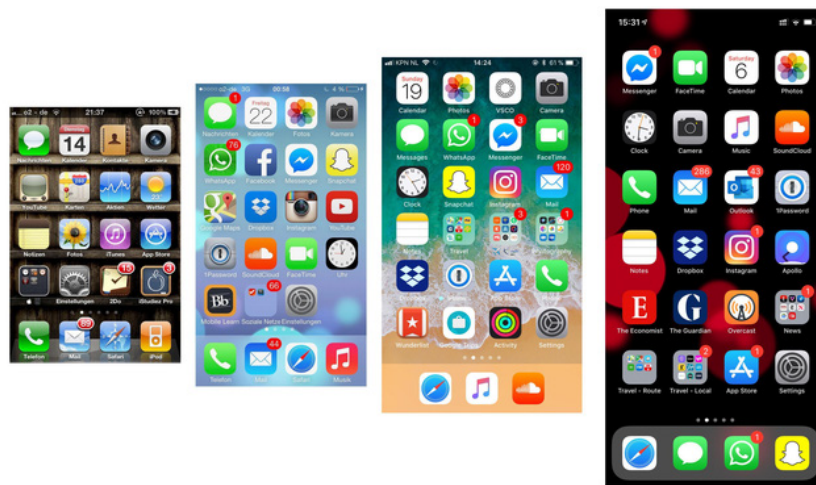


iOS 14 will bring the change that iPhone users have been waiting for over 10 years

According to leaked information, iOS 14 will have a completely new homescreen interface.

From the beginning until now, though there have been 13 versions with a series of important upgrades, but one thing that Apple has not changed on iOS is the main screen. The main screen of iOS first version, until the current iOS 13, is based on the concept of the icons are arranged in rows and columns, divided into multiple pages. This design is simple and easy to get used to, but proved to be boring for many users.

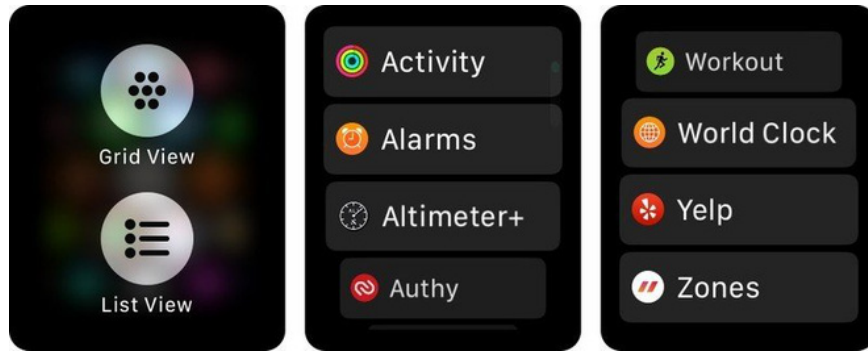


The main screen interface of iPhone across generations has remained unchanged

On iOS 14, Apple will change this. According to information from page *9to5mac*, iOS 14 will allow users to change the interface of the main screen. This is the discovery of *9to5mac* based on a leaked iOS 14 beta version.

Specifically, iOS 14 will have the option to display the application in the list (List View). This will make it easier for users to access and manage applications. Not only that, users can also arrange the applications in the list to be most convenient, such as displaying applications with unread notifications, or suggesting applications that users may want to use.

While there's no specific description, the List View home screen interface on iOS 14 will likely be similar to List View on Apple Watch's watchOS.
