Siri is only available through Apple products. The number of Apple devices is growing slowly and may be a bit limited compared to Alexa. While you might have an Apple device or two in your home, chances are you own more Alexa-enabled gadgets.

## Question answering skills: Siri is smarter and funnier

Siri

1. Can understand more normal speech.
2. Have a sense of humor.
3. Slightly faster.

Alexa

1. Sometimes the syntax requirements are quite specific.
2. Integrated procurement support.
3. New skills are added every day.



Both Alexa and Siri do a great job answering all of your questions. You can ask one of these virtual assistants to convert measurements, tell you tomorrow's weather, as well as connect them to your family calendar to notify you of upcoming events.

However, Siri often understands better when you speak normally or quickly, while Alexa requires precise sentences to fully understand what you mean. Additionally, Siri has a better sense of humor, often providing humorous, light-hearted answers to everything, if you want to ask something trivial for fun.

Alexa does a much better job of helping you shop. There is a shopping list feature and you can easily order items through Alexa, of course you don't need to use Amazon. Alexa also seems a bit faster when adopting new things, like support for new hardware or online services, thanks to the **Skills** section .

## **Phone support: Siri wins convincingly**

Siri

1. Attached to all iPhones and iPads.
2. Can easily send SMS messages or make calls.

Alexa

1. Requires separate Alexa app to be installed.
2. Does not support SMS.

Siri was created with the iPhone in mind. It served as a standalone app before becoming a built-in feature on all Apple devices. Using this assistant on your phone is much more convenient than Alexa requiring you to install a separate app.

Siri is very well integrated into the iPhone, making it feel natural to use, while Alexa takes a bit of practice and tinkering in the app to fully understand. Setting up smart home routines in particular can be difficult with Alexa and takes some time to master.

## **Interaction with other gadgets: Alexa has the advantage**

While Alexa has problems snooping on conversations, Apple keeps your smart home data separate from your personal profile, keeping your activity from being used to advertise things.

Siri is also a bit easier to set up smart home routines, while Alexa can seem a bit difficult to use, if you're not tech-savvy.

However, Siri only supports Apple Music for its music streaming service, while Alexa supports a variety of music streaming services, including Amazon Prime Music and Spotify, making it easier to use.

Alexa also supports more IoT devices than Siri, from things like Nest thermostats to doorbells. Overall, Alexa has the edge here, simply because it's more convenient than Siri.
