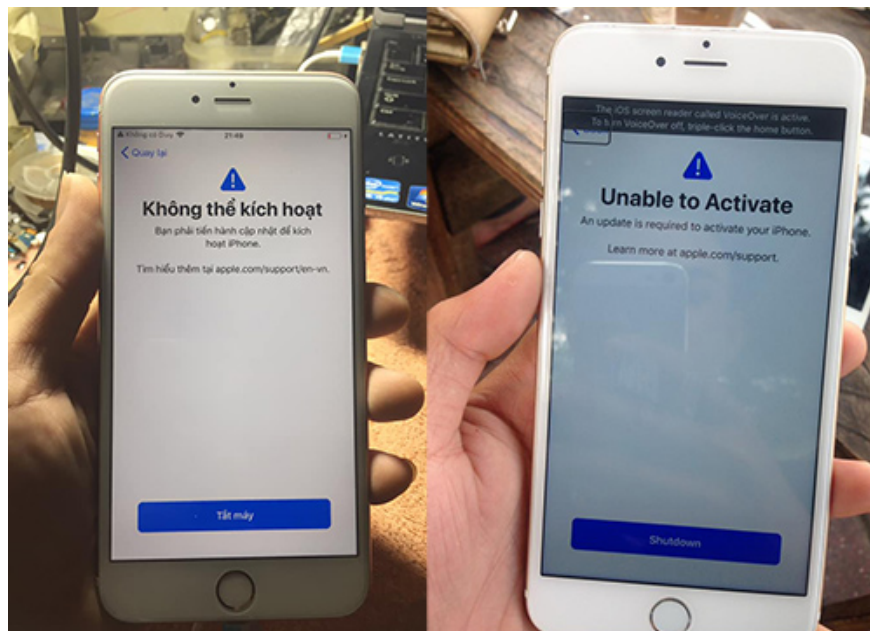


# iPhone update to iOS 12 can be seriously corrupted into 'brick'

The recently released iOS 12 operating system has been highly praised for its performance stability. But besides, iOS 12 also generates errors that make users frustrated.

The recently released iOS 12 operating system has been highly praised for its performance stability. But besides, iOS 12 also generates errors that make users frustrated. The most serious error on iOS 12 can even turn the iPhone into a 'brick'.

In Vietnam, many users after upgrading to iOS 12 reflect on their device displaying the message "Cannot activate" and "You must proceed to update to activate iPhone" with that. The appearance of an exclamation point in the wave column and the IMEI of the device also disappears.



There are not any software solutions that can fix this serious error, including downgrade to iOS 11. According to information from technology forums, this error comes from the baseband chip (management chip wave) and almost only appear on the past hardware repair or problems related to waves or breaking iCloud.

This serious error mainly affects users who have purchased the device that has been repaired or replaced without knowing.

For users who make sure their device hardware has not been repaired, can update to iOS 12 without having to worry because this is really a great update.
