

# iPhone Lost Call Tone - Apply Tips Immediately

iPhone losing call tone means the phone doesn't ring when there is a call, causing you to miss out on a lot of important information.

Most smartphones sometimes have errors that you don't know how to handle. And specifically with the iPhone, one of the most common errors you encounter is **the iPhone losing call tones** . This not only causes annoyance and trouble but also affects your work and life. That's why I've integrated here some tips to help fix the error of iPhone losing notification sounds when there is an incoming call.





Even though you have enabled Sound mode on your iPhone, incoming calls still don't ring but only vibrate. Or your phone has a missed notification but you don't see the call.

What a headache! But rest assured, **TipsMake** will help you fix the error with a few simple tricks:

### **#Why does iPhone lose call tone?**

Before going to the solution, let's take a look at the reasons why the iPhone does not ring when there is a call:

? Because you adjusted **the ringtone volume** too low, the iPhone did not ring

? You are leaving your iPhone in **Do Not Disturb Mode** , resulting in incoming calls not being received

? Software conflict errors due to incompatible applications or applications containing harmful viruses that you have previously installed on your device. In addition, the operating system version is too outdated is also a suspicious reason

? The iPhone's external speaker is broken due to an old device or a water-damaged device, so it's natural for the iPhone to lose sound.



At this point, you probably can imagine the reason *why incoming calls don't ring* ? Now follow the tips below to fix it!

## **#Fix the error of iPhone losing call tones**

**iPhone losing call notification** is a problem that needs to be fixed immediately. Because if your iPhone doesn't ring when there is an incoming call, you will miss important calls. Furthermore, work is affected by calls from customers, partners, etc. Therefore, immediately apply the following solution:

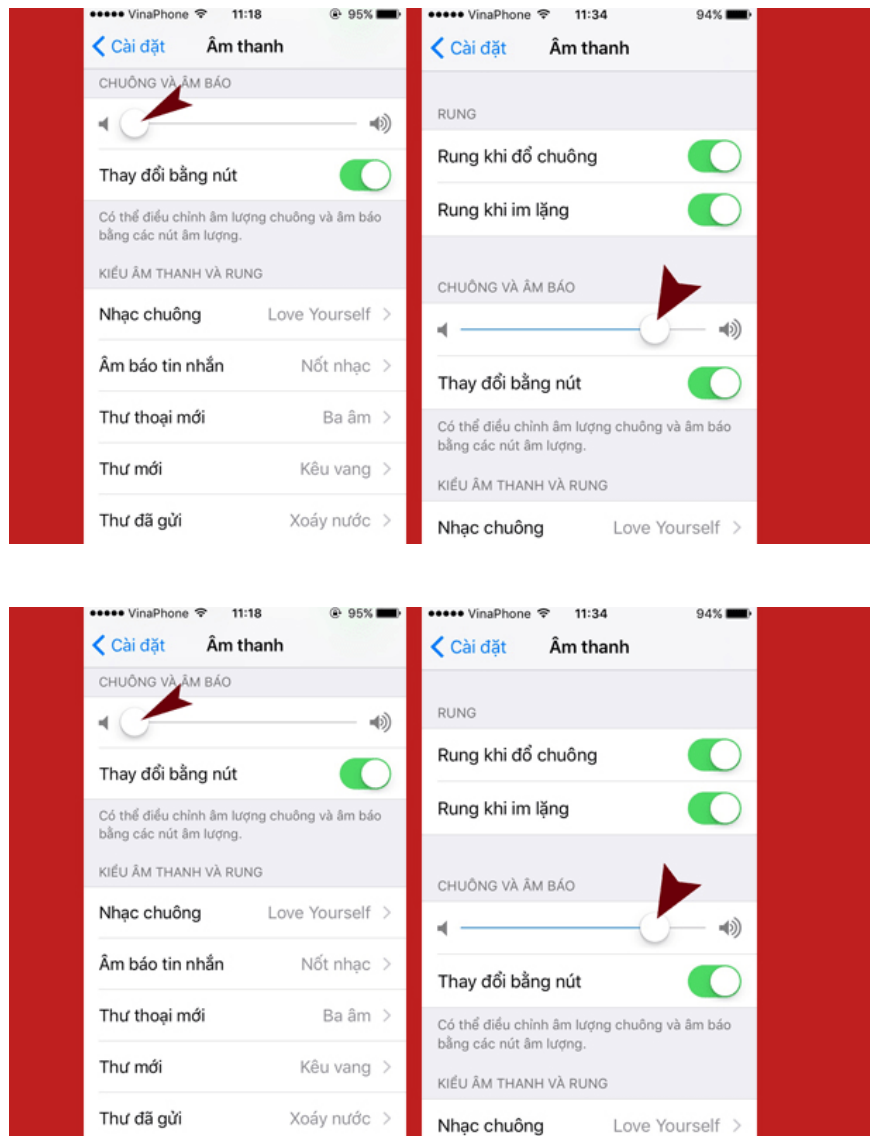
### **1./ Check Sound settings on iPhone**

