

iPhone Lock suddenly revived after 8 months of waiting

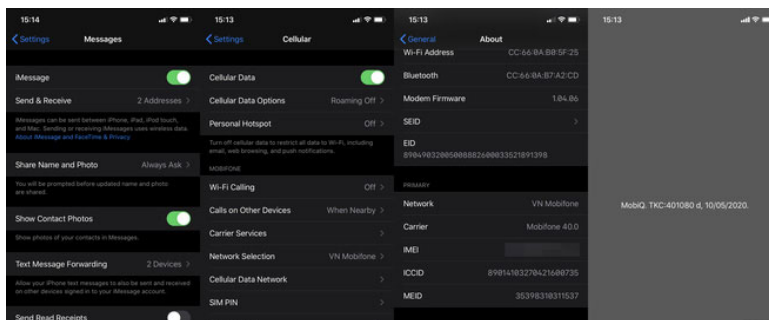

From July 2019, the iPhone Lock in Vietnam could not be activated due to the combined SIMs, the separation of the iPhone Lock, which was locked by Apple. Although some Chinese manufacturers developed another pair of SIM cards right after that, they caused iPhone Lock to be unable to activate iMessage / FaceTime, missed calls, and not used. Get individual access points.

It seems that iPhone Lock has forever gone into the past, but yesterday afternoon (March 11, 2020) iPhone Lock was suddenly revived after 8 months of waiting, making the iPhone Lock community in Vietnam excited.

Testing with an iPhone 11 version of Lock shows that all features of the device from calling, messaging, missed calls, iMessage / FaceTime activation, mobile data, personal hotspots . all work. As good as the international machine.

However, in order to pair the SIM successfully, iPhone Lock needs to be upgraded to the latest version of iOS, specifically at the moment it is iOS 13.3.1.

Despite being revived, the future of the iPhone Lock is not bright, because this vulnerability can be patched at any time, similar to what Apple did last year.
