Accordingly, a group of scientists who study lesions on archaeological subjects at the University of Pisa have announced that they have found a set of dentures that are considered to be the oldest in the world.

It is known that this set of dentures is found in the **remains of an ancient family in Italy** , estimated to be in the late 14th and early 17th centuries.



A member of the research team, Dr. Simona Minozzi, said: " *The set of dentures that have been discovered so far may be the oldest set of dentures in the world, marking a historic turning point. specific in Italian dental history* '.

Antique false tooth model was found to consist of 5 teeth, in which canines, incisors were covered with a layer of metal mainly gold, silver and a small layer of teeth found on this denture time as well. quite long.

It is known that this prosthetic set was found in the tomb of the **ancient Giunigi family in Lucca** , where Italian science has also unearthed more than 200 bones buried in a chapel of the San Francesco monastery before.
