This time IE is still the browser that holds most of the market share, users almost have to accept using IE if they want to surf the web on PC.

IE 6 was *given* 'a special place' by PC World magazine in the list of 8 worst products of all time. By the end of last year, large companies including Google and YouTube had canceled all support for browsing their site on IE 6.

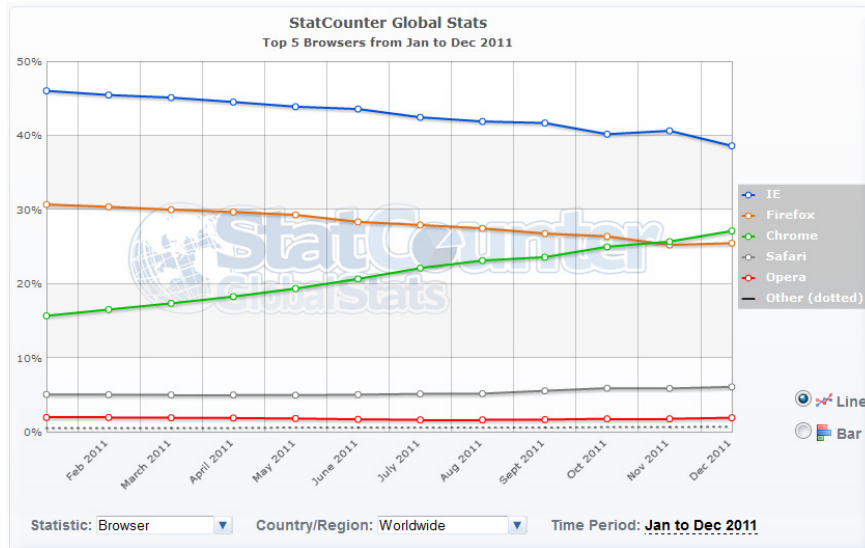
In 2006, Microsoft released IE 7, which has not fixed many of the previous versions. IE 8 was released in 2009, this version fixes a series of bugs on older versions, but it still has problems with Web content standards and backward compatibility.

Last March, Microsoft released IE 9, the best browser version of IE ever. More stable, fewer errors and received some compliments from users but the browsing speed of IE 9 is still quite slow. This version has yet to make the user completely satisfied.

The most prominent error that all versions of IE have made is the page layout error. While other browsers such as Chrome, Firefox or even Safari perform this function well, it seems to be quite a difficult task for IE.

Besides, IE does not allow specific areas on the browser for users to place icons of images, text, tools . at will. The way IE works is the same as the browser was born and acquired the browser market at the time: forcing users to use it rather than serving the user's needs.

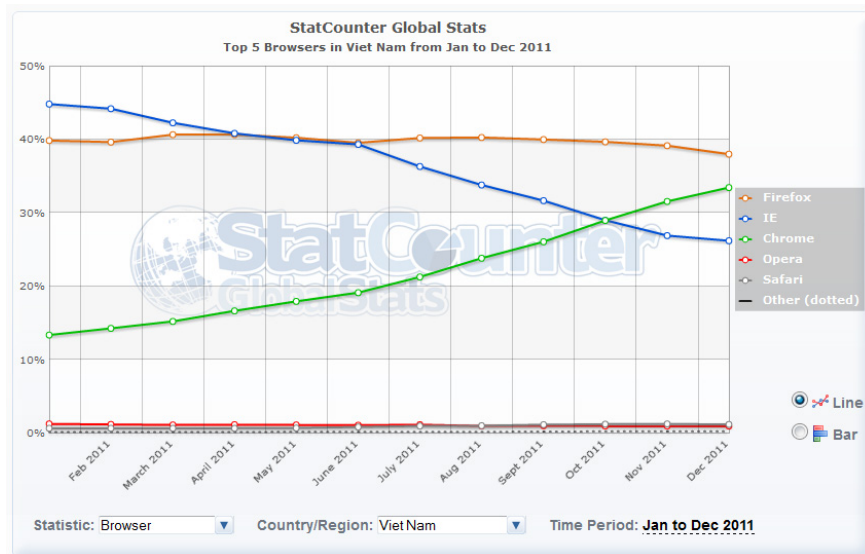

According to *StatCounter* 's latest statistics, Internet Explorer still holds 40.63% of the browser market share worldwide, while those of Chrome and Firefox are 25.69% and 25.23, respectively. % However, IE's grasp of the largest number of browser market share is simply because the browser is defaulted on all devices running Microsoft's Windows operating system.

According to *StatCounter* about the Vietnam market after last November, Firefox is dominant in the first place with 39.13%, followed by Chrome with 31.52%. IE only ranked third with 26.88% market share.
