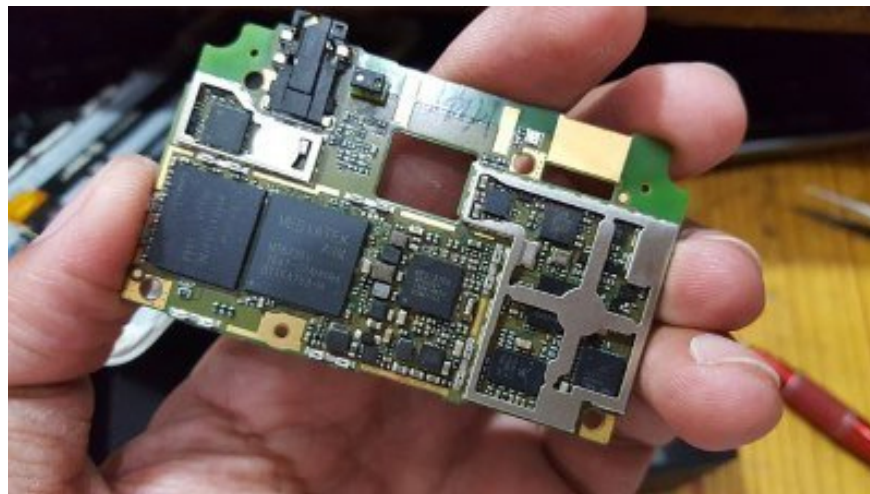

In the early days of Android, users did not easily perform specific tasks or optimize device operation. For example, in Android version 3.0, you cannot take a screenshot without downloading the Android SDK. In addition to saving battery, you also need to root to optimize the application.
