

iPad Pro 2020 exposes terrible benchmark scores on AnTuTu, confirming there is 6GB of RAM, faster GPU

AnTuTu data shows that the iPad Pro 2020 will be equipped with up to 6GB of RAM, higher than the 4GB RAM capacity on the 2018 iPad Pro.

Yesterday, Apple quietly launched its next generation of high-end tablets - iPad Pro 2020. Like its predecessor, the iPad Pro 2020 still has two 11-inch and 12.9-inch screen options, keeping the same design. but upgraded with configuration, camera and keyboard accessories.

Just a few hours after its launch, an iPad Pro 2020 variant with 11-inch screen was unexpectedly found in the database of performance scoring software AnTuTu, thereby revealing a few parameters. a technique Apple hasn't mentioned before.

Specifically, AnTuTu data shows that the iPad Pro 2020 will be equipped with up to 6GB of RAM, higher than 4GB of RAM on the iPad Pro 2018. It comes with 128GB of memory, which may be the standard storage level for both 11 inch and 12.9 inch versions. In addition, the device was found to be running iPad OS 13.4, which has not yet been officially released.

iPad Pro 2020 scored 712,218 points in AnTuTu's performance review

In terms of processing power, the A12Z Bionic chip on the iPad Pro 2020 is not only an upgraded version of the A12X on the iPad Pro 2018, but is also much more powerful than the A13 chipset of iPhone 11, iPhone 11 Pro and iPhone 11 Pro Max. .

As we know, Apple A13 on iPhone 11 has 6-core CPU and 4-core GPU, while A12X of iPad Pro 2018 has 8-core CPU and 7-core GPU. For iPad Pro 2020, the A12Z chip is equipped with up to 8 GPU cores, although the CPU is still 8 cores. AnTuTu data shows that the iPad Pro 2020 has a 9% faster GPU than the previous generation.

The device found in the AnTuTu database has a model code of iPad 8.10. Meanwhile, the iPad Pro 2018 has two variants with the model number iPad 8.1 and iPad 8.8. As this model number first appeared and ran the iPad OS 13.4 operating system that has not been officially released, so it can be sure that this is the iPad Pro 2020.