? First, **turn off silent mode on iPhone** if you accidentally set it to the right by: Check **the Sound switch button** on the right.



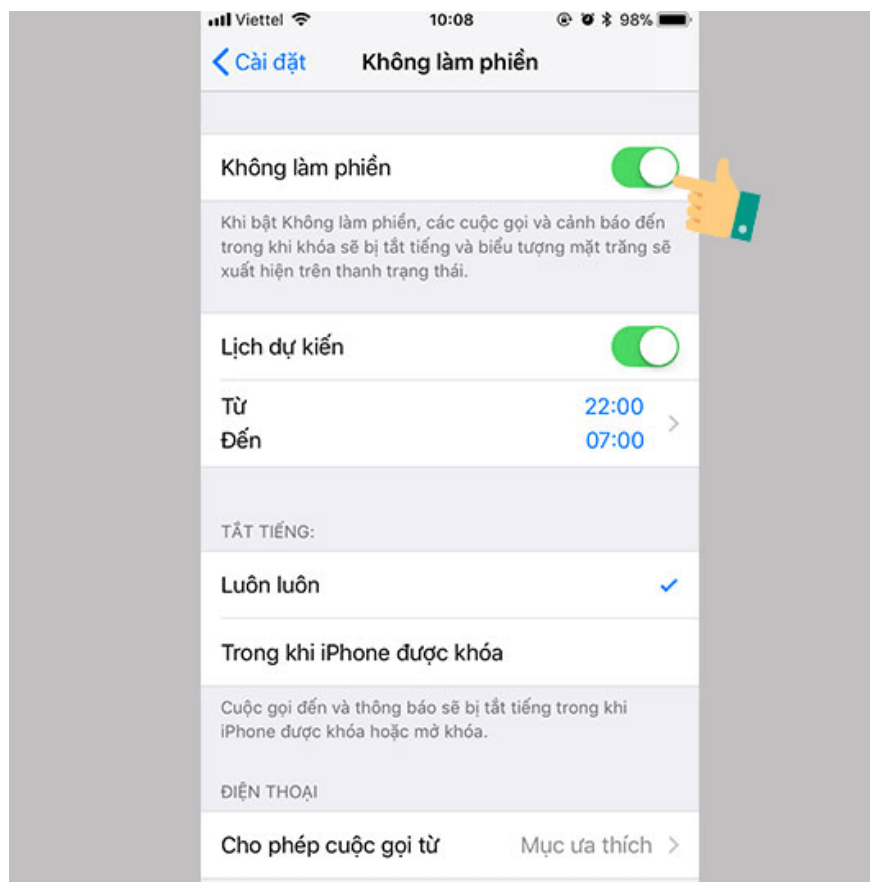
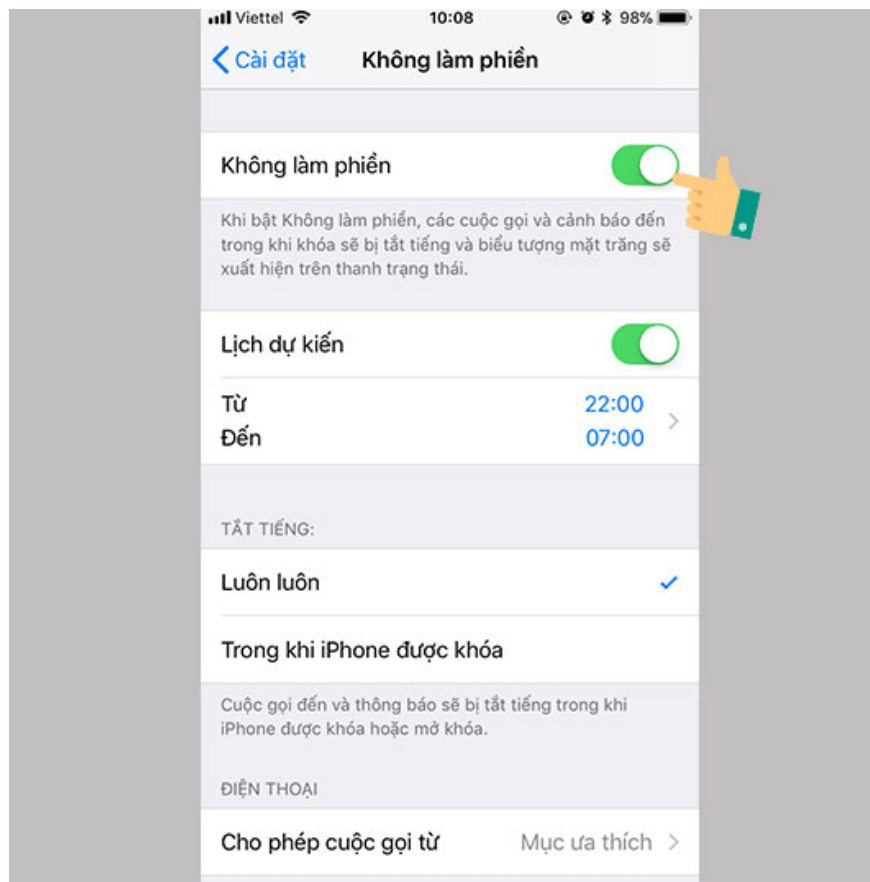
? Or maybe you accidentally adjusted the volume down to *the Mute button* without paying attention. At this time, you should set **the iPhone ringtone volume** larger.

