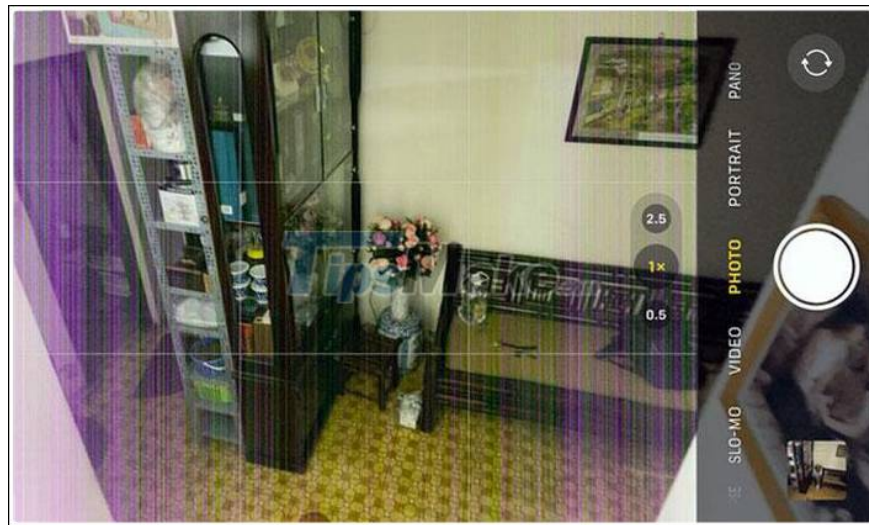


iOS 14.4 and mac OS 11.1 fix a lot of errors on iPhone and Macbook

On January 27, Apple released a new iOS 14.4 with many bugs fixed, notably the new-generation iPhone ending noise when shooting in HDR mode in low-light situations.

Some iPhones 12 and iPhone 12 Pro Max sometimes experience image errors when shooting in HDR mode.



Besides photo fixes, iOS 14.4 also adds a check - warning mechanism if the camera module on the user's iPhone 12 is replaced by a non-genuine component.

In addition, the new iOS also fixes the phenomenon of Messages app sometimes displaying the wrong keyboard language; the keyboard is not sensitive; improved recognition of QR codes with too small sizes in the Camera application; Add the ability to classify Bluetooth headphones connected to the iPhone (inner ear, ear worn over head .) to ensure the volume is not harmful to the user . Many of these errors have been complained by users from the very first day iOS 14 was released.

In this update, Apple is also 'taking advantage' to add a new feature to the Find My device search function. Previously, this app was only able to locate Apple-made devices, but can now add third-party products - mainly from 'Apple' partners (e.g. the ear listening to Belkin). In the long run, this feature allows users to track many other things with a suitable navigation accessory attached, similar to the SmartTag solution that Samsung has introduced with the Galaxy S21 phone.



iOS 14.4 can monitor the location of new objects outside of an Apple device.

Along with the new iOS, Apple also released version 11.2 of the macOS Big Sur operating system for Mac computers. Among the changes, it's worth noting that external displays are no longer black when connected to a Mac Mini with a M1 processor using the HDMI-DVI cable jack.

In addition, the update also fixes the error of Photos app not saving changes when users edit photos Apple ProRAW (newly supported on iPhone 12 Pro / ProMax); iCloud Drive turns off automatically when the iCloud Drive Desktop & Documents Folders option is disabled; some options in System Preferences are not opened even if the user has entered the system administrator password .

On the same day, Apple also rolled out an OS update for its HomePod Software 14.4 smart speaker, watchOS 7.3 watch, and Apple TV tvOS 14.4, but mostly fixed minor bugs.

As noted by the morning of January 27, the aforementioned upgrades can be downloaded through the tools integrated into the respective operating systems.
