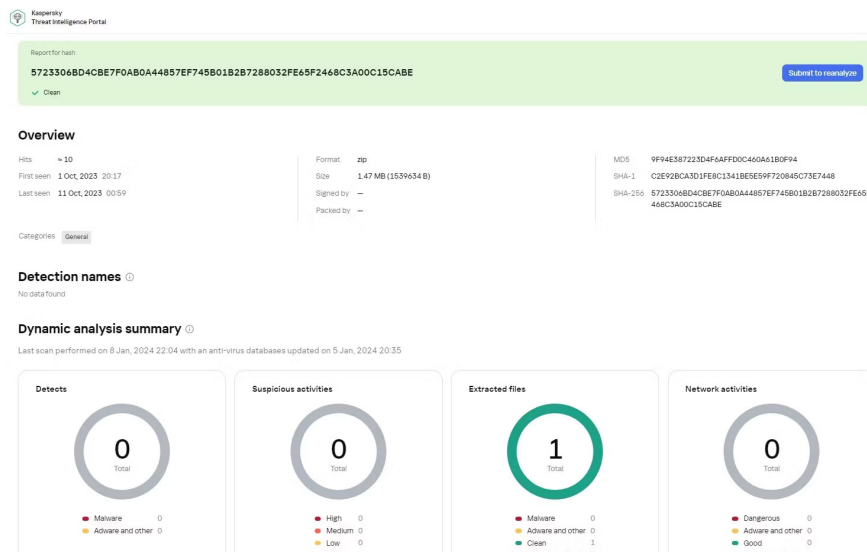

## Why was Kaspersky banned?



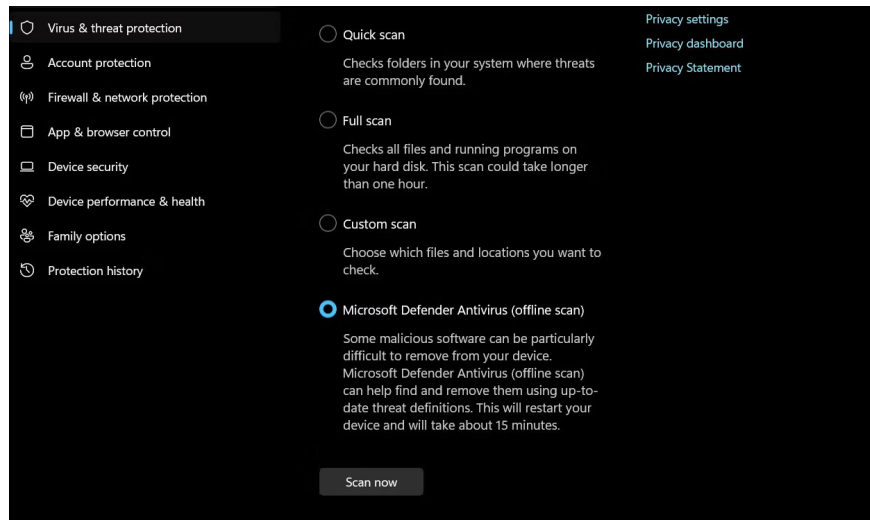
Throughout 2024, the United States has continuously evaluated which foreign applications are allowed within its borders. It all started when the US passed a bill banning TikTok due to concerns that the application would act as a data collection tool for China. Now, due to the war in Ukraine, sanctions against Russia, and concerns around the extent of Russian companies' access to sensitive documents, the United States will ban Kaspersky from July 20, 2024.

Kaspersky software will continue to receive updates until September 29, 2024. However, those affected should find early alternatives before that date arrives; Having an antivirus that doesn't update itself won't protect you from any new attacks that arise.

## 3 best alternatives to Kaspersky

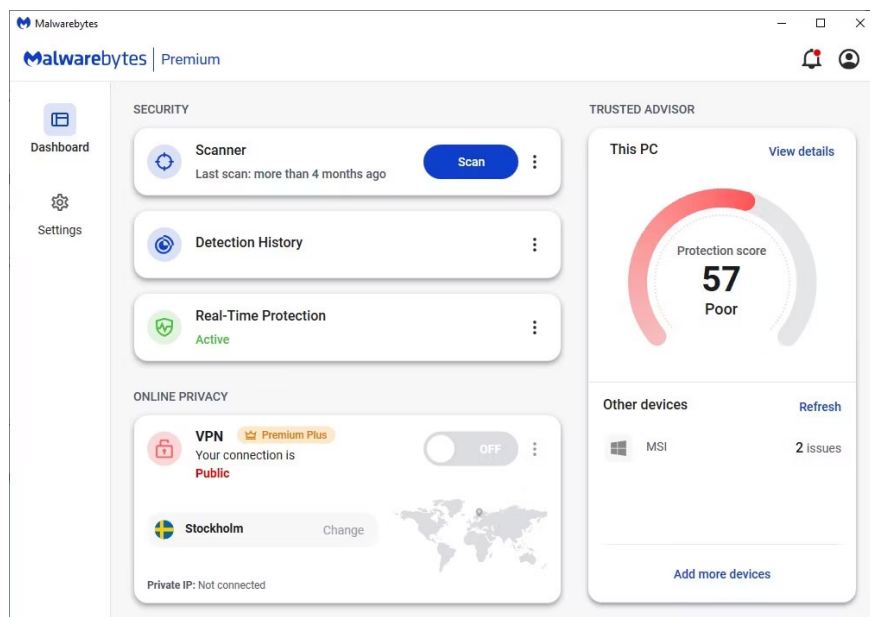
So if Kaspersky is banned, what is a good alternative? Below are the top 3 options currently.

## Microsoft Defender



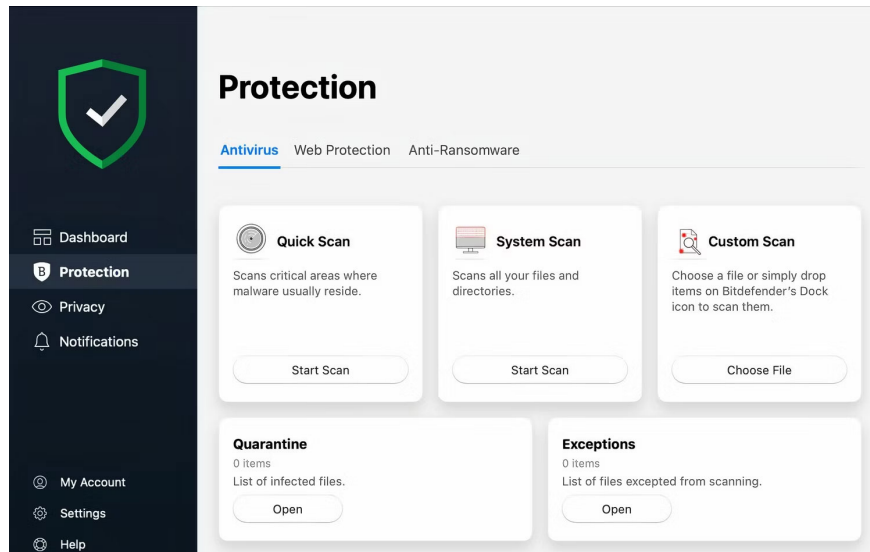
