Associate Professor Sunny Jung and colleagues at Virginia Tech University (USA) used high-speed camcorders and mathematical models to shed light on the dynamics process that occurs when dogs drink water to help people have A better look at how to "refresh" the puppy.





The whole process of drinking the dog's water depends on the tongue part. Then, it will bend its tongue backwards and push the tongue into the liquid, and quickly pull the tongue back to the mouth. This action will create a water column below the tongue, the inertial force will be introduced into the mouth.
