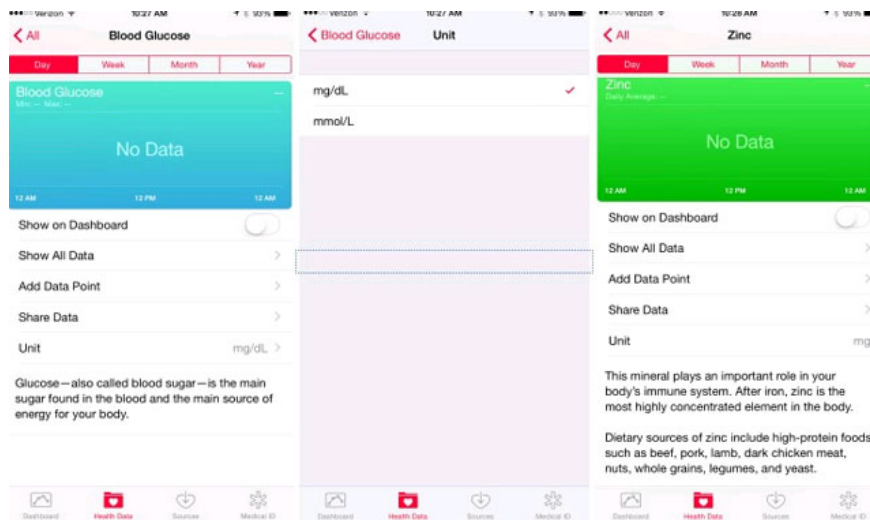


IOS 8.2 update will support blood sugar monitoring