=> To set *the ringtone volume*, go to: **Settings > Sound & Touch >** in the **Bells and notifications** section , you can adjust the volume higher.



## 2./ Turn off Do no disturb mode

This is a useful feature that manufacturer Apple has equipped on iPhone phones to avoid being disturbed by notifications, Facebook messages or incoming calls when you are in a meeting or classroom that needs concentration. certain.



Please check the do not disturb mode again. They are shown below the 'Crescent Moon' icon above the notification bar. To turn off Do Not Disturb Mode on iPhone, go to **Settings > Do Not Disturb >** turn off 2 options: **Do Not Disturb** and **Scheduled**.

### 3./ Restart iPhone

Restarting the device is also something you need to do after briefly checking for basic 'accidental errors': This is a highly successful way when the iPhone does not ring. Because you know, rebooting can help reset the system of those 'little errors'.



To *Power Off and Restart iPhone* : press and hold the **Power button + Volume Down button** for about 5 seconds, then the *Slide to power off slider will appear on the screen*, you just need to drag it to the right . Then press the *Power* button to restart iPhone.

### 4./ Restore iPhone Factory Settings

Restoring the iPhone to factory settings is probably an effective solution if the iPhone loses call tones due to a software conflict. However, this operation will cause your device to lose all data on the device. So please backup your data before operating! If you unfortunately lose important data, you will cry forever!

»» There are 2 ways **to restore iPhone factory settings** :

***Restore using device operations*** : Go to **Settings > General > Reset > Erase all content and reset.**



### ***Connect to iTunes on your computer:***

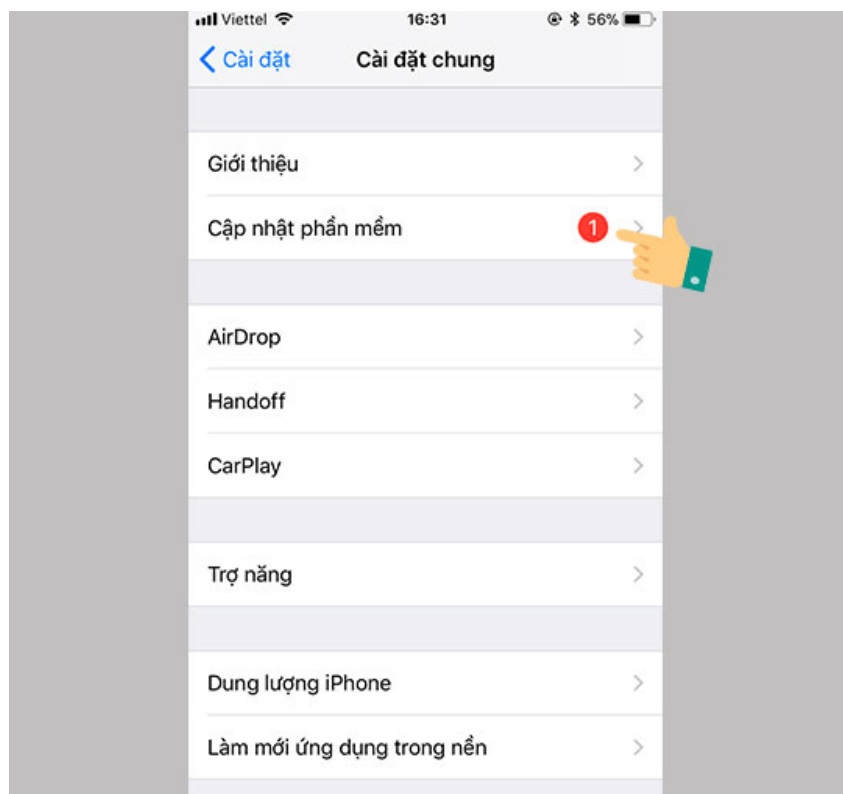
This method is a bit more complicated: your computer must install the latest version of iTunes software.

