On Twitter, many accounts complain that they cannot add members when chatting FaceTime between them. If you want to start a group call, the caller must turn off FaceTime, then start again from the beginning with two or more people. iPhone, iPad updated iOS 12.1.4 are affected.

In response to user feedback, the Apple Support support account on Twitter only instructs them how to use Group FaceTime when "making a call with at least two people".

In addition to limiting the feature of adding members when chatting with FaceTime, iOS 12.1.4 update also has a series of other serious errors such as not accepting sim, losing wifi connection, 4G.
