for more than 30 days and the system has automatically deleted the old files.

Note: This guide only applies to Fall Creators Update version. The above process will be slightly changed during each release.

If you do not want to use Windows 10 Fall Creators Update anymore, please follow the instructions above immediately!