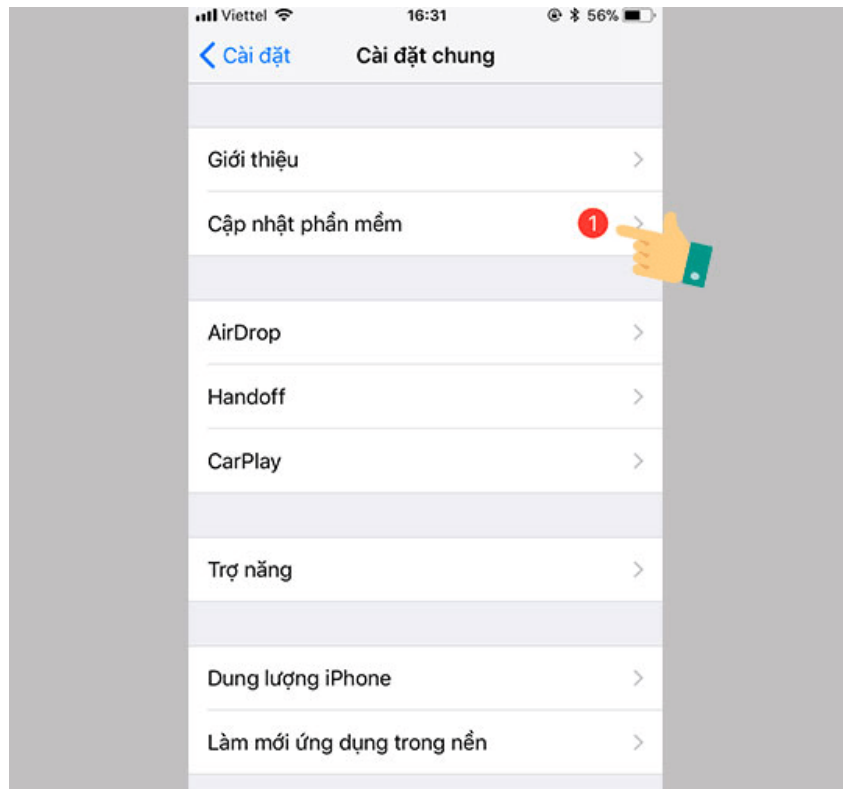
? Use a cable to connect iPhone to the computer. Do this by **opening iTunes** and clicking **the iPhone icon** in the upper *left corner of the screen*.

? Then select **Restore Backup** and follow the predetermined instructions. Additionally, thanks to the *iCloud data cloud storage system* , you can also restore data through them.

### **5./ Update the new iOS operating system**

One of the iPhone errors that causes the speaker to lose sound may be because you have not updated the new terms of the operating system.





To update your iPhone, go to **Settings > General > Software Update** . Don't forget *to restart your device* , adjust the volume and call your phone to test your iPhone's ringing feature again!

## **6./ Bring iPhone for repair**

If you apply the above method but still cannot fix *the iPhone sound loss error* . Damaged speakers? Do you think the iPhone lost speaker sound due to speaker damage? This is an error that also occurs frequently. But to be careful and check all features, try playing a song to test!





Not only the error of losing call tones, if your iPhone encounters errors such as: *unable to hear the conversation at both ends of the line, sound too low, loss of sound when watching videos, noise* . That you applied Tried all the above methods but still can't fix it. At this point, the iPhone's speaker is definitely broken. Please take your phone to a repair shop to have it checked and fixed. The solution may be to replace the speaker for the iPhone!
