If you're interested in the Laptop market, you probably already know Intel plans to launch its own foldable laptop during the upcoming CES 2020. It is clear that many manufacturers are interested in this potential segment, but there is not really a commercially available foldable laptop, if Intel can launch such a product. right at CES 2020, that would be a huge advantage, but unfortunately everything is out of their control.

It's clear that Microsoft's delay in developing Windows 10 X has delayed OEM product launches by at least a year and they still have to accept because they simply have no other choice. While it is not a good idea to develop your own operating system platform for foldable devices. Even when Windows 10 X is released, it will take a long time for the platform to truly work and provide the best experience, and only OEMs and technology users can.
