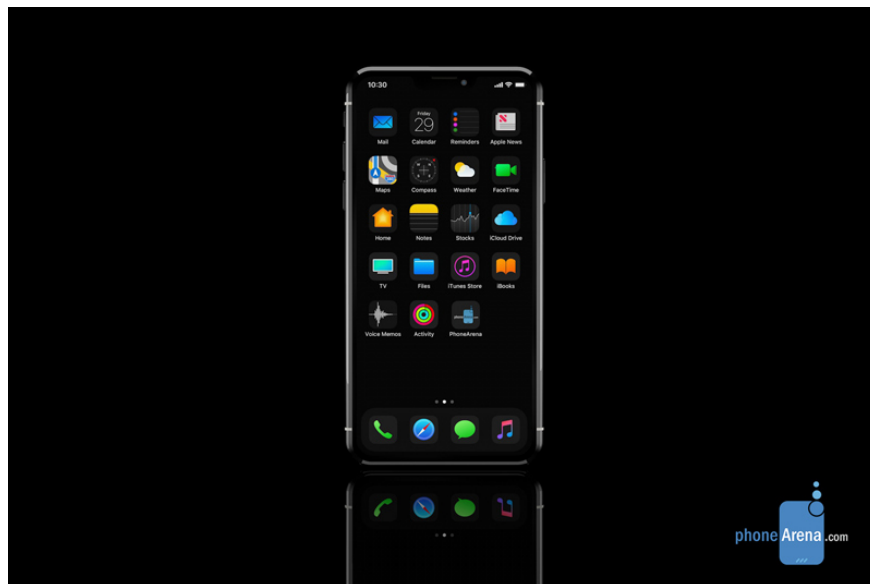
When Dark Mode is activated, the UI's light tone changes to darker tones.
